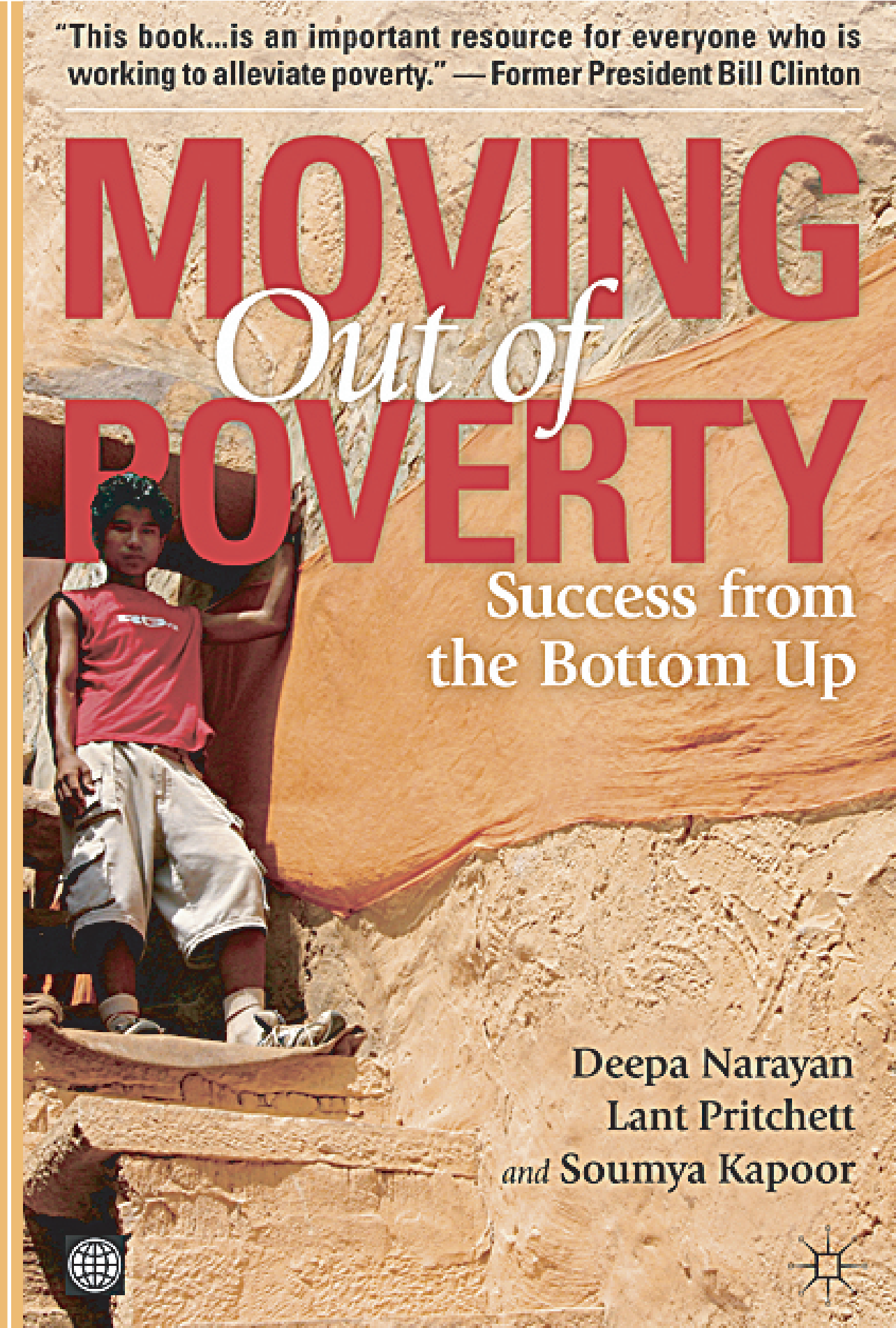


## MOVING OUT OF POVERTY SUCCESS FROM THE BOTTOM UP

Poverty studies typically focus on people who live below the poverty line. Few studies have examined how people not only move out of poverty, but also stay out of poverty. The second volume of the Moving Out of Poverty project, *Success from the Bottom Up*, represents one of the few large-scale comparative research attempts to address these questions. The book is based on life stories, interviews and questionnaires with more than 60,000 people in Africa, East Asia, South Asia, and Latin America.
