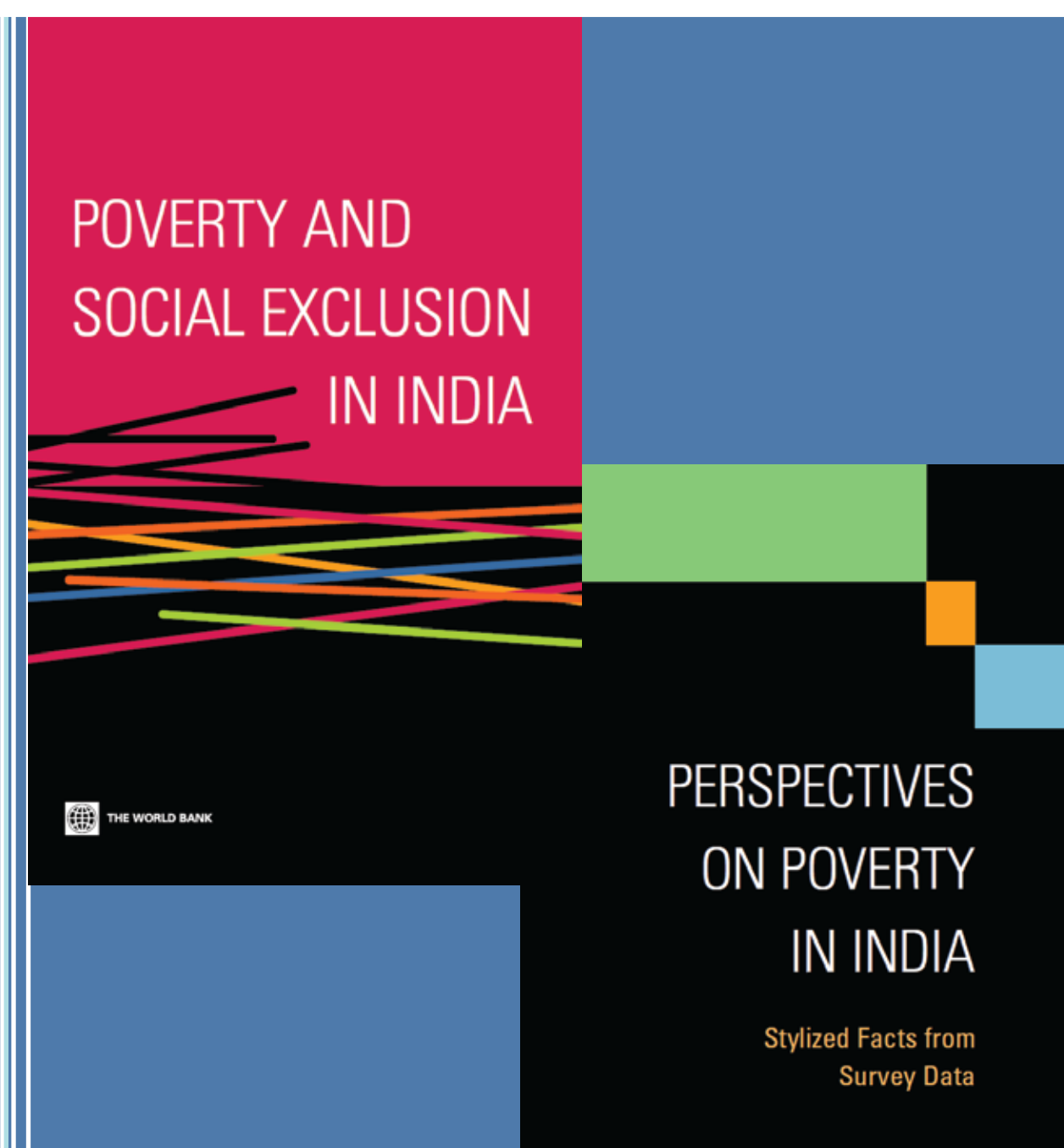


## Perspectives on Poverty & Exclusion in India
