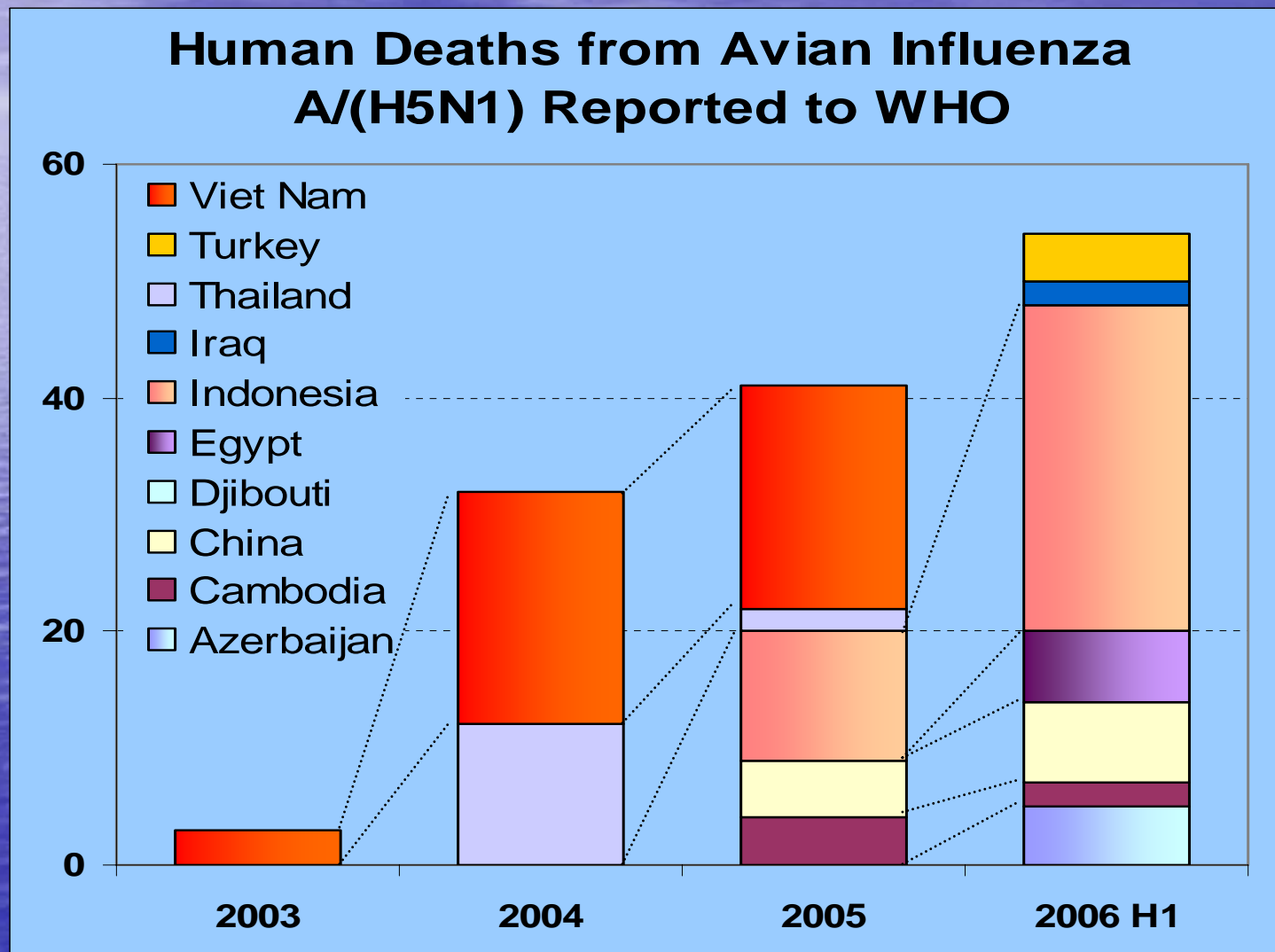

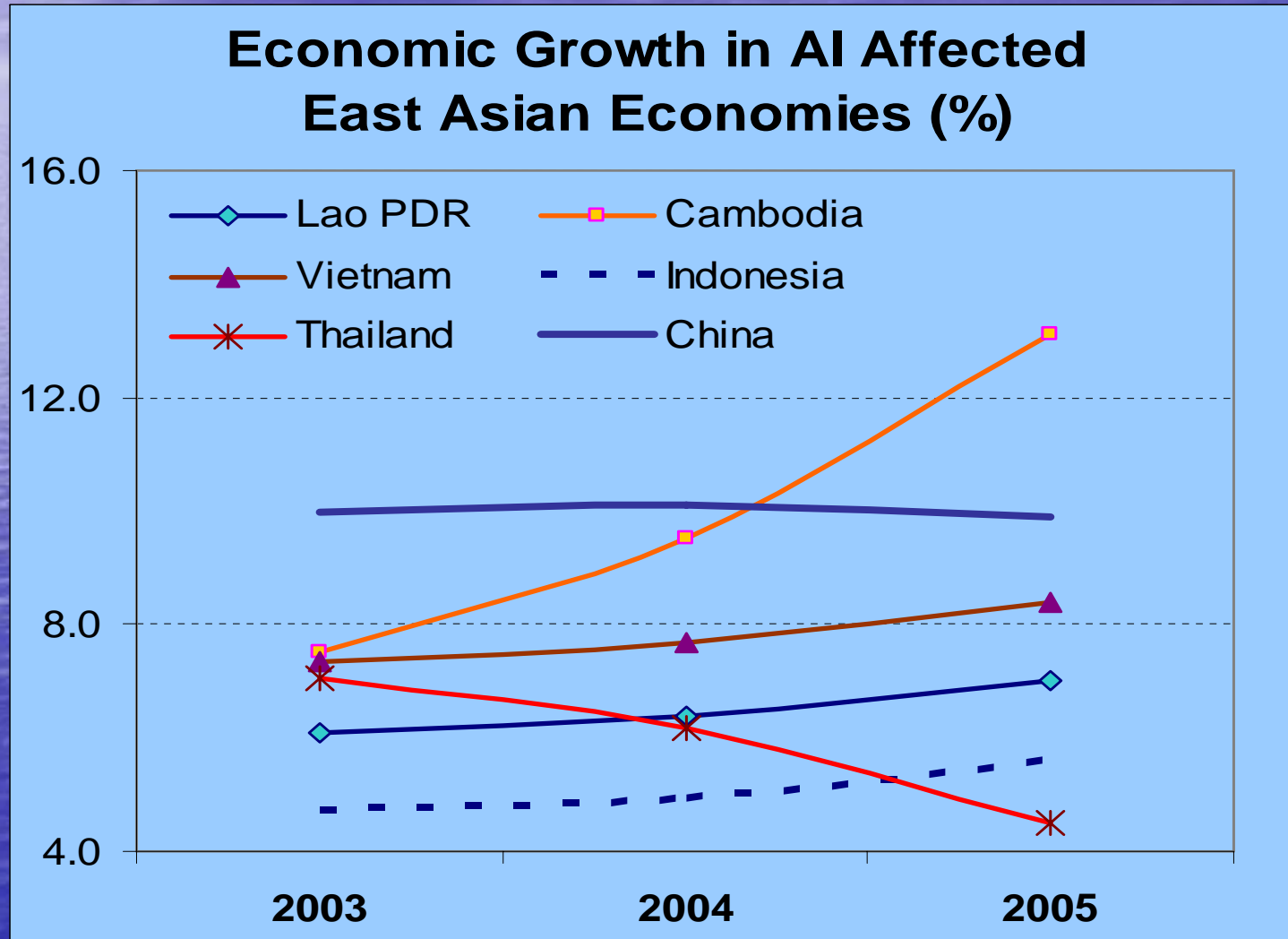

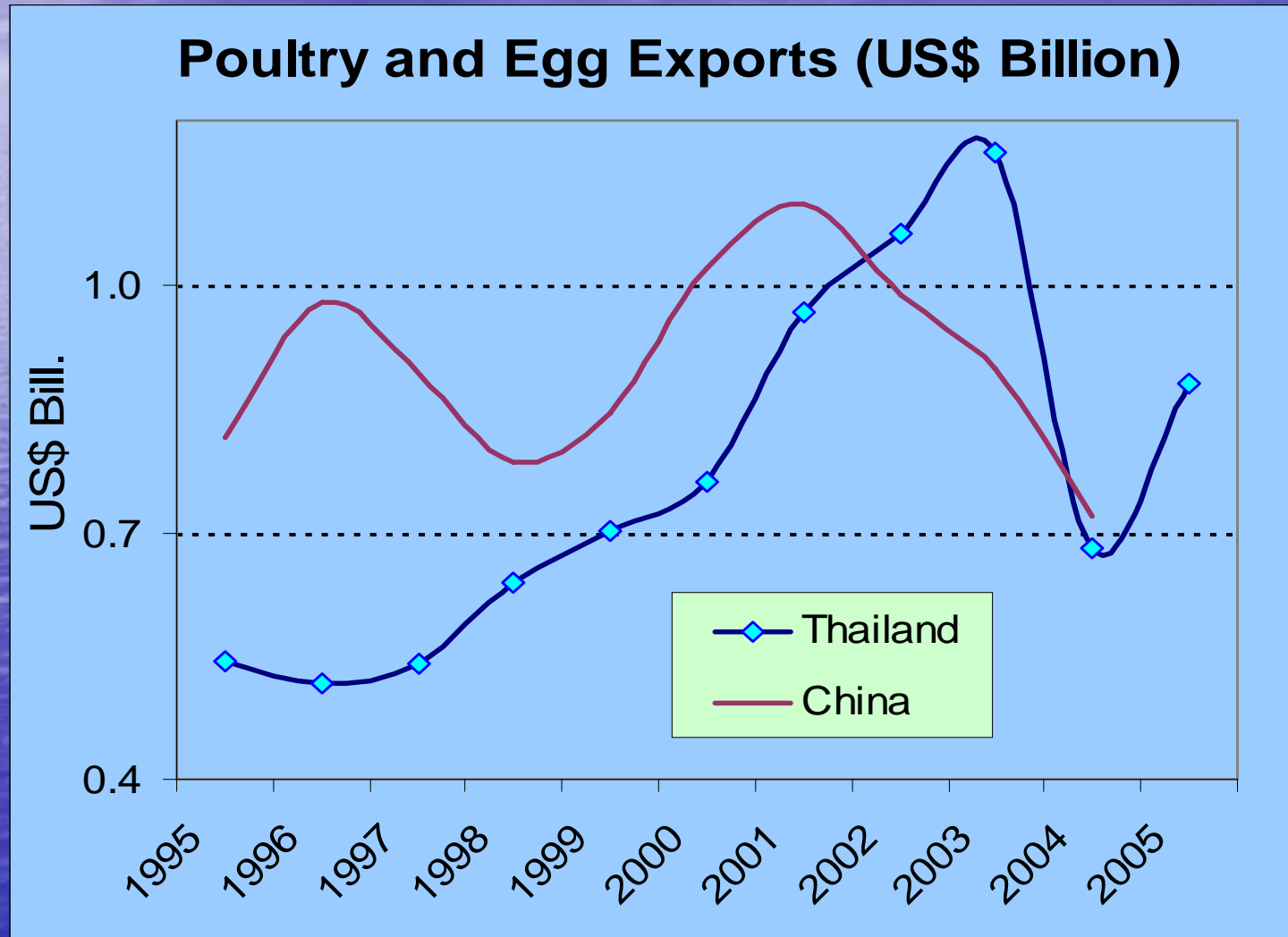
# Acceleration in Human Infections and Deaths in 2006



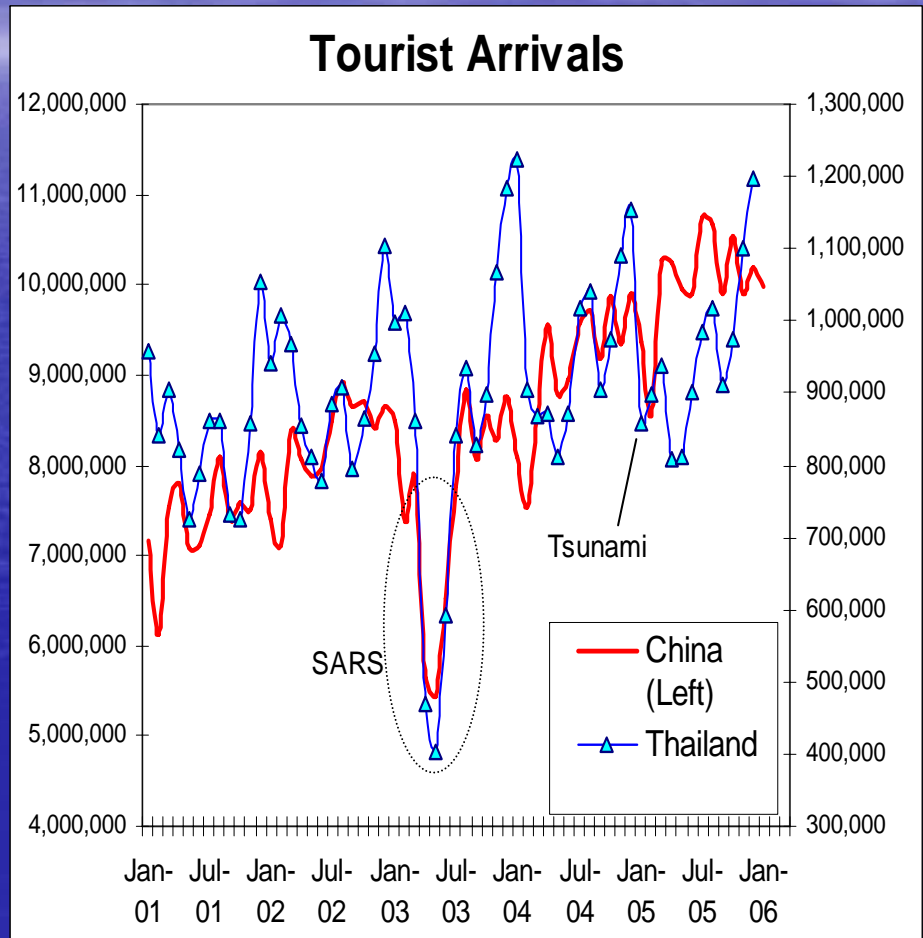
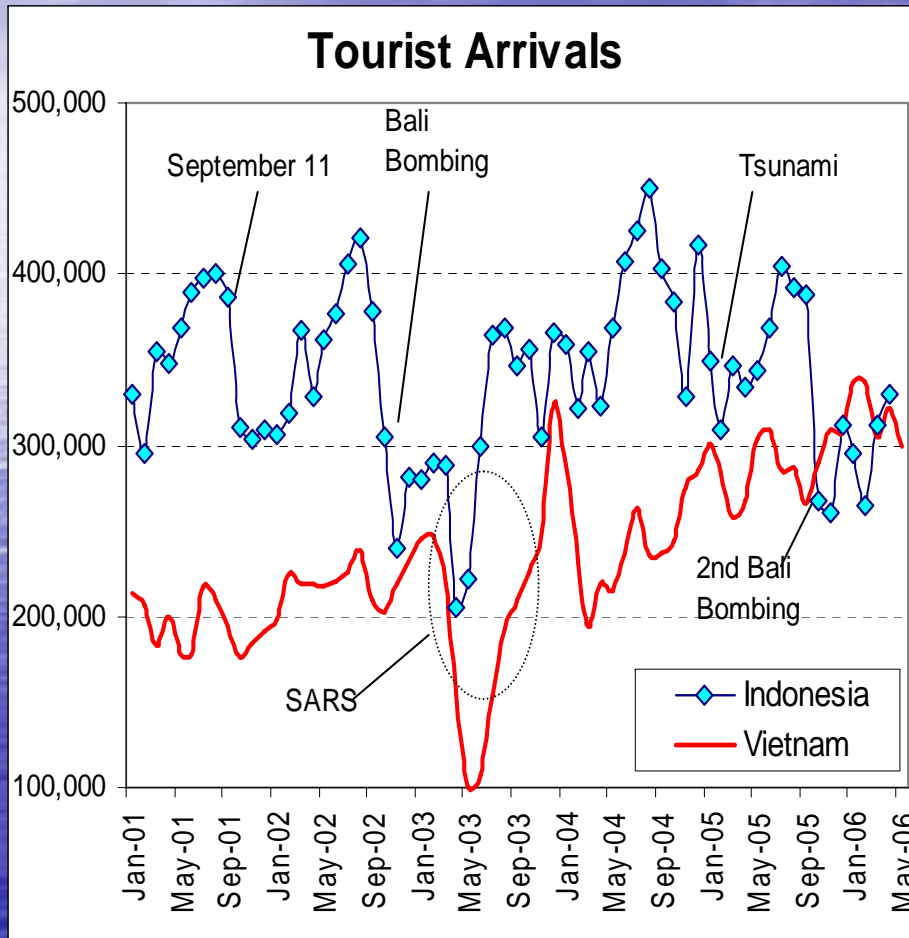
# Little impact on East Asian growth overall ...except Thailand



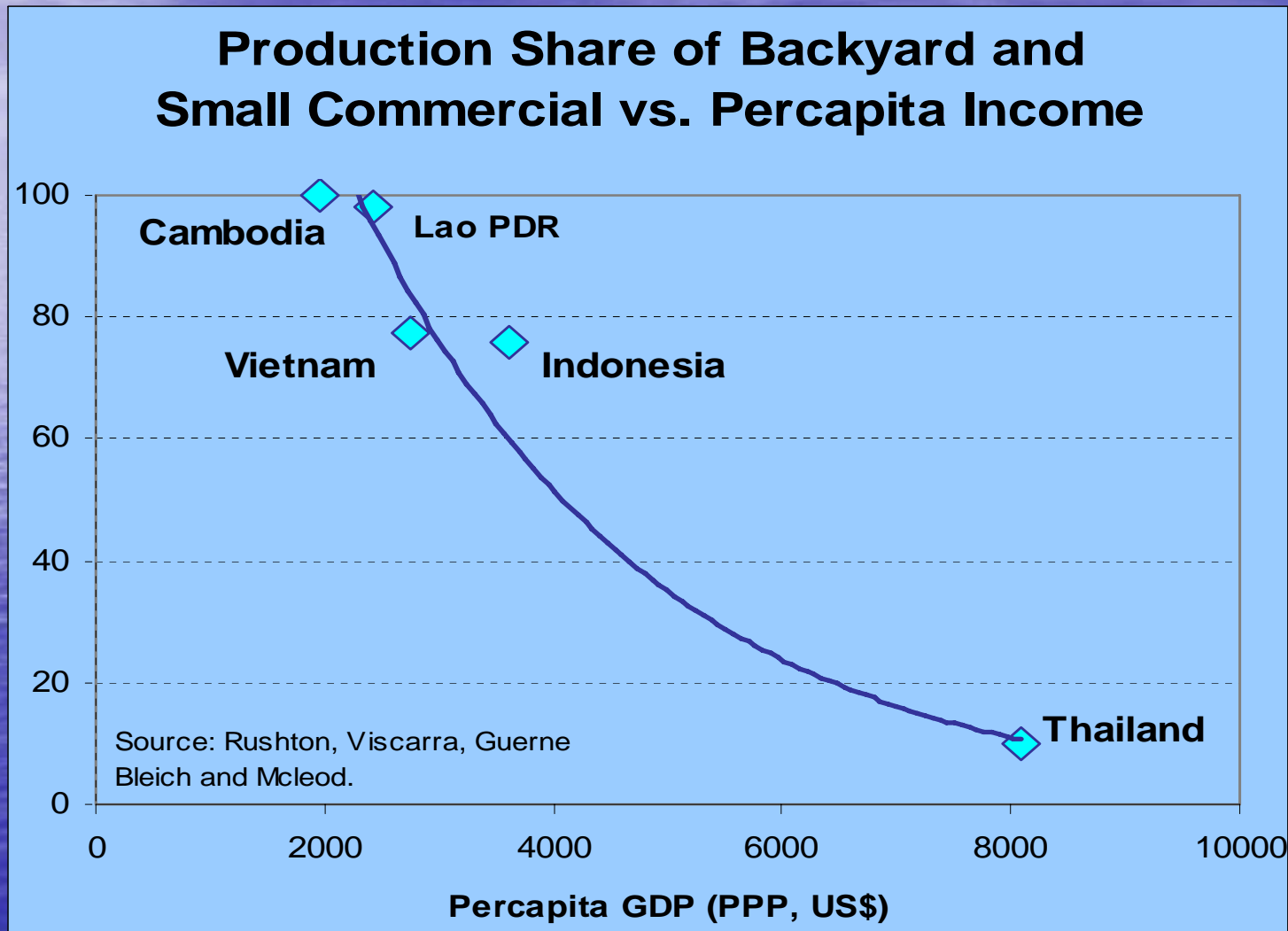
# 40 percent drop in Thai poultry exports



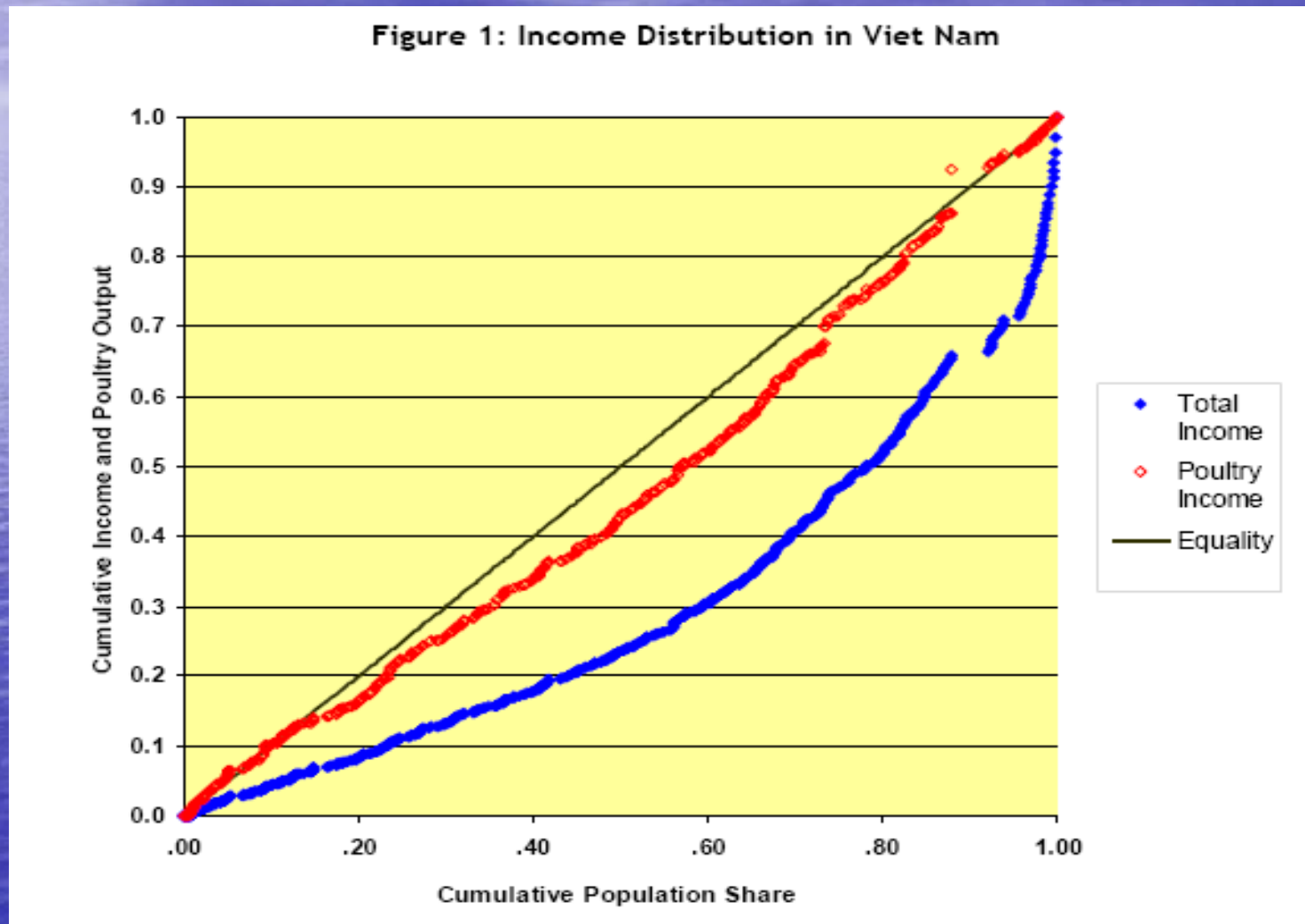
# Little Noticeable Impact on Tourist Arrivals



# Backyard production prevalent in low income economies

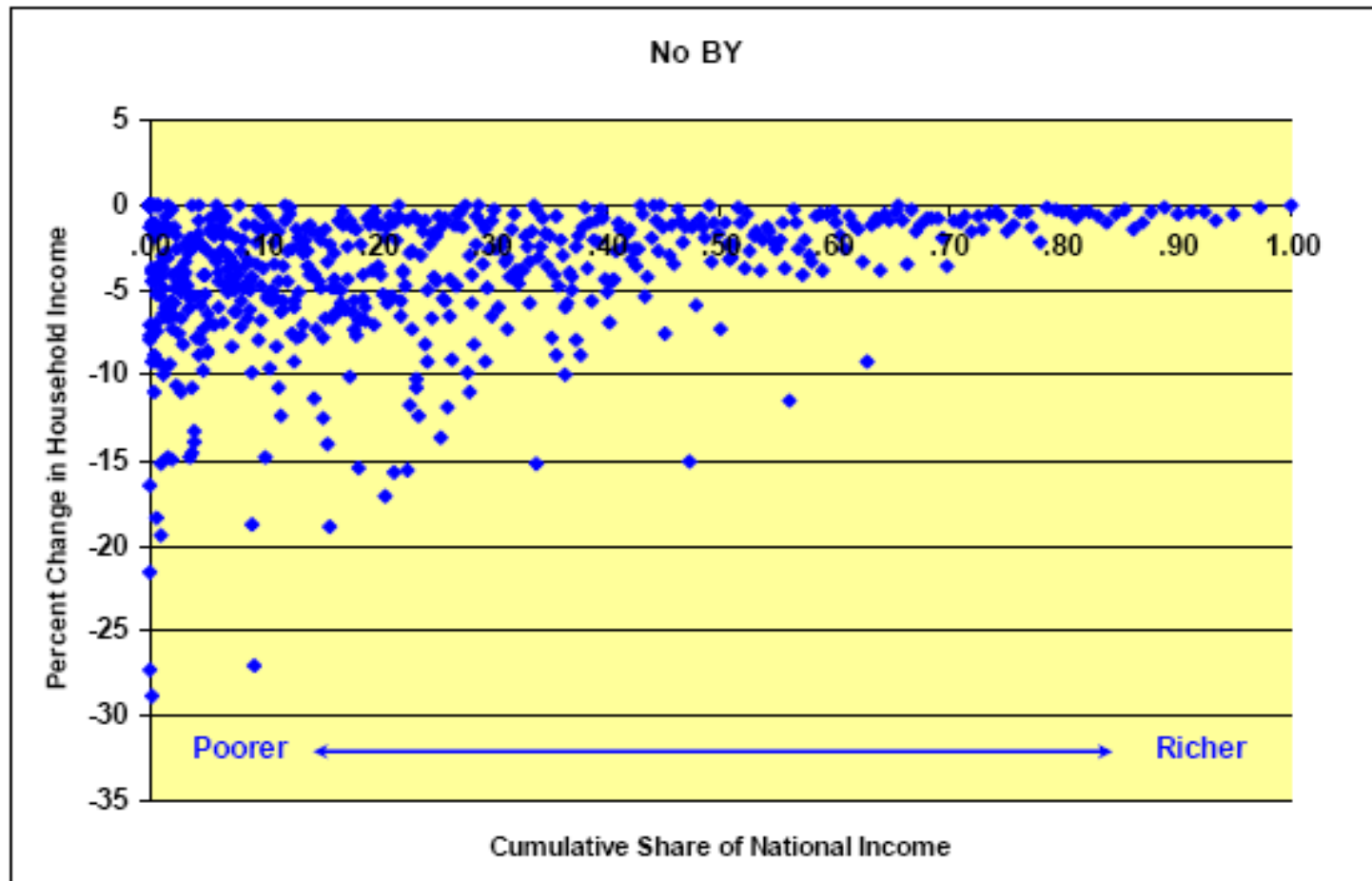


# Poultry income more equally distributed than total income in Vietnam

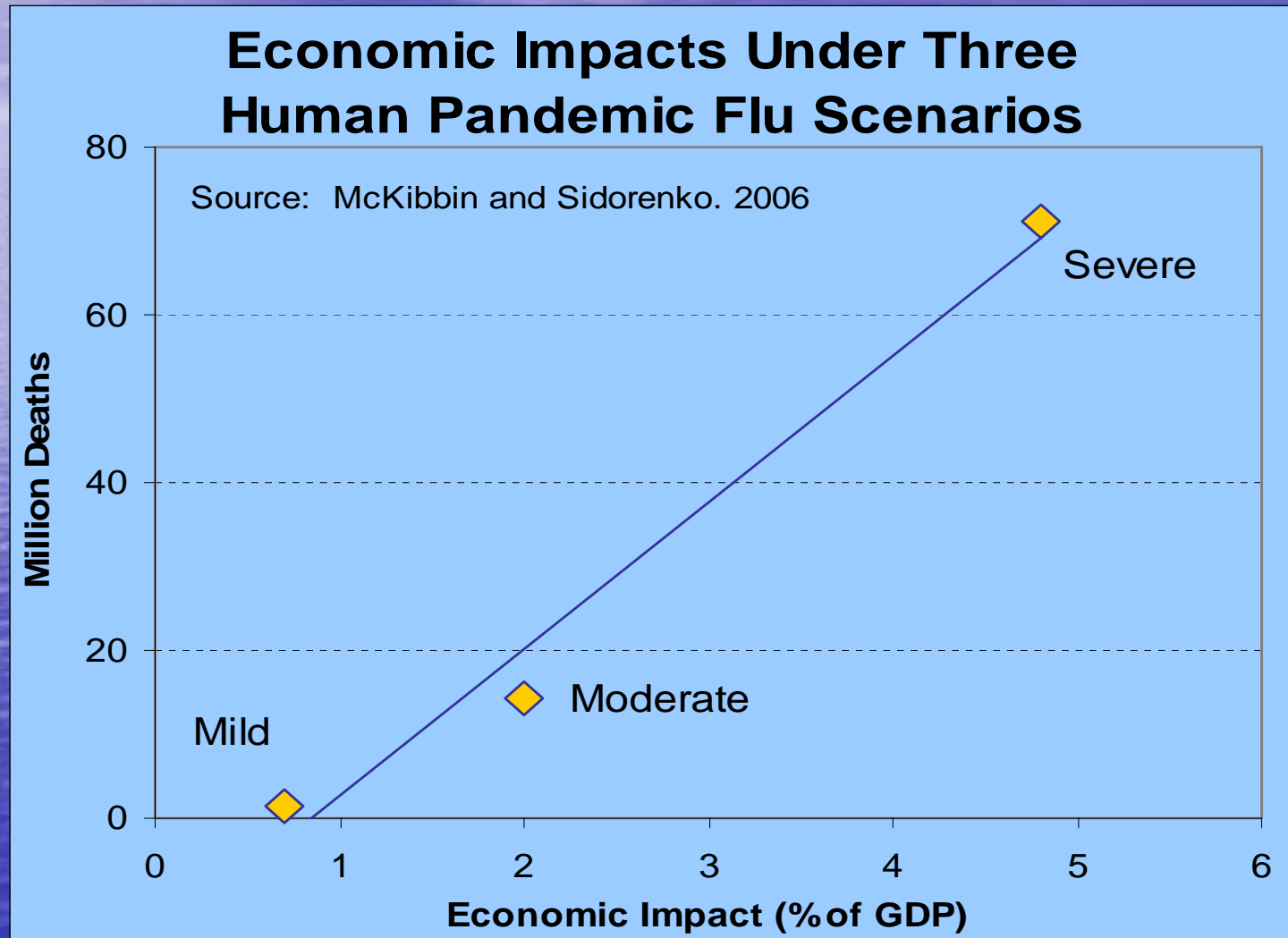


# Poor Hurt More by a Poultry Sale Ban
