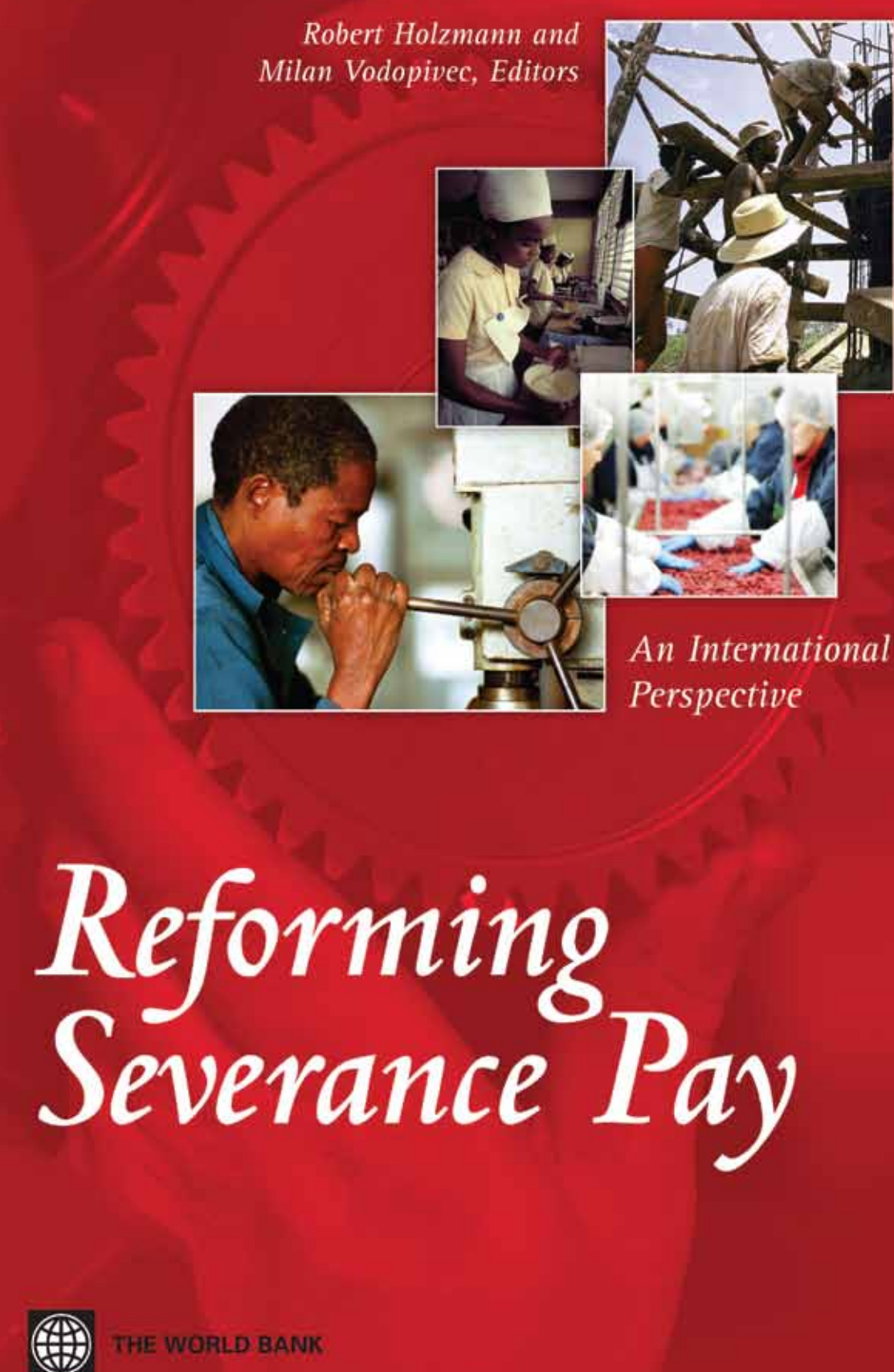


Reforming Severance Pay
