Anonymous access

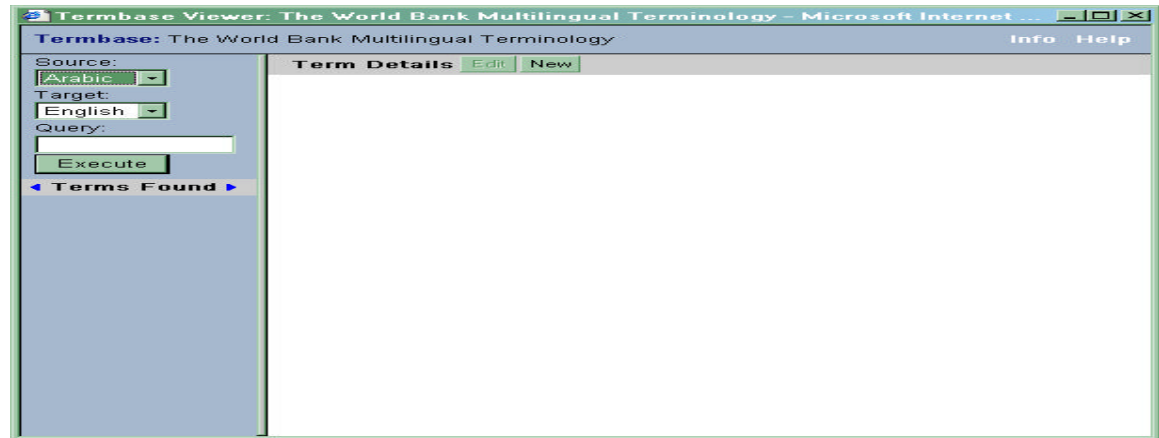
Use this option to access the terminology database without any login. No username or password are necessary for accessing the database via the URL.

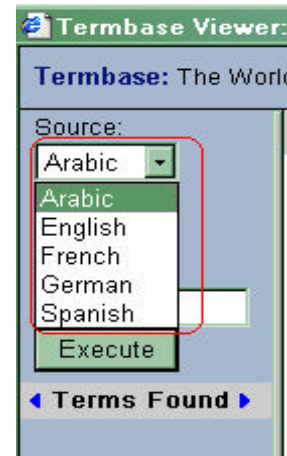

The termbase browser will now appear. You might want to resize it if necessary.



English is the pivot language of the terminology database. However you will be able to query the database using any combination of the four languages currently available. You may do so by selecting the source and target language of your choice.

Select your source language from the pull-down box as shown. Select your target language from the pull-down box in the same way you select your source language.



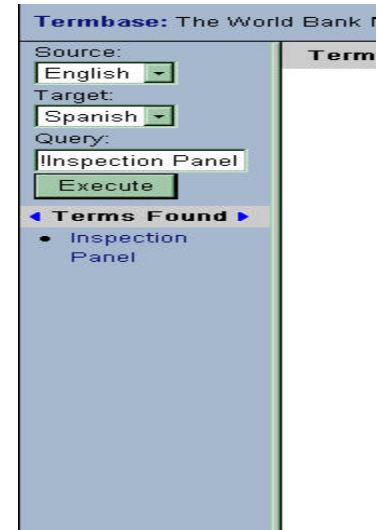
You are now ready to start navigating through the termbase. You can query by an exact term or use any of the symbols indicated to do a fuzzy search or a wildcard search.

Enter the term or wildcard in the query field and hit Enter or click on Execute to start a search.

! = exact search
= fuzzy search
* = regexp search: wildcard for multiple characters
? = regexp search: wildcard for single character

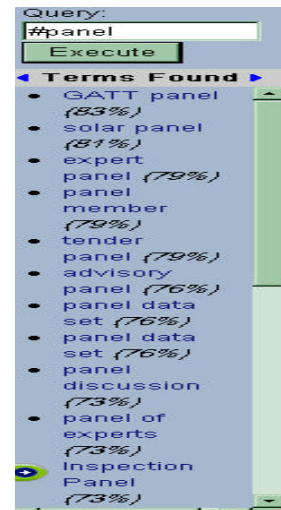
Exact search

Placing the exclamation mark in front of the term to be found returns the desired result:



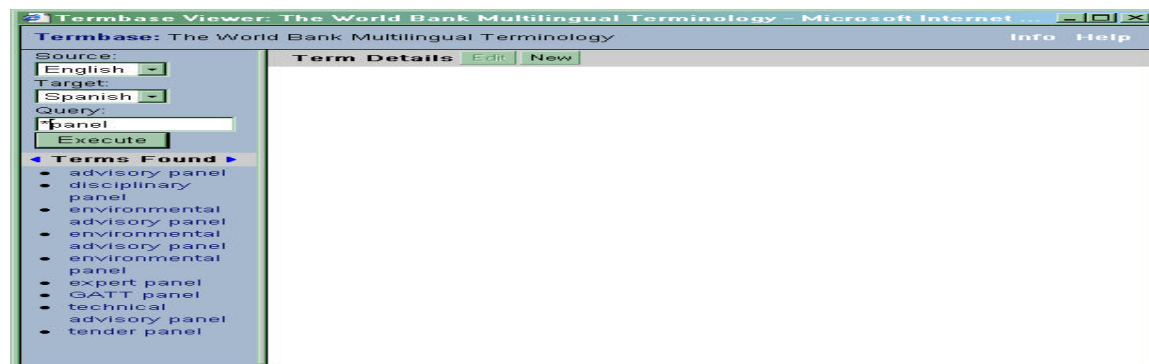
Fuzzy search

Placing the pound sign after or before the term gives the following results:



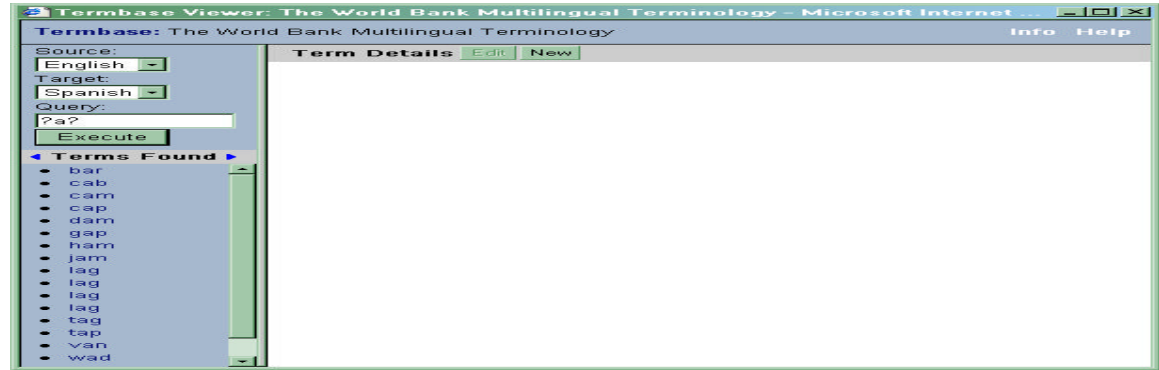
Wildcard for multiple characters search

Placing the star sign in front of the term will give you the following results, for example.



Wildcard search for single character

Placing the question mark on each side of a character will give you the following results:



The results of your search will be shown on the Terms Found section below the query field. Click directly on the term of your choice to display the term details on the right-hand side of your screen.



There might be more terms retrieved that meet your search criteria. To view them, click on the backward or forward arrows found on both sides of the Terms Found label.
