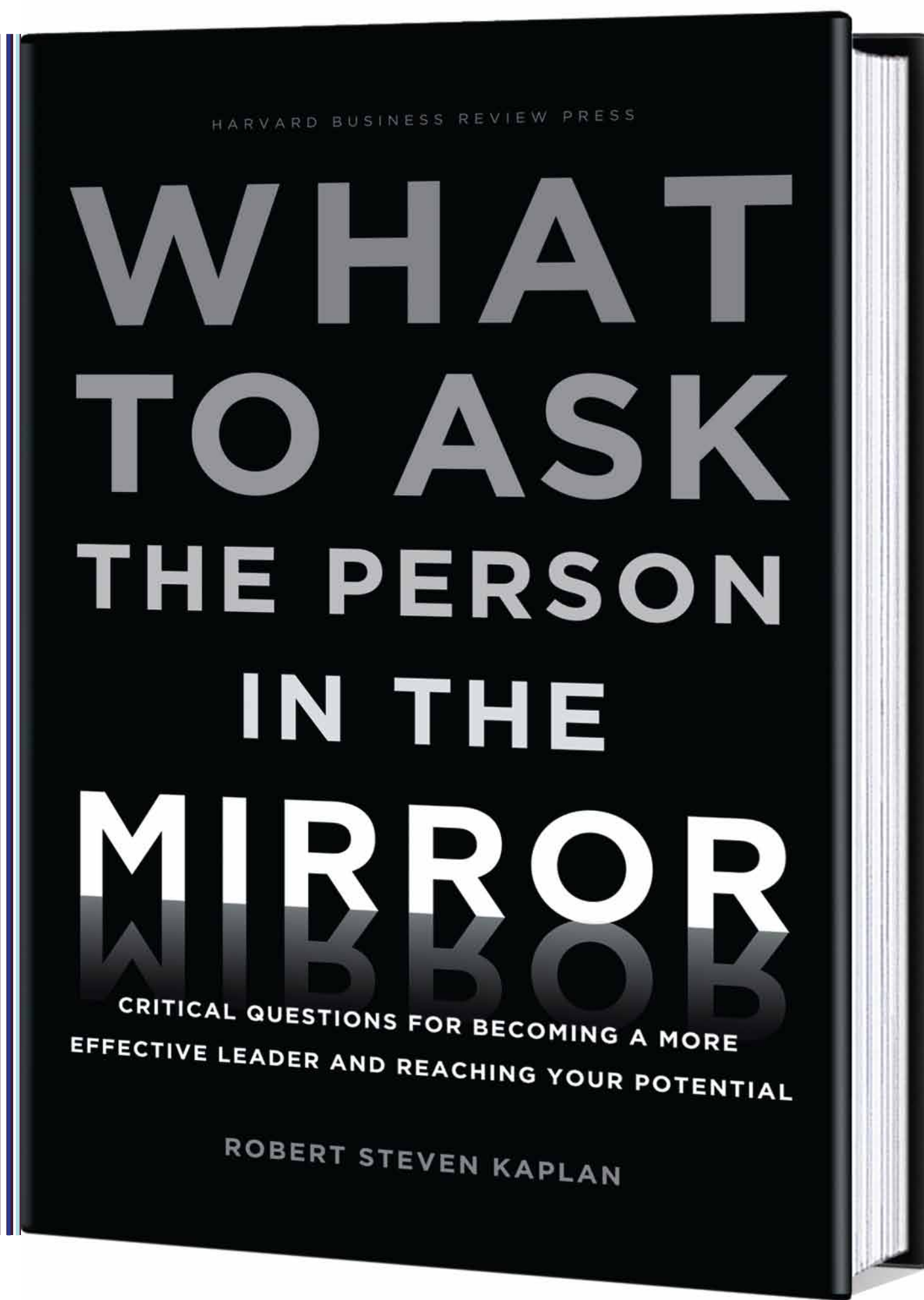


## What to Ask the Person in the Mirror
