

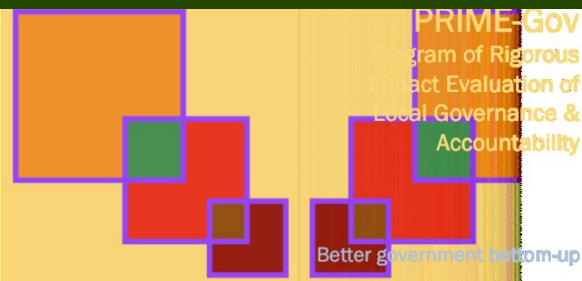

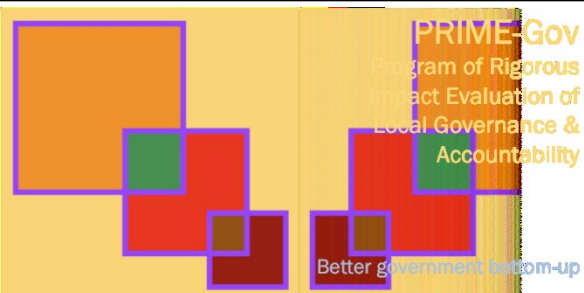

EVALUATION QUESTIONS

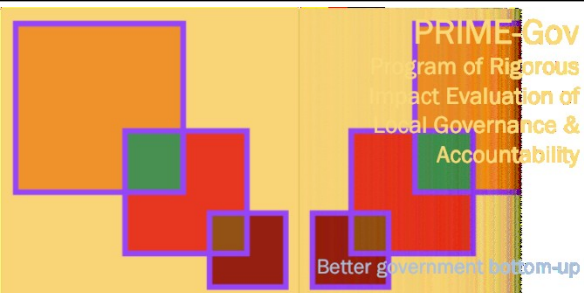
1. What is the impact of KC on HH welfare (consumption, etc.) and municipal local governance?
2. Does more intensive CDD social preparation improve long term poverty alleviation-related benefits?
3. What are the stronger impact gains from KC implementation along with CCT?
4. What longer term benefits are gained from community involvement in prioritization of local public funds for poverty alleviation community projects?

Options 1 and 3: Regression Discontinuity

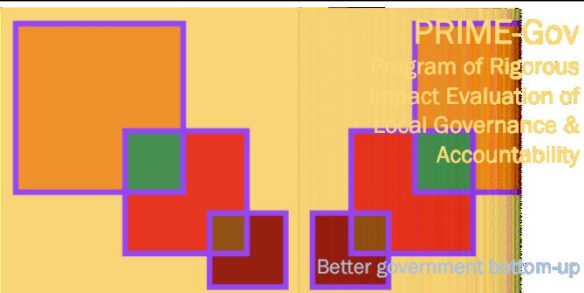
Options 2 and 4: Randomized

Options 1 and 3: Use available national surveys (potentially in combination with additional data collection)

Options 2 and 4 : new surveys

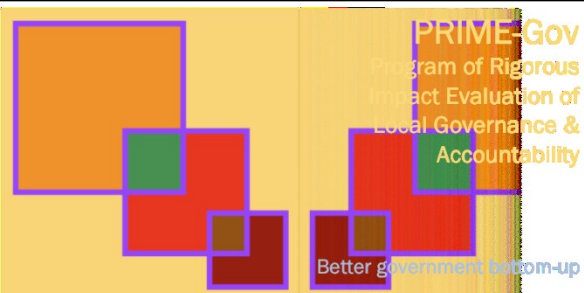


TIMELINE FOR IMPACT EVALUATION

Baseline (when necessary): late 2009

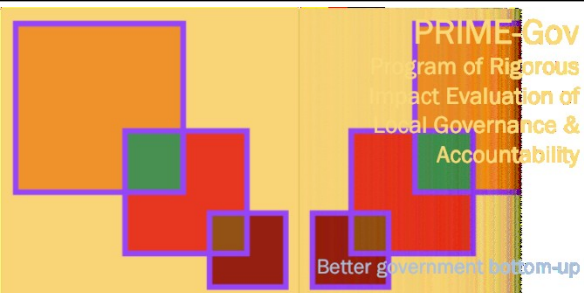
Follow-up: late 2011

Endline: late 2012



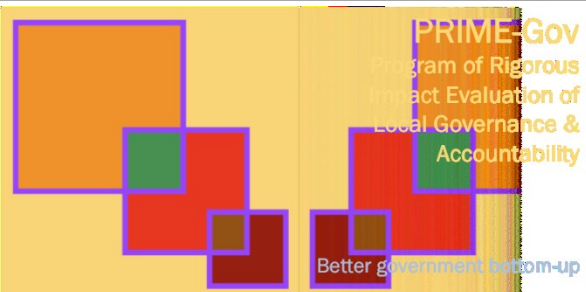
