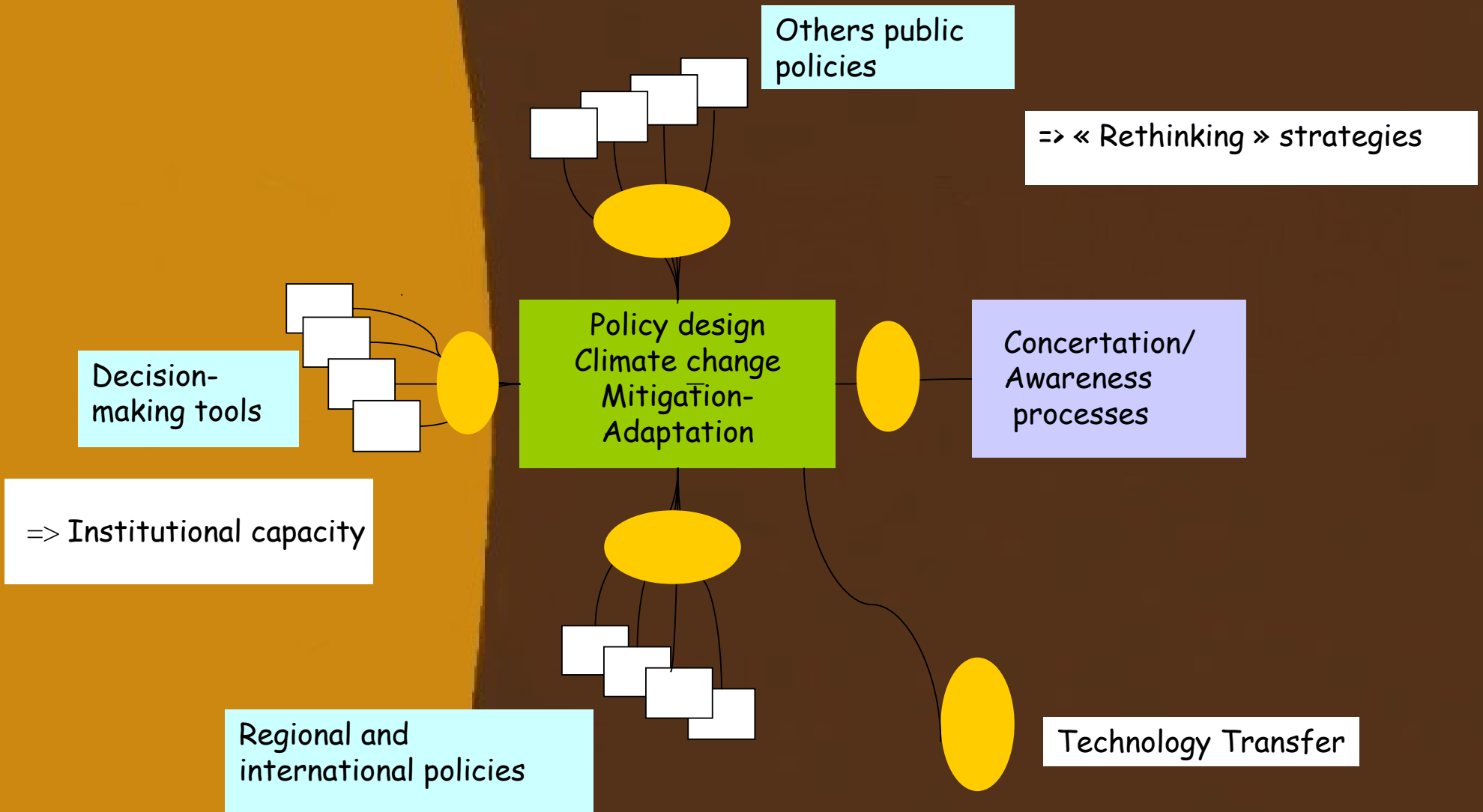
Short term implications of the integration of the climate change dimension (Mitigation and Adaptation)
