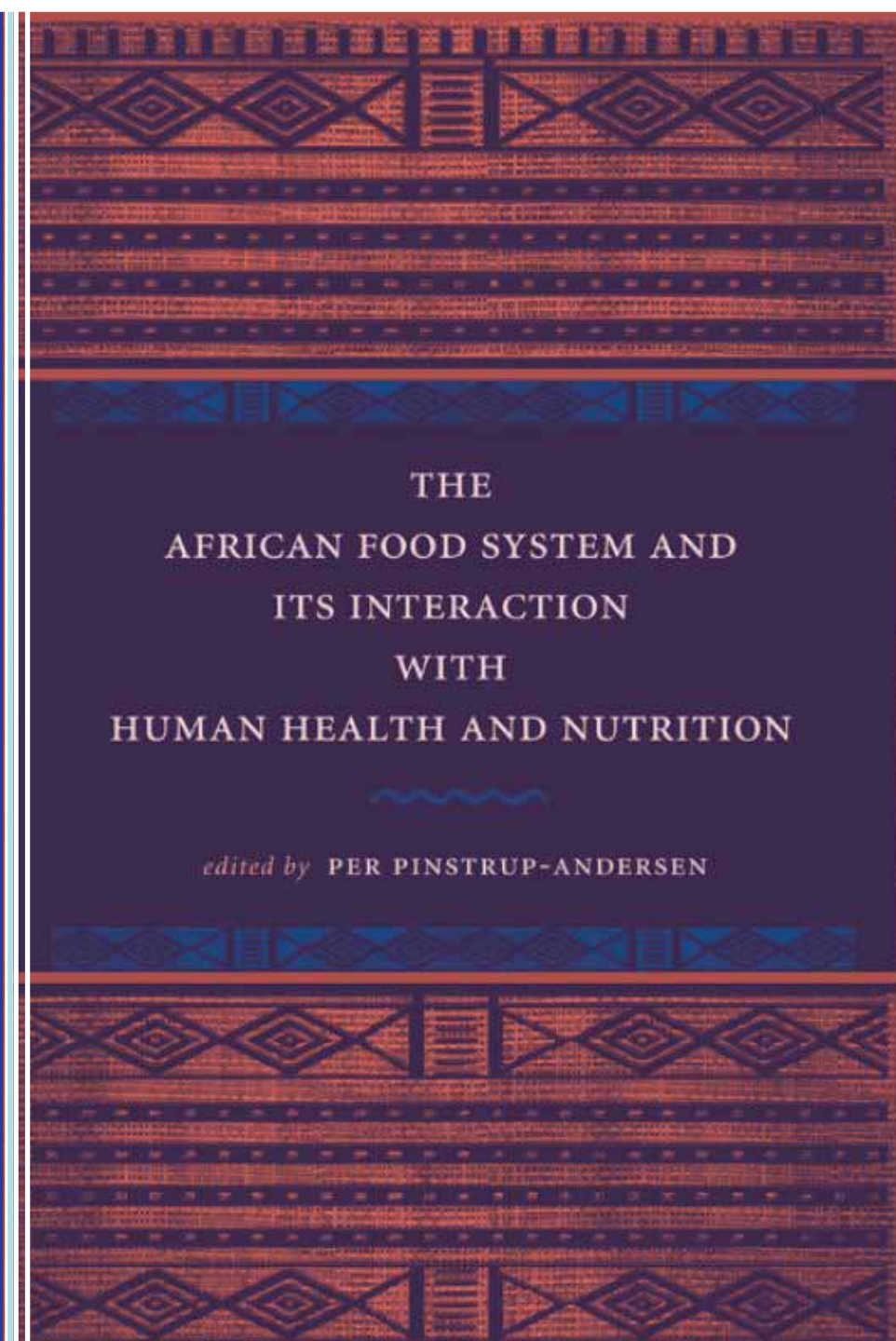




# The African Food System & its Interaction with Human Health & Nutrition
