Africa Emergency Locust Project	3/3/2005	11/30/2005	6/30/2009	9.1	7.6	The regional project (covering Chad, Niger, Burkina Faso, Mali, Mauritania, Senegal, and The Gambia) aims to help reduce hardships such as crop and livestock losses, delayed effects from lost productive assets, and reduced income opportunities caused by locust invasions; and to minimize the risks posed to people and the environment from application, handling, and storage of pesticides. The project also seeks to reduce the vulnerability of the concerned countries to future infestations by supporting improved strategies for prevention, early warning, reaction, and mitigation at both the national and regional levels. Regional collective action is required to respond to this regional plague.

The proposed project would support this objective by financing productivity-raising interventions and strengthening the institutional and technical capacities of producer organizations, government institutions, and private support services.

In terms of education, this means providing universal quality basic education by 2015. This project is the first 5-year phase of this long term endeavor, which is one of in-depth policy and institutional reforms. Its objective is to ensure that the framework for quality universal basic education is in place and ready for implementation. It places an emphasis on developing an effective partnership between the State and the communities, creating a national technical capacity for curricula and textbook development, and improving basic education quality and efficiency. At the end of the project, these objectives will translate into stronger institutional and managerial capacity, increased enrollment rates, more equitable access and better education quality and efficiency.

This is also the objective of the National Transport Program which is financed only in part by the project (roughly 25%), and in part by other donors and the Government.

Petroleum Sector Management Capacity Building Project	7/7/2000	3/23/2001	12/31/2006	23.7	0.07	This project sets out to strengthen Chad's capacity to manage petroleum resources within environmental and socially sound practices, and establish a framework for private sector investments in the petroleum sector. Through technical assistance such as training government staff, the project develops the country's capacity in legal, financial, and environmental aspects of petroleum resources (such as implementing a National Environmental Framework, and collecting geological information and other data). Logistic support provided by the project focuses on the engineering monitoring and evaluation of the Doba oil field area and along the pipeline, and sponsors private investments.

Achievement of these objectives will be measured by the following in project areas: an increase in the coverage of basic health services, the percentage of operational health districts, and an increase in health facilities utilization rates.
