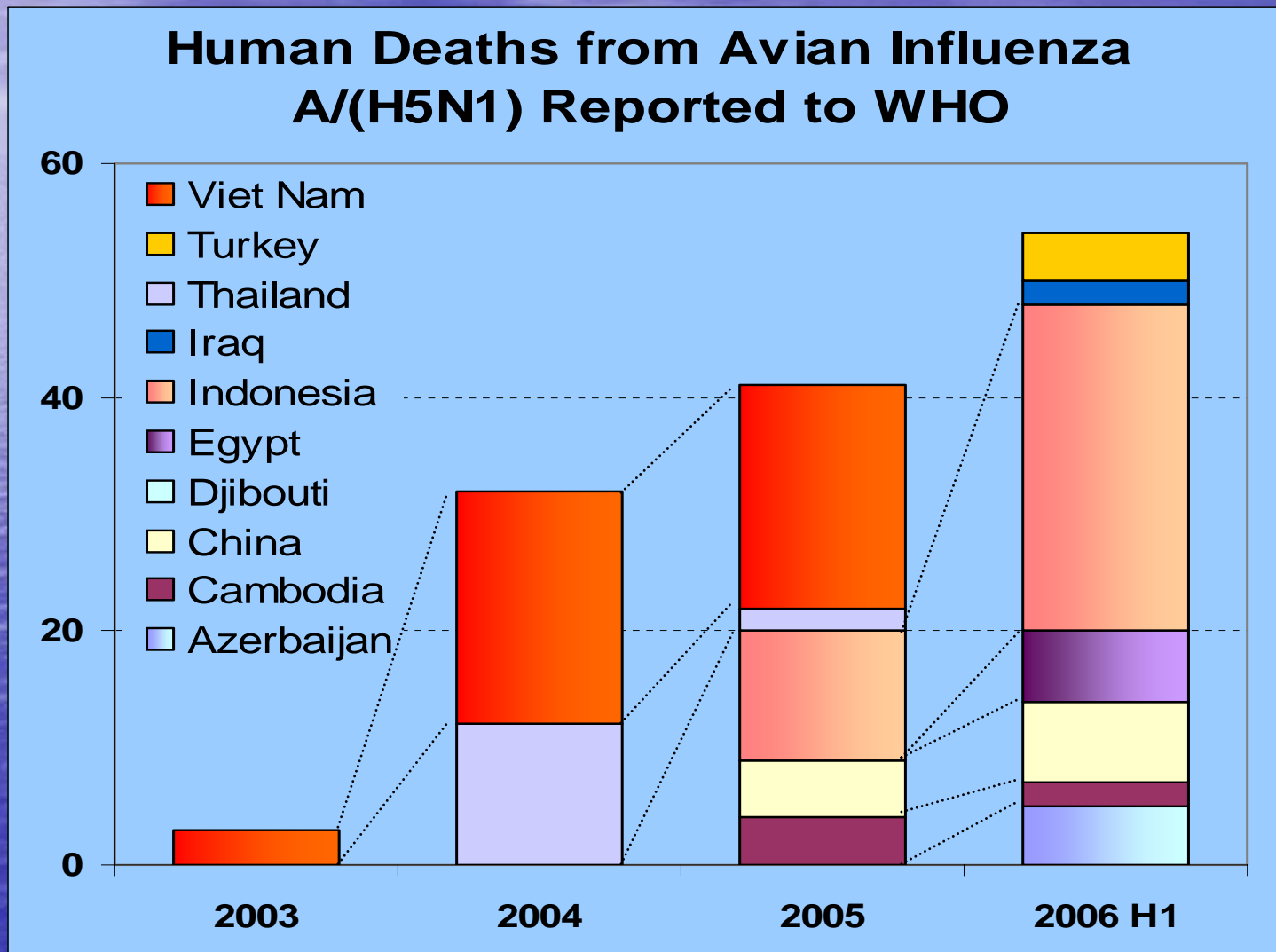

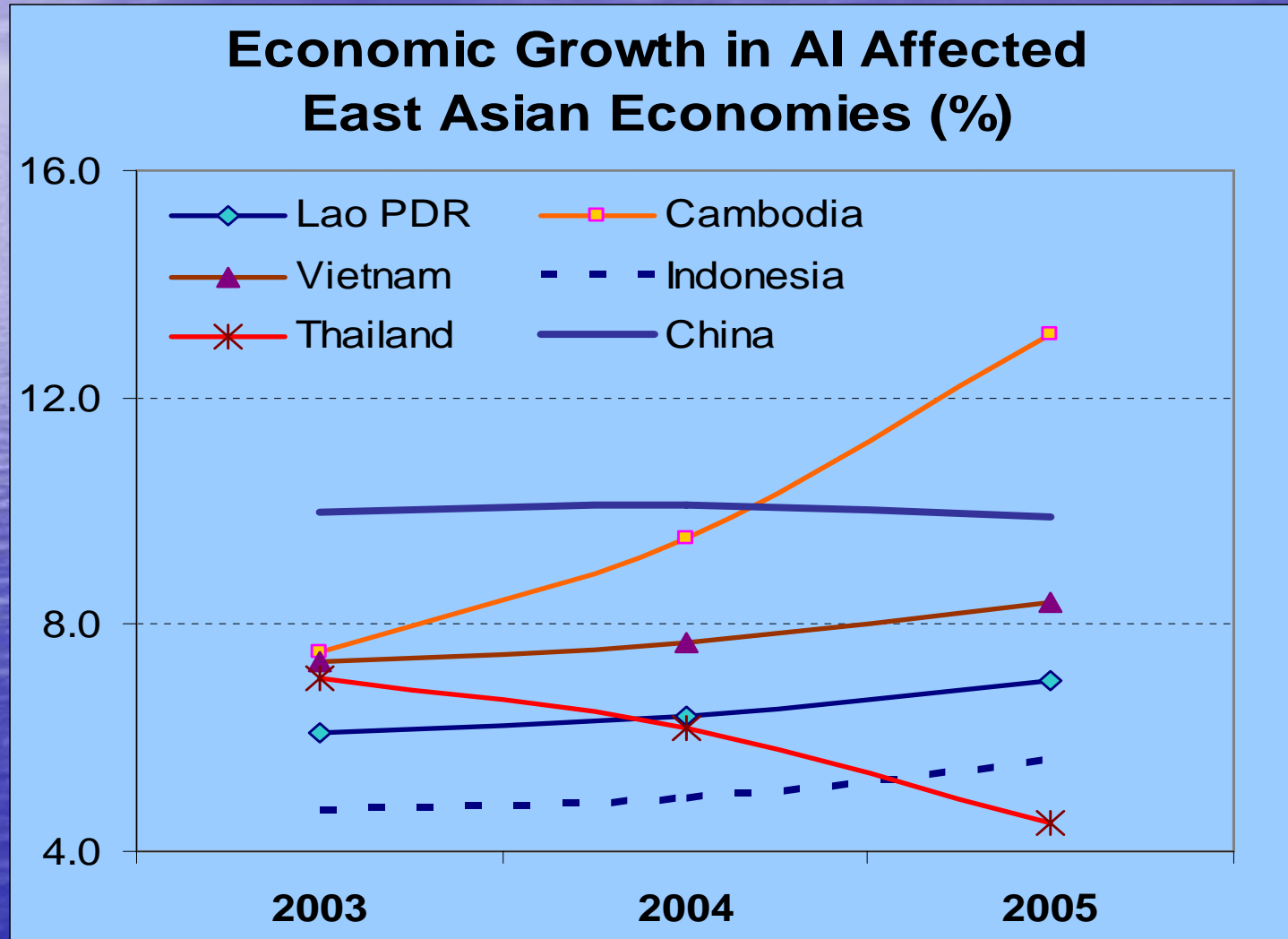

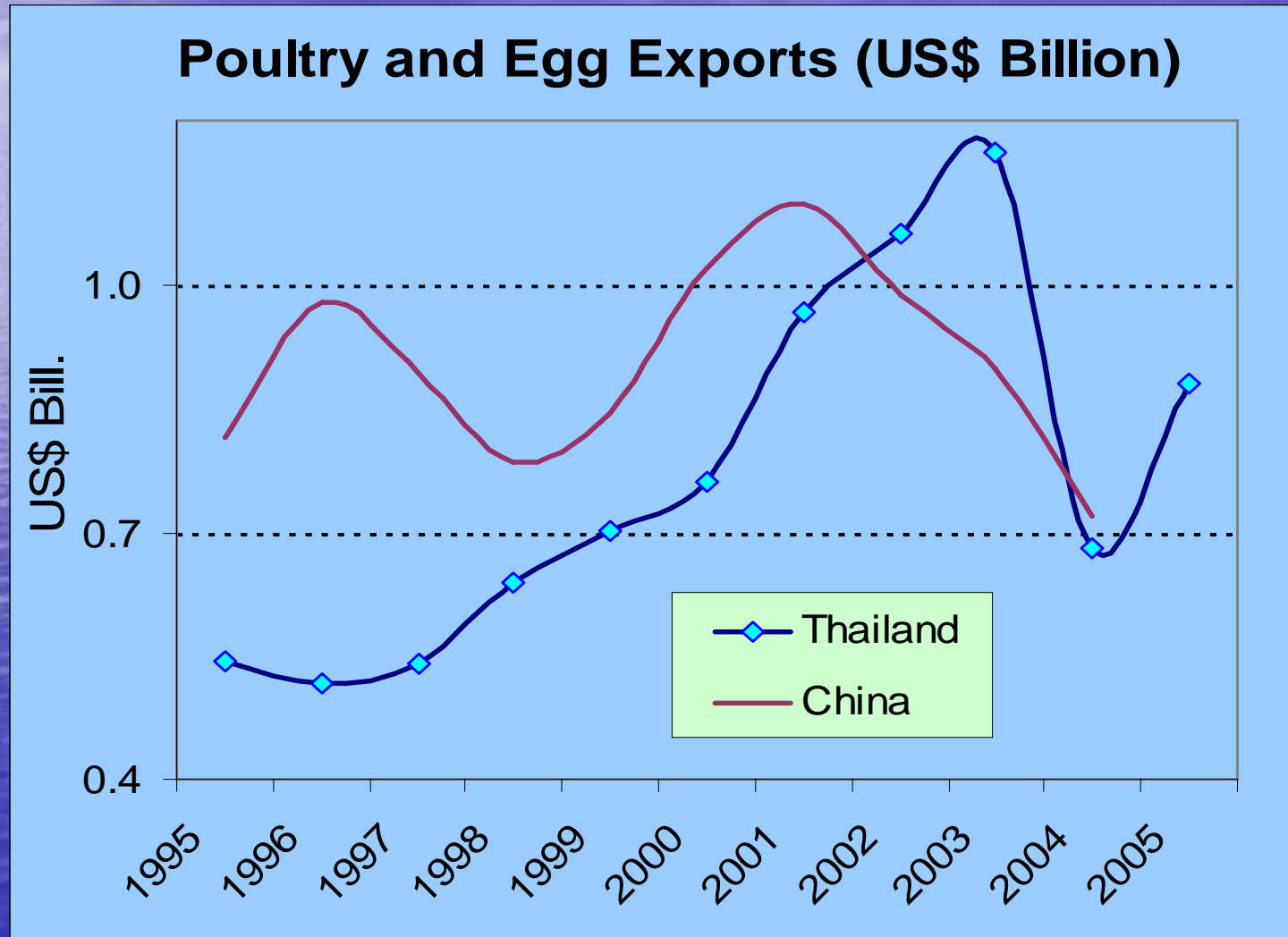
Acceleration in Human Infections and Deaths in 2006



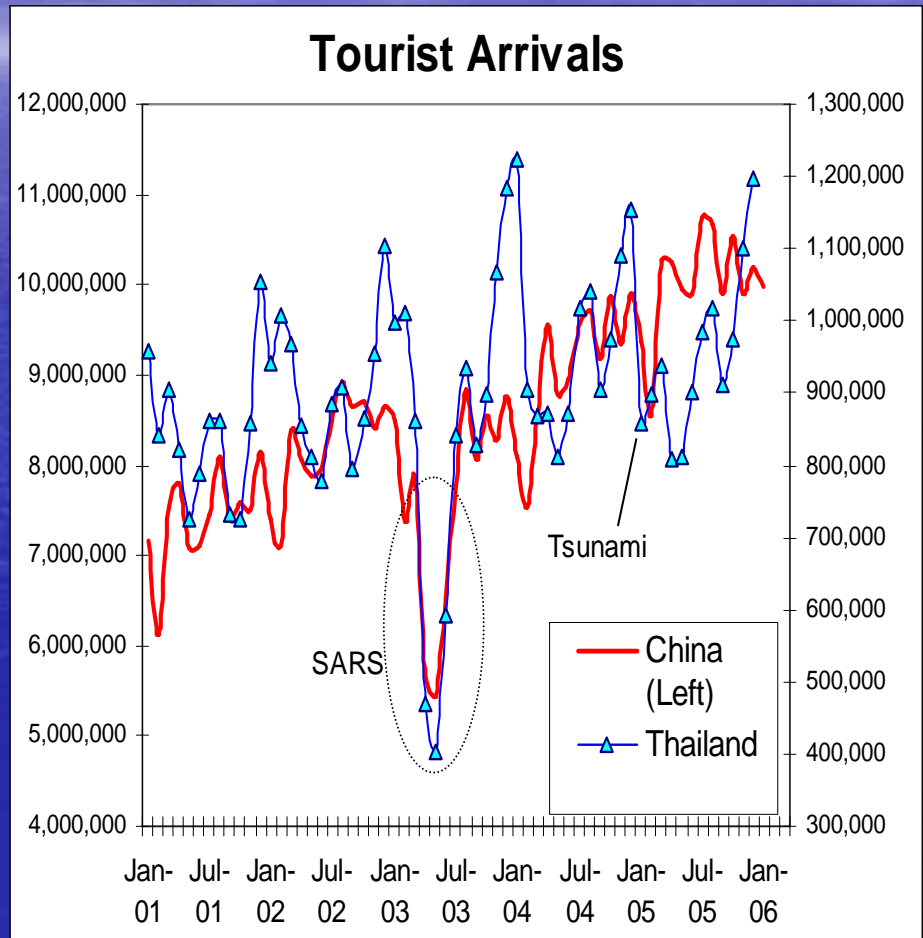
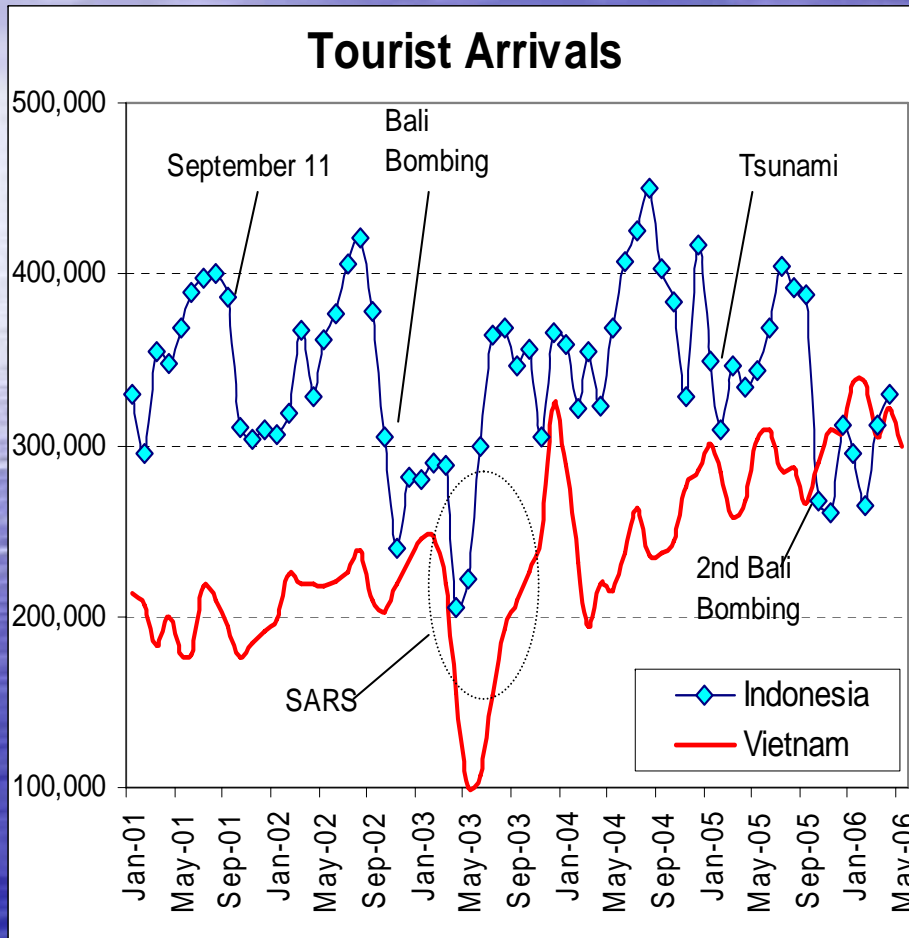
Little impact on East Asian growth overall ...except Thailand



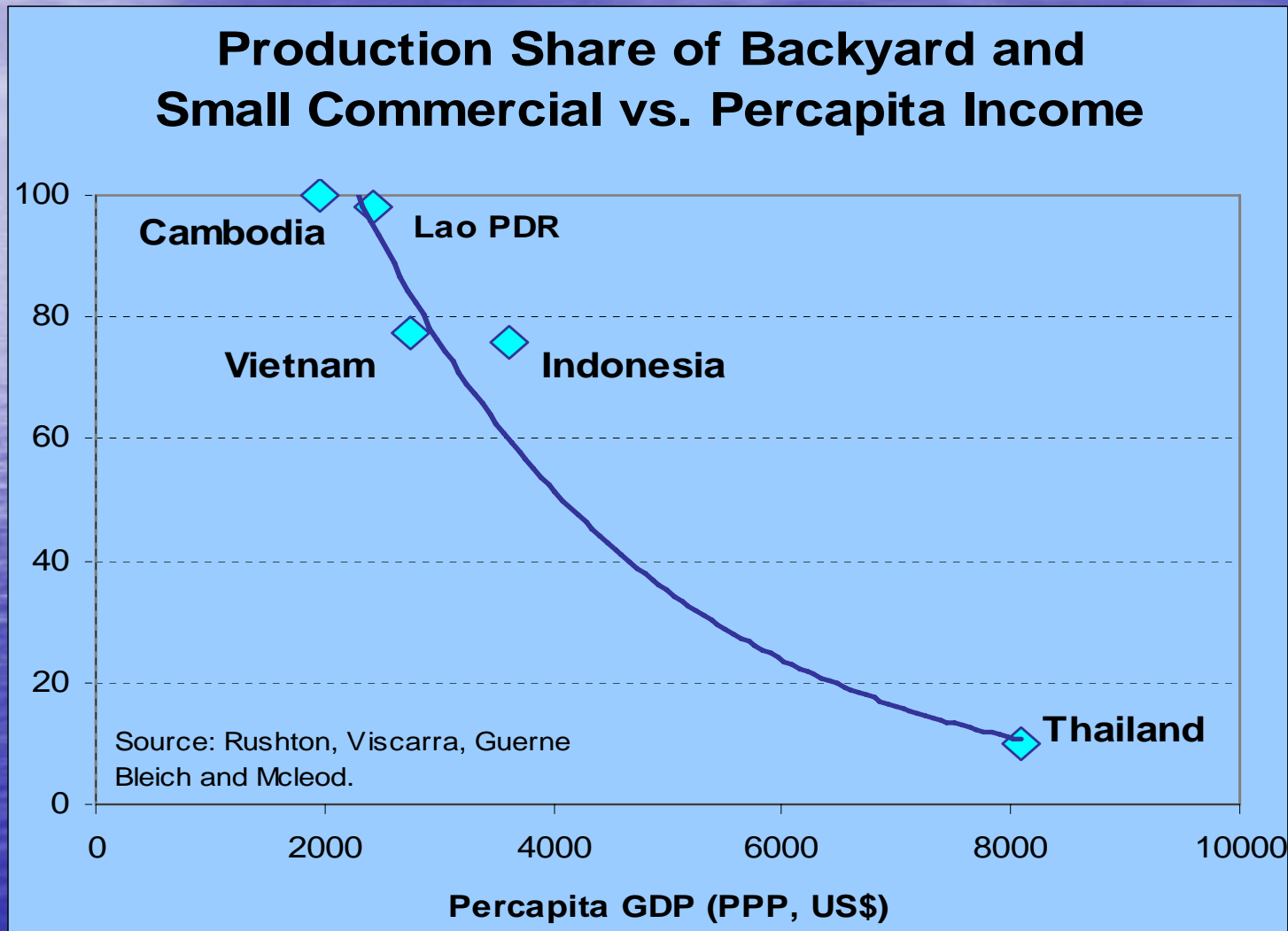
40 percent drop in Thai poultry exports



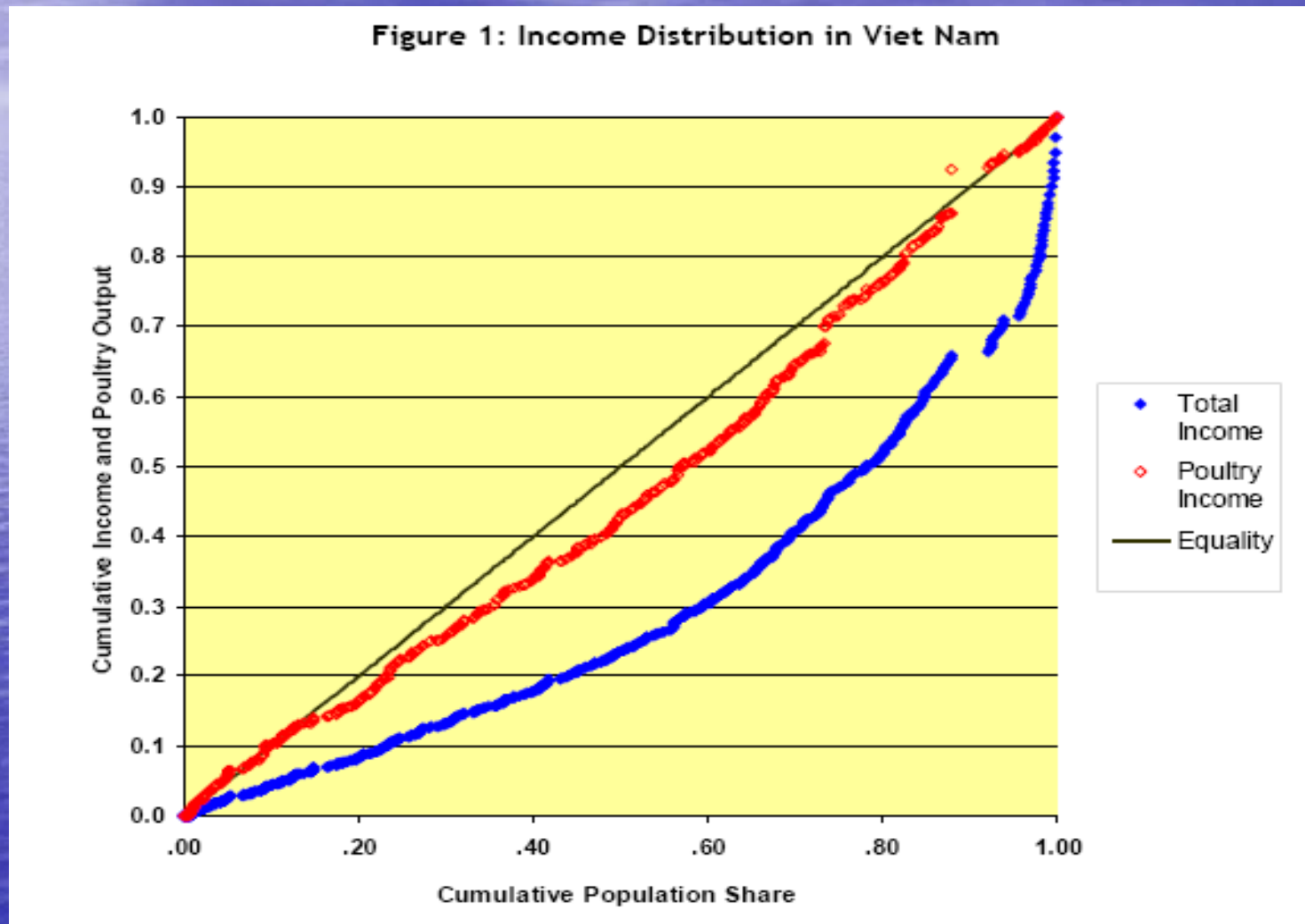
Little Noticeable Impact on Tourist Arrivals



Backyard production prevalent in low income economies

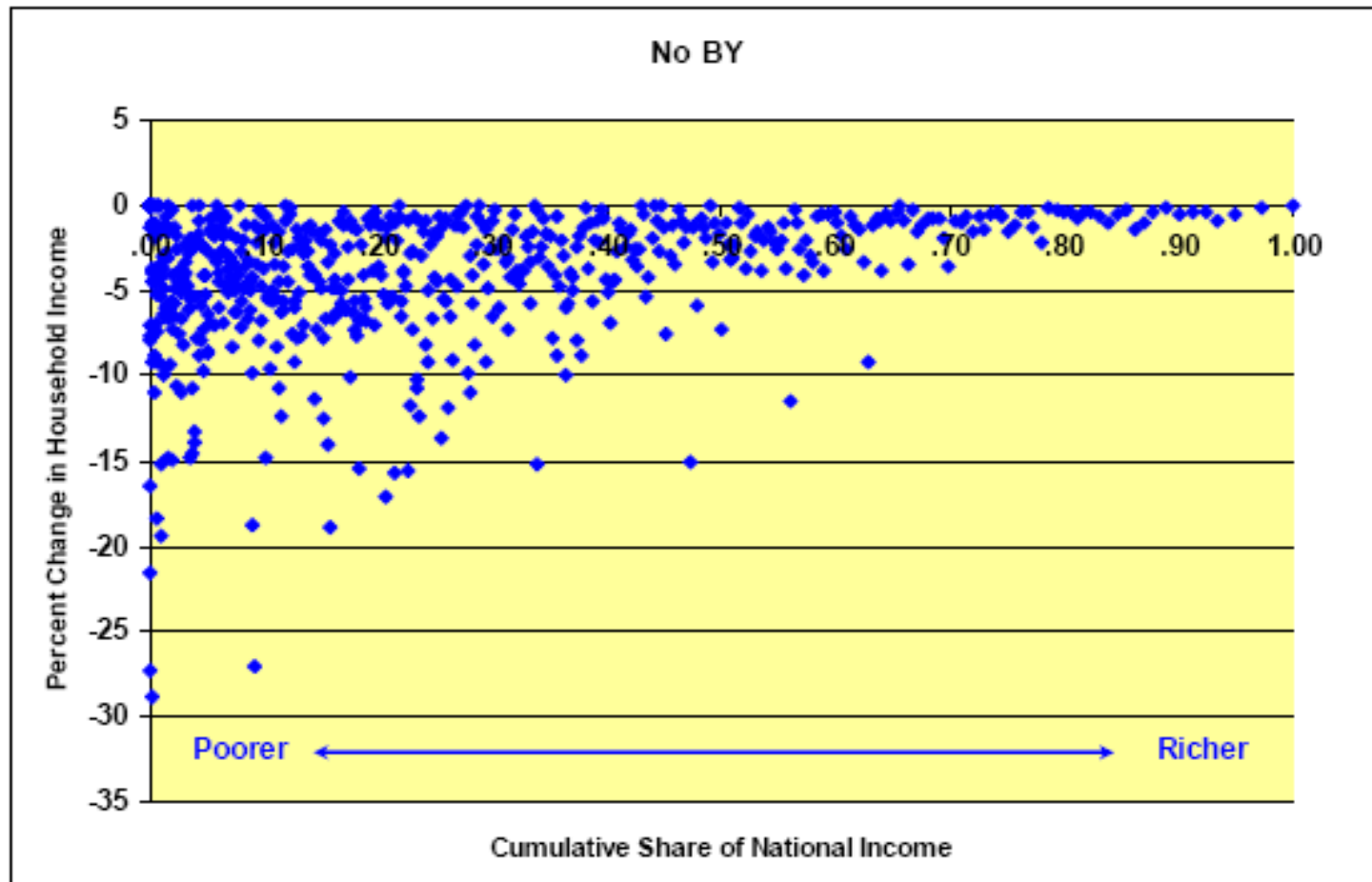


Poultry income more equally distributed than total income in Vietnam

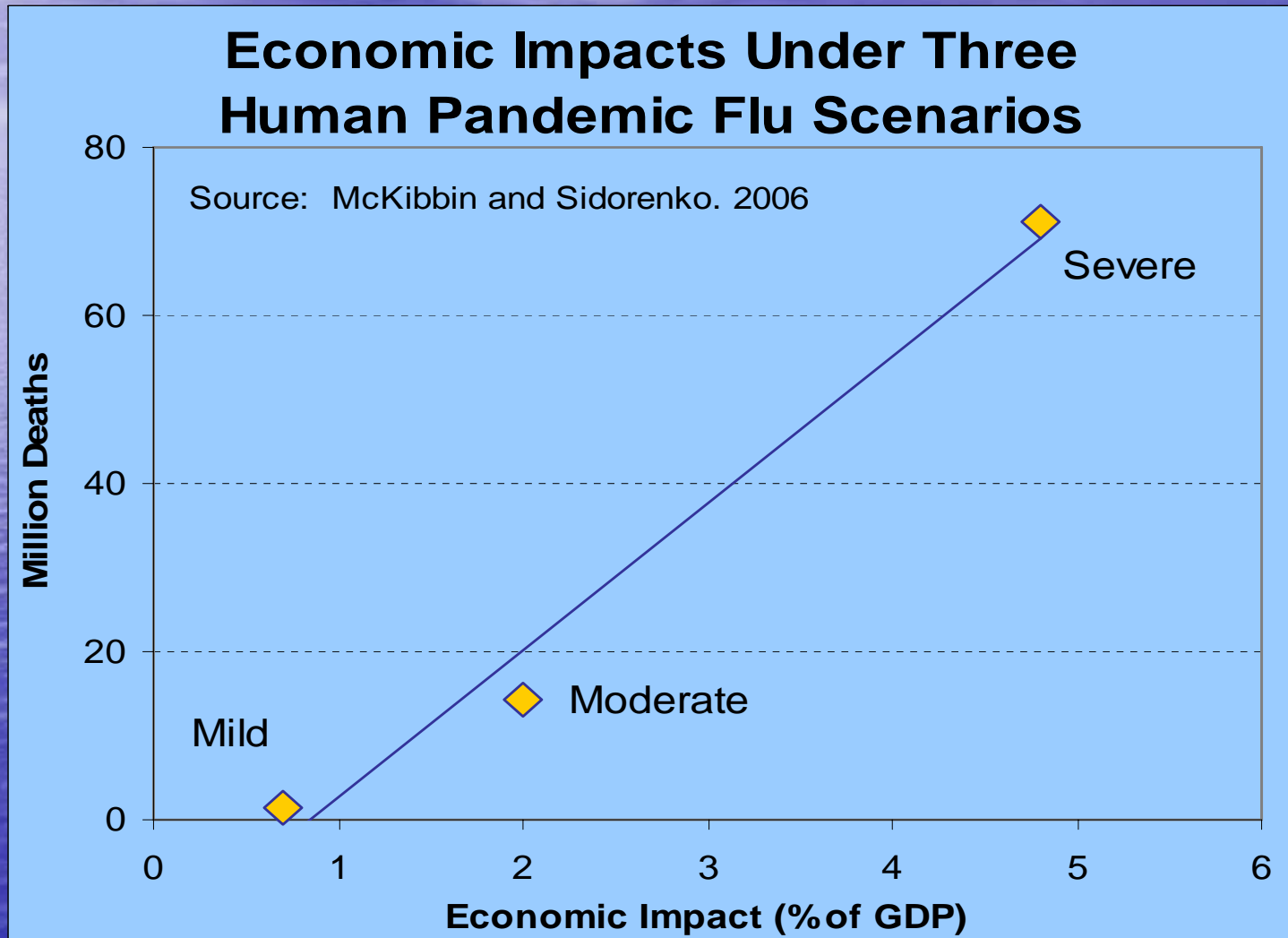


Poor Hurt More by a Poultry Sale Ban
