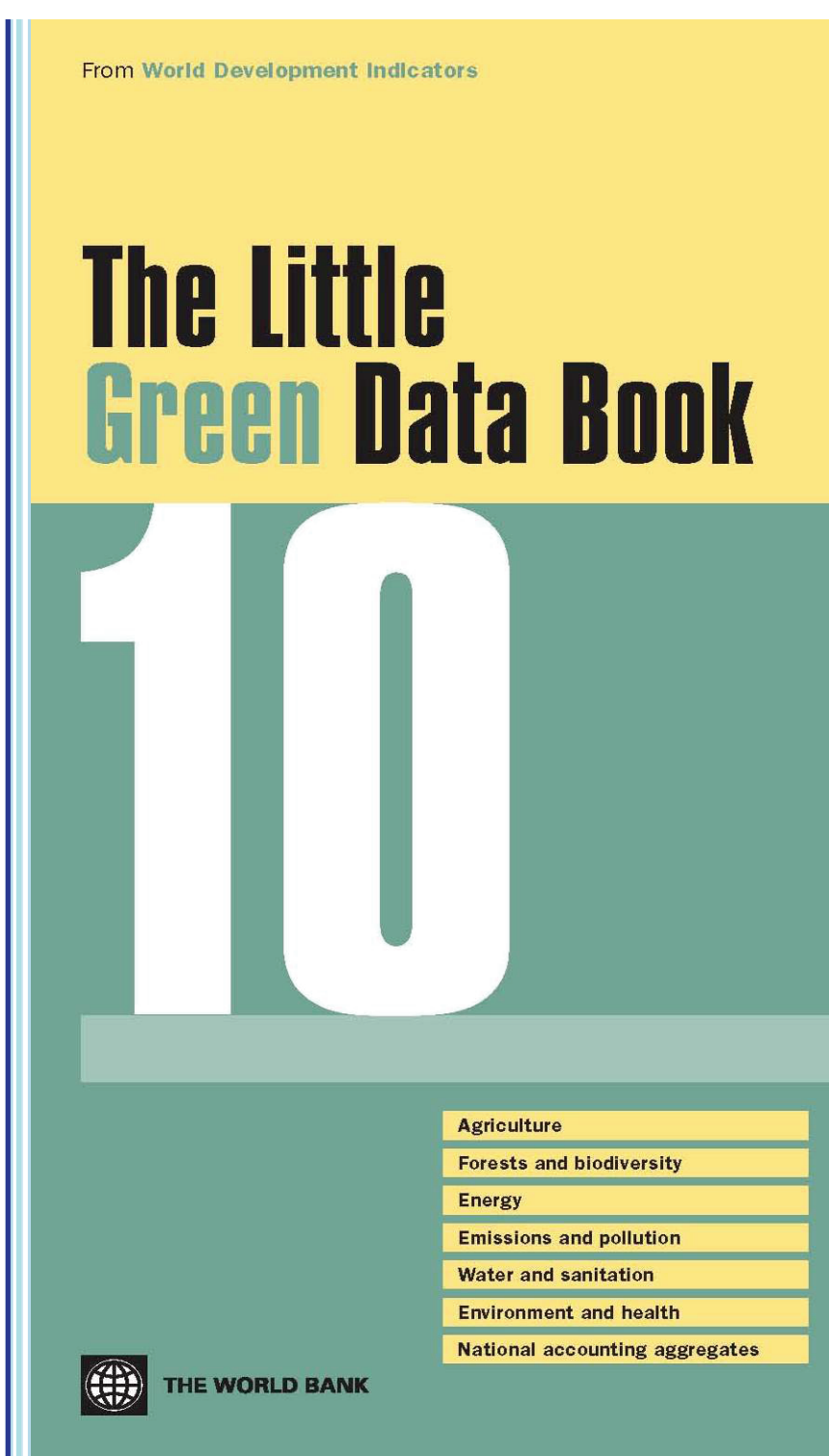


10 Years of The Little Green Data Book
