Chart 1: National Social Welfare System for PWDs

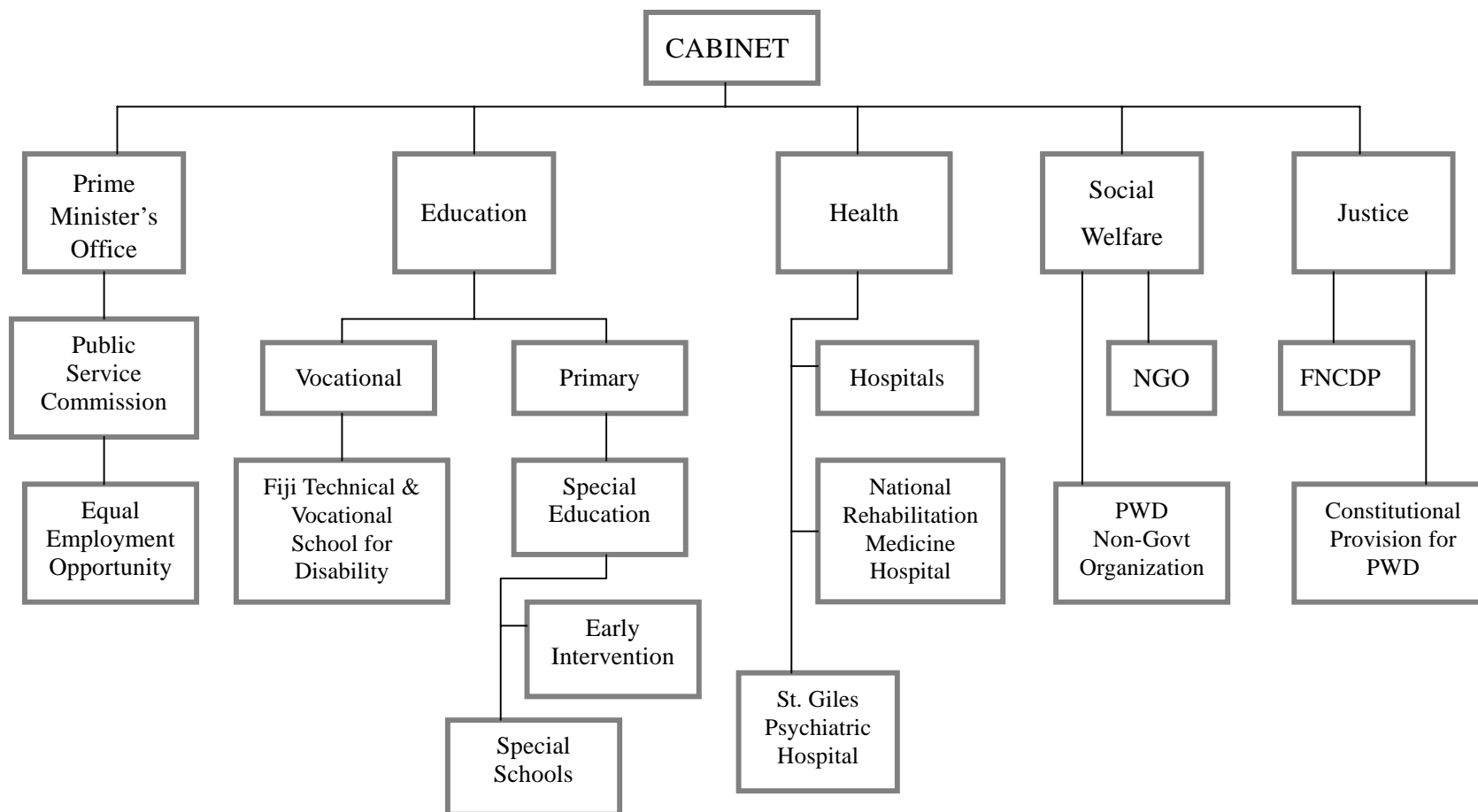
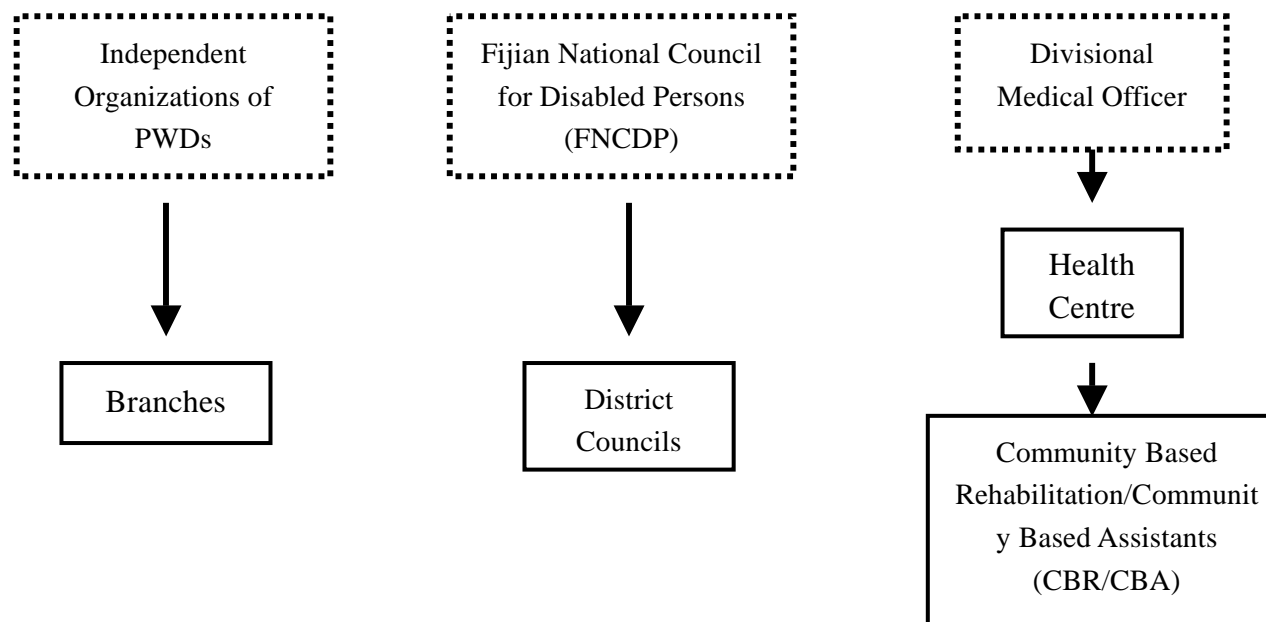


Chart 2: Local level
