

**Climate Change adaptation and aid effectiveness  
- how to integrate adaptation into development planning**

**Summary:**

The Commission on Climate Change and Development has chosen as one of its priority Issues adaptation to climate change in developing countries that are particularly exposed to impacts of a changing climate. Investment in development can be threatened by the very severe impacts climate change and disasters might have and adaptation must be dealt with in an integrated manner for it to be effective and sustainable. The Commission's work will serve as an input for discussion among donor and partner countries in order to improve global policy on development and adaptation.

- How to create a robust and coherent institutional architecture for managing and financing adaptation?
- What are effective financial mechanisms for supporting adaptation?
- How can the Paris principles be applied in development cooperation for adaptation?
