The President of Ecuador, Rafael Correa, announced in 2007 that he would not exploit Ecuador's largest bloc of undeveloped oil reserves, called Ishpingo-Tambococha-Tiputini (ITT), in return for financial compensation from industrialized countries. This film tells the three-year story of Correa's team as they try to show the international community, both north and south, that it would gain by supporting this model of post-petroleum era sustainable development.
