Malaria in Malawi:

The most important public health problem in Malawi, accounting for 4 million cases annually.

The Booster Response:

Approved in May 2006, the Bank provides US\$5 million as additional financing to the current World Bank financed US\$15 million Health Sector Support Project (HSSP) which is a contribution to the entire Sector Wide Approach (SWAp) program. Just like the HSSP, the Booster Program resources are provided through basket funding, pooled together with funds from government, Norway, DFID, UNFPA and other development partners who may join in the future.

At the central level, the primary objective is to strengthen institutional processes to support an effective M&E system for the SWAp using malaria indicators as drivers.
