TERMS AND CONDITIONS

<p>1. CARE AND PRESERVATION</p> <p>a. The Borrower will use the same level of care with respect to the Objects described in this Agreement as it does with comparable property of its own.</p> <p>b. Objects, while in the Borrower's custody, will be reasonably protected from fire, theft, mishandling, dirt, insects, and extremes of light, temperature and humidity.</p> <p>c. It is understood by the Lender that all tangible objects are subject to gradual inherent deterioration for which the Borrower is not responsible.</p> <p>d. Evidence of damage to the Objects at the time of receipt or while in the Borrower's custody will be reported as soon as possible to the Lender.</p> <p>e. The Lender certifies that the Objects are in such condition as to withstand ordinary strains of packing, transportation, handling, and display.</p>	<p>4. INSURANCE DURING LOAN</p> <p>a. Transportation and insurance costs incurred during the loan are to be paid by the Borrower unless specifically noted otherwise.</p> <p>b. Each object shall be insured at the Borrower's expense for the benefit of the Lender against all risks of physical loss or damage for any external cause while in transit and on location during the period of the loan. Required insurance shall be arranged by either the Borrower or the Lender and agreed to by the Lender before any objects may be removed from the lending site. If insured by the Borrower, the objects shall be covered wall-to-wall by the amount set forth under Insurance Value on the reverse of this form.</p> <p>c. If insurance is waived by the Lender in accordance with written specification as indicated on the reverse of this form, this waiver shall constitute the agreement of the Lender to release and hold harmless the Borrower from any liability for damage to or loss of the Object.</p>
<p>2. PACKING AND TRANSPORTATION</p> <p>a. The Borrower and the Lender will agree on the method of packing and shipping to and from the Borrower. Objects should be returned carefully packed in the same manner as received and by a competent carrier.</p> <p>b. All handling, packing, transportation, and insurance costs incurred during the loan are to be paid by the Borrower unless specifically noted otherwise.</p> <p>c. The Lender is responsible for providing the carrier with the necessary documentation for temporary exportation and re- importation of artwork(s) to be included in this exhibition.</p>	<p>5. POSSESSION AND RETURN OF LOANS</p> <p>a. The Borrower retains the right to determine when, if, and for how long objects borrowed will be exhibited.</p> <p>b. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the Borrower will return the objects only to the Lender at the end of the duration of the loan as specified in this Agreement. In case of change of legal ownership during the period of the loan, the new owner will be required to establish his or her legal title by proof satisfactory to the borrower.</p> <p>c. The Lender cannot ask for a rental fee on any artwork(s) lent for this exhibition.</p>
<p>3. REPRODUCTION AND CREDIT</p> <p>a. Unless otherwise specified in the Agreement, the Borrower may photograph or reproduce the Objects lent for educational, cataloguing, and publicity purposes. No reproduction fees will be paid to the Lender, even in the case of catalogue sales. It is understood that Objects on exhibit may be photographed by the general public.</p> <p>b. Unless otherwise specified in the Agreement, the Borrower will, in any catalogue or publication, give credit to the Lender as specified on the face of this agreement. Whether individual labels are provided for Objects on display is at the discretion of the Borrower.</p>
