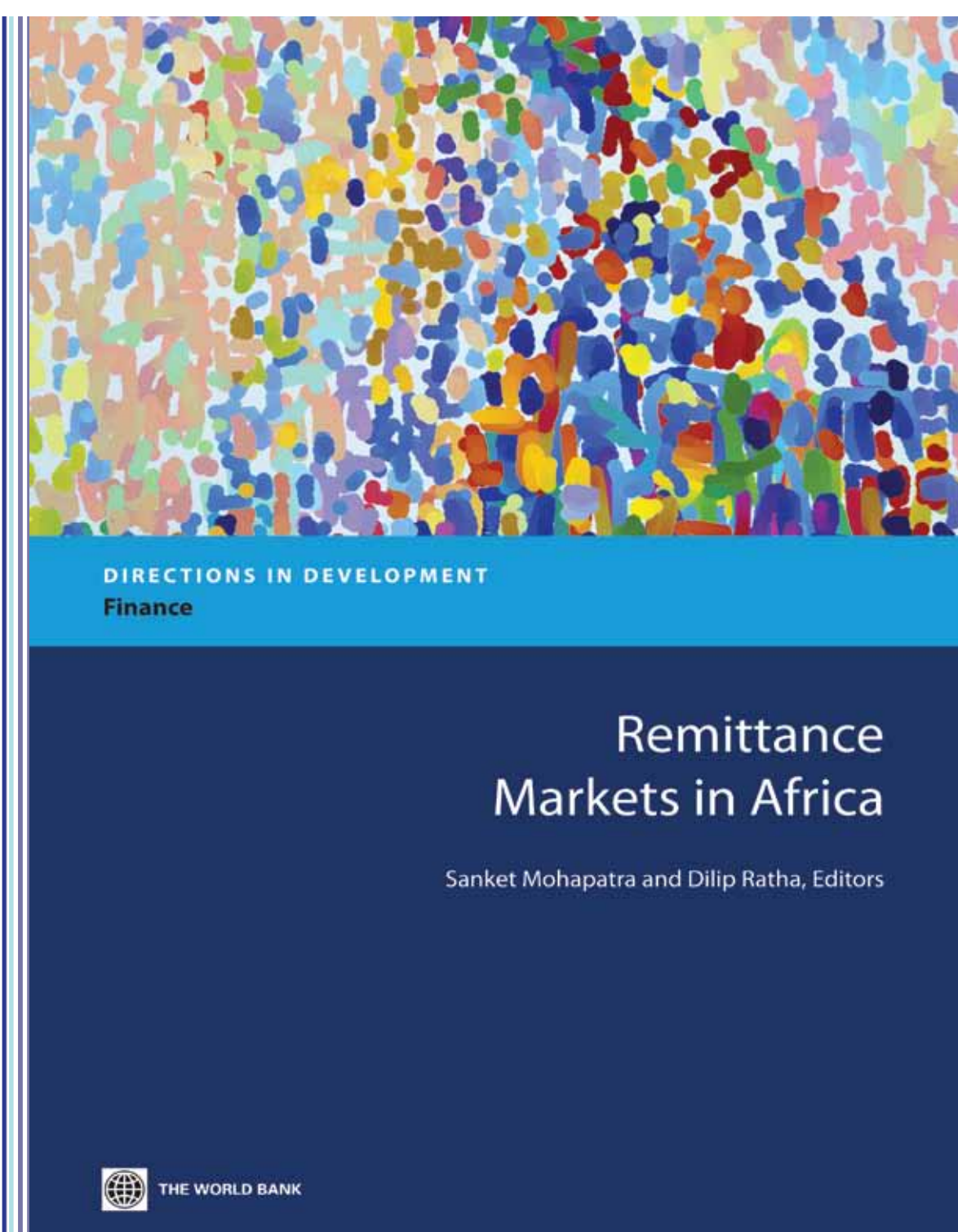


Remittance Markets in Africa
