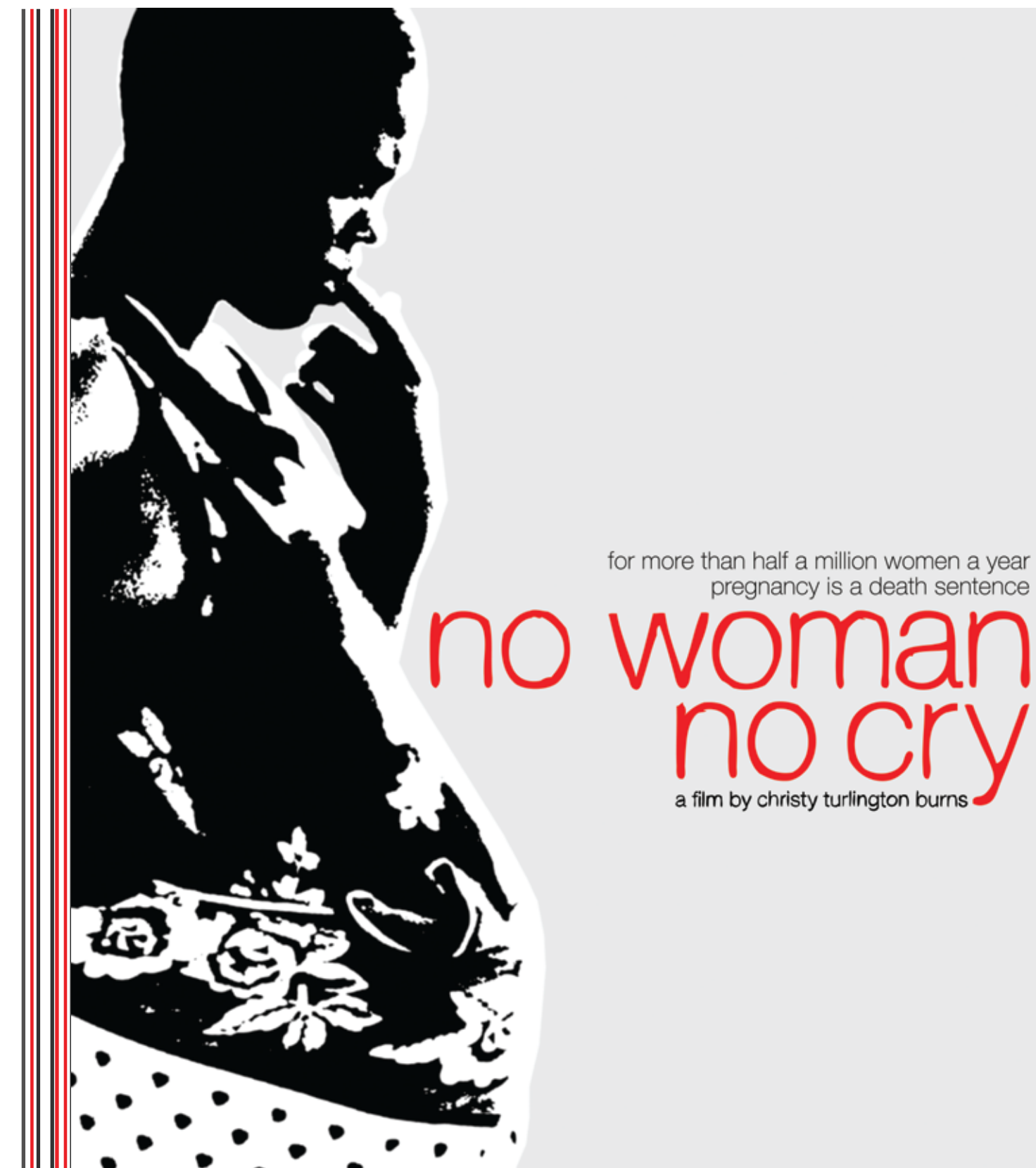


No Woman, No Cry
