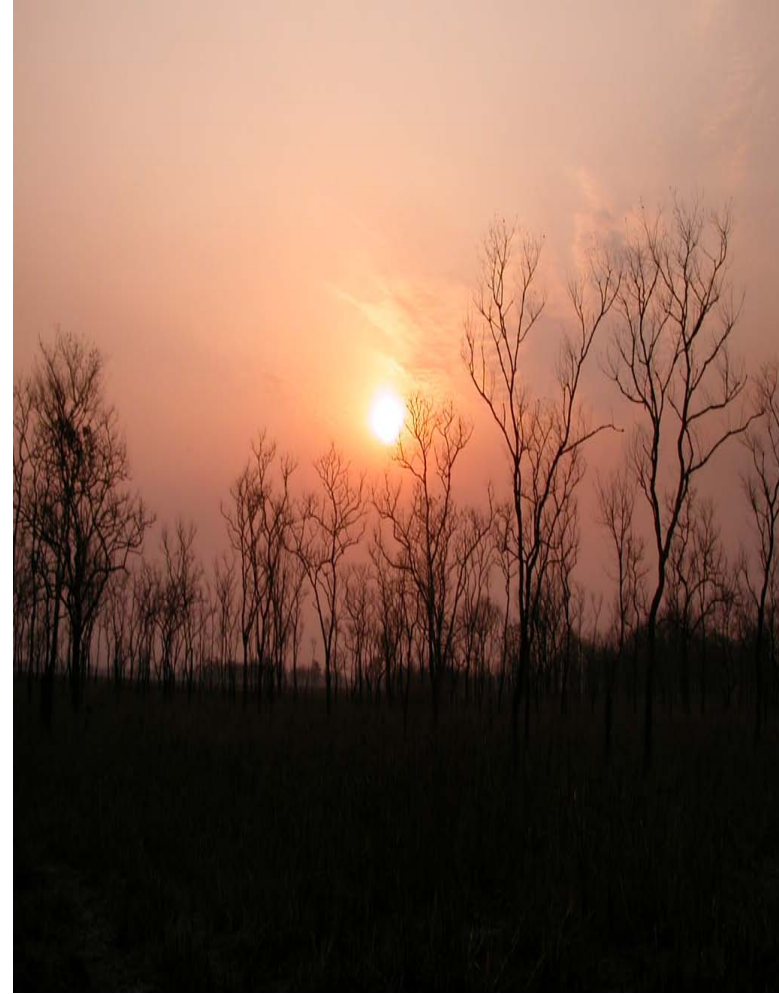
Response I

- A very **progressive** and **comprehensive** report
- A **balanced critical appreciation** of overall status of PwD in India.
- Getting the basics right –
Statistics – Unicef Microplanning data
- **5160 villages in Amrawati, Chandrapur, Latur, Nandurbar and Yavatmal**
9% to 11%

- **Regional imbalance**
- **Sense of urgency**
- **NGOs Role - Promoting Rights based approach**

- **Low/No visibility in the major national program and lack of strategy and design to increase visibility**



Response II

- **Importance of recreation. Most neglected field in the Government system. Very few NGOs interested. Sports authority of India not in the picture. Cultural ministry has no agenda**
- **Designing methodology towards diverse and expansive meaning of Access.**
- **No agenda at DPDC. Devise mechanism to orient and institutionalize disability component at PRI and in the DPDC.**
