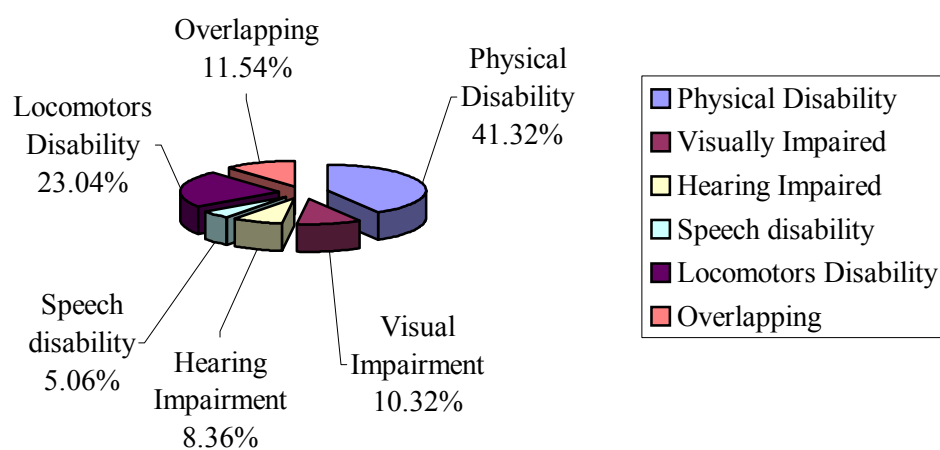

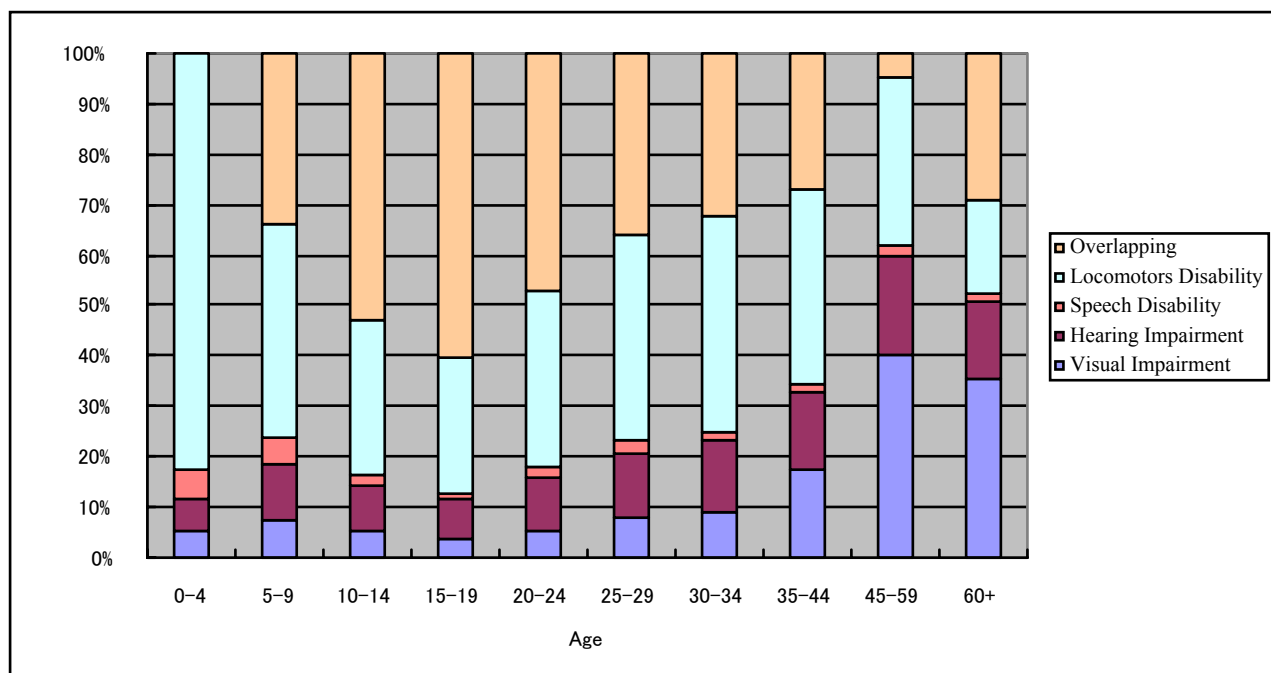
**Figure 1: Disability-specific Data**

**Figure 2: Age-specific Data**



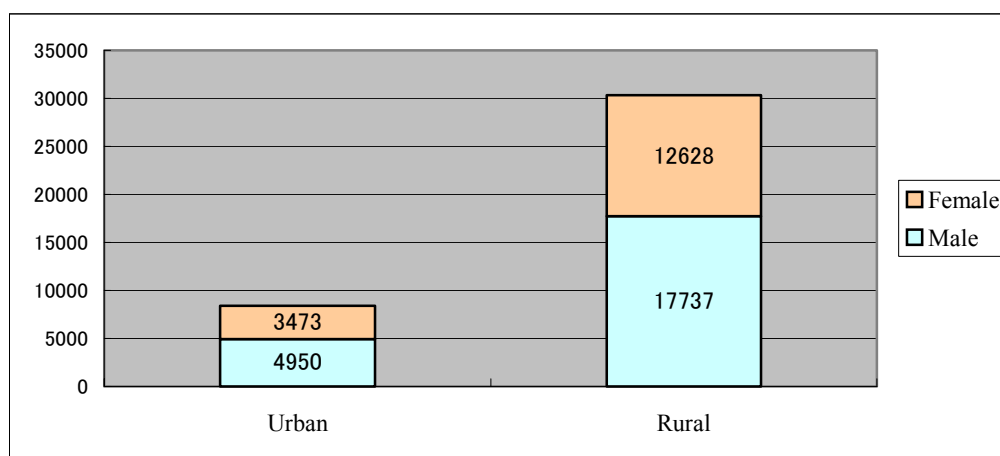

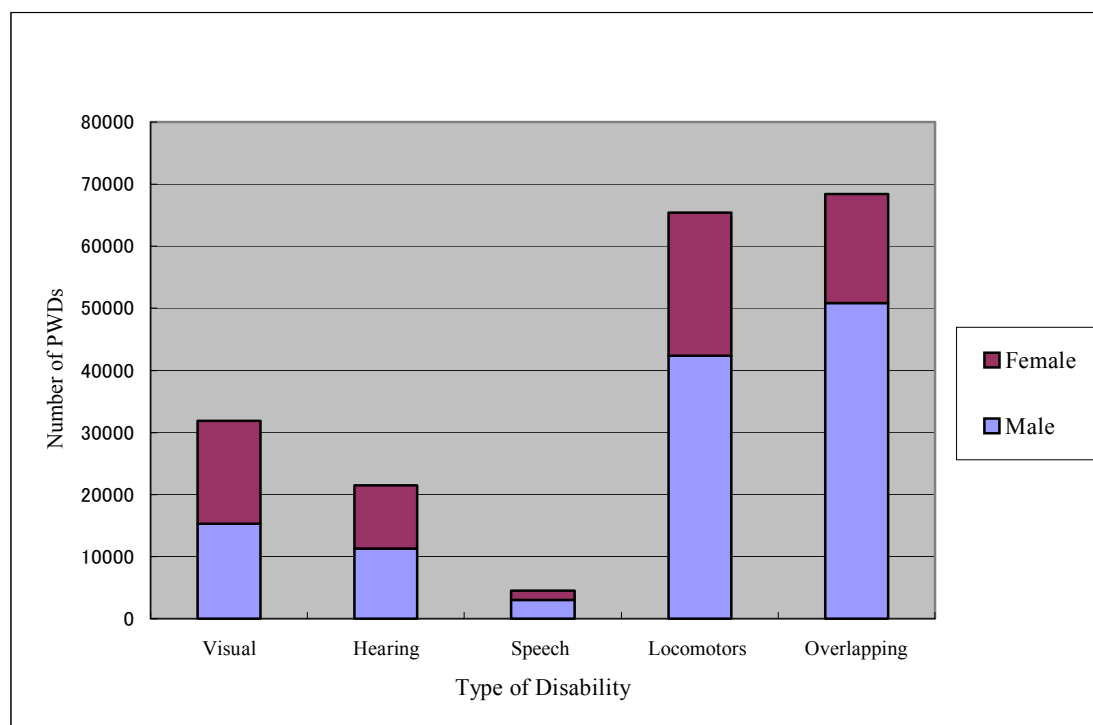
