**NOTE CONCERNING PARAGRAPH 147 IN THE REPORT OF THE IAG's 12th MISSION**

**Paragraph 147 should read as follows.**

147. • The *Ministère de l'Éducation*, the *Ministère de la Santé* and the *Ministère de l'Hydraulique* (for potable water supply system projects only) are concerned by the fact that the ***Ministère des Infrastructures executes their capital spending***, and worry that they no longer have control over their planning. They criticize the high unit costs and the *Ministère des Infrastructures'* lack of compliance with school and health-zone maps. The Ministry, on the other hand, says that it is correcting inconsistencies between the budget plans it receives and the realities in the field and that, in accordance with Department policy, it favors infrastructure projects that are more durable rather than less costly but more fragile.
