Malaria in DRC:

Transmission almost year-round in most areas and has been worsened by the complex emergency circumstances in certain areas.

The Booster Response:

Malaria control interventions in DR Congo are being implemented through two projects:

1. The US\$150 million DRC Health Sector Rehabilitation Support Project (HSRSP) has a Malaria Booster component of US\$30 million and twenty million people are covered by the project in 150 zones. The project has a strong focus on “learning by doing” and will benefit from Annual Reviews for refinement based on solid evidence.
2. The recently approved US\$180 million Emergency Urban and Social Rehabilitation Project (EUSRB) capitalizes on the Bank’s multi-sector environment by including a US\$13 million dollar component that is focused on malaria control. The project will finance approximately two million nets in Kinshasa with the goal of distributing up to three long lasting insecticidal nets to each household as a means of reducing malaria-related infant mortality.
