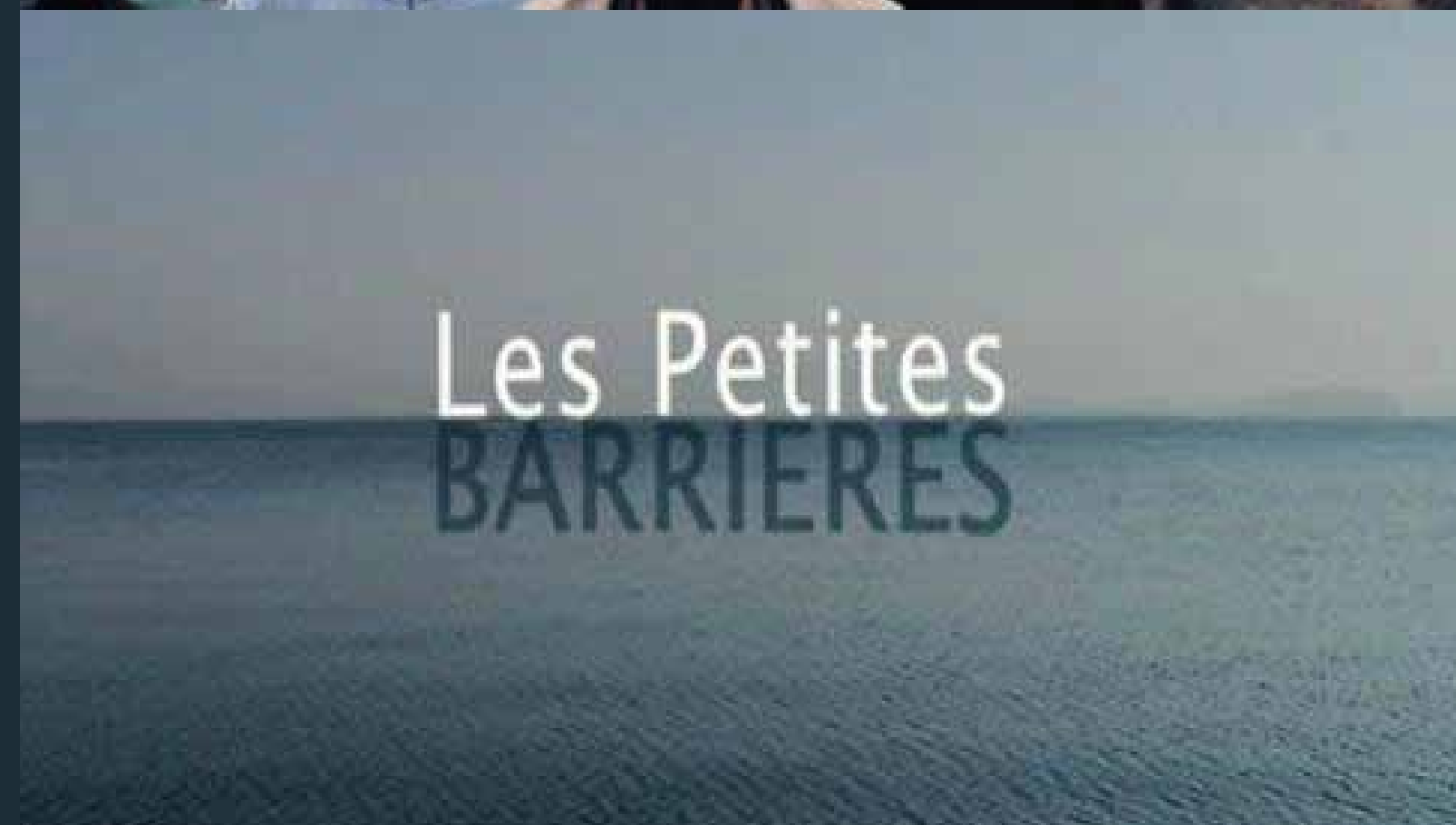
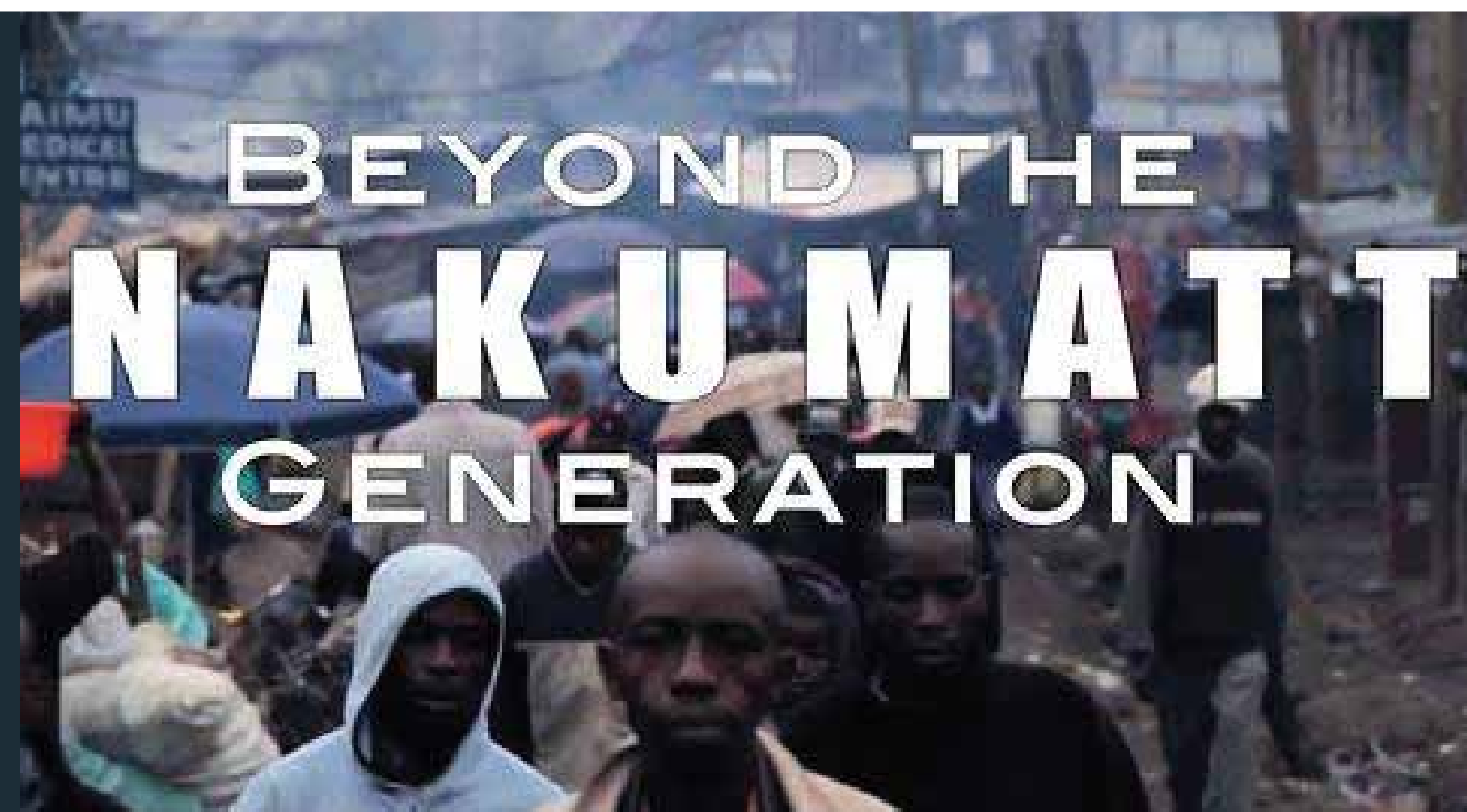


Double film feature to highlight the major obstacles small traders and farmers face in Africa.
