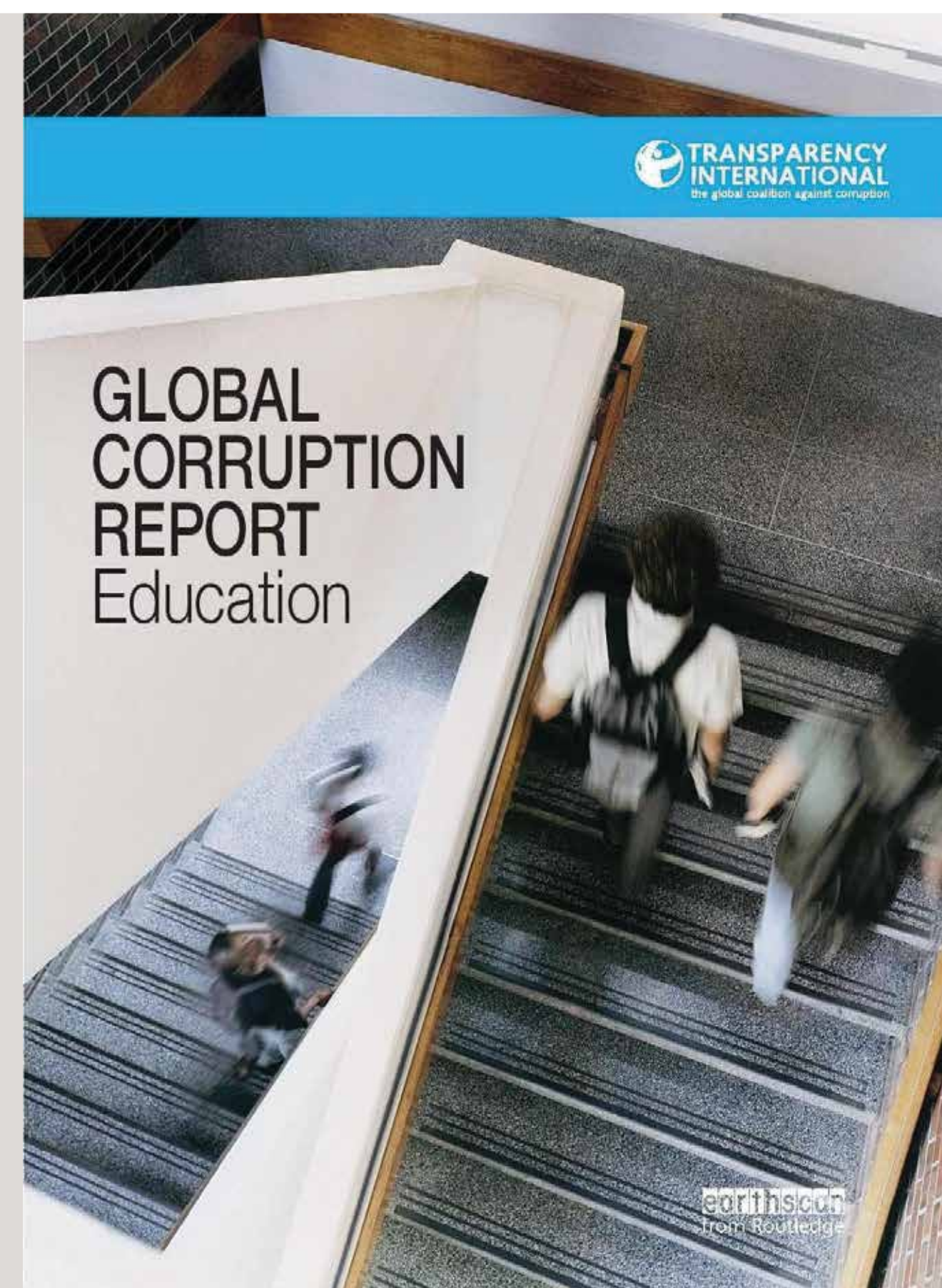


The Cost of Corruption in Education
