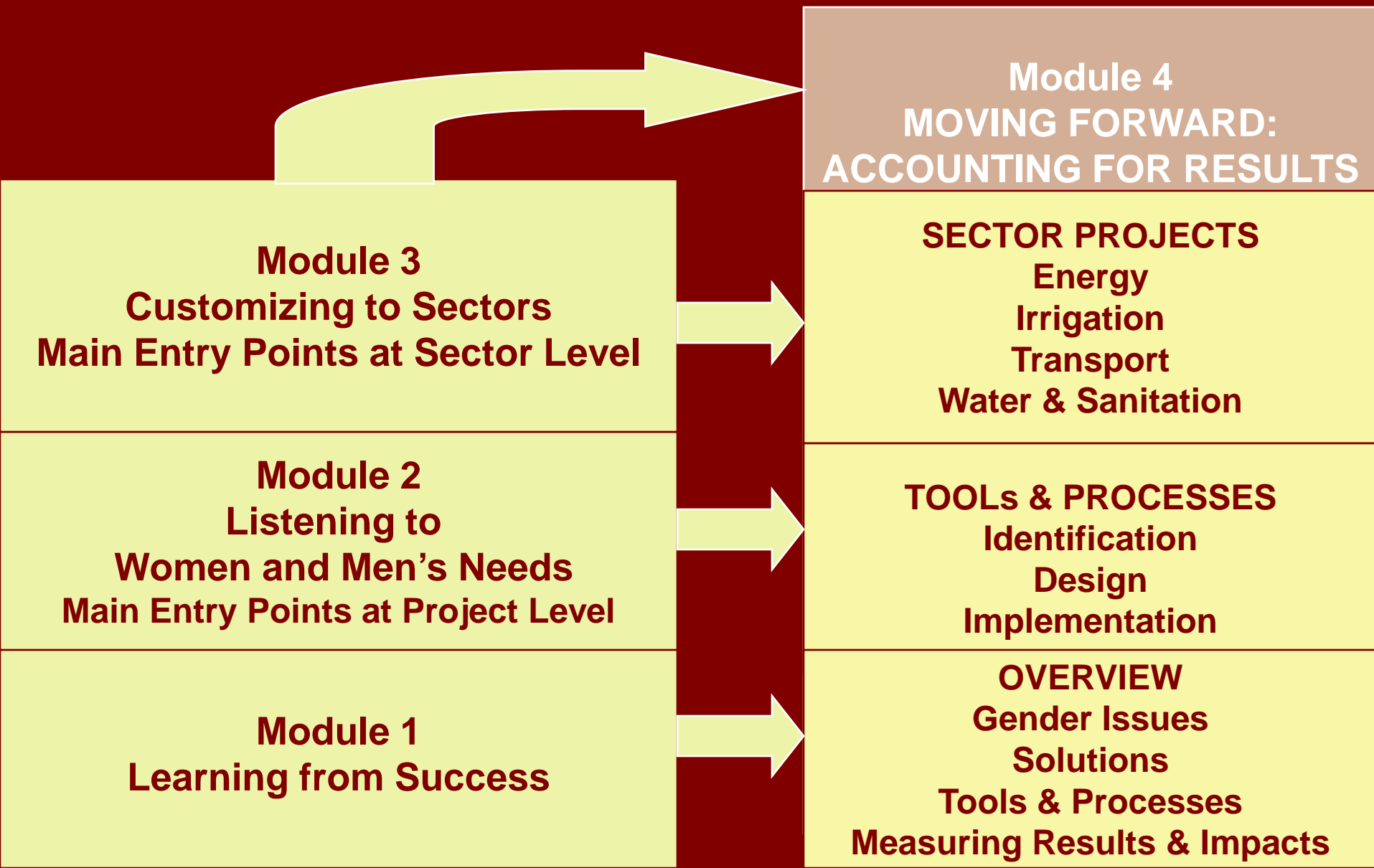

Three Principles for a Successful Workshop



Working Group 1:

Learning from Success and Getting results

Objective: Reflect on successful cases and on your experience:

- Identify concrete steps to integrate gender into projects you are currently working on
- Establish how to remove current constraints to success if any
- Identify expected results and impacts; include indicators if you can

Working Group 2

Listening to Women and Men: How to make it happen

Share your experience from the perspective of your own organization and experience on the ground:

- Identify processes and tools that worked well
- Identify constraints and areas for improvements
- Identify solutions to constraints, in order to mainstream gender in infrastructure projects

Working Group 3

Customizing to the sectors

- List key gender and « how to » questions in your sector
- Test those questions with the members of the practitioners' panel and get their feedback/suggestions
- Bring your projects to the Project Fair

Working Group 4

Moving Forward: A Common Platform

- Select priority infrastructure projects in your country, at any stage of identification, design, or implementation
- Identify priority actions to engender these projects
- Identify priority steps at country level to ensure success at project level
