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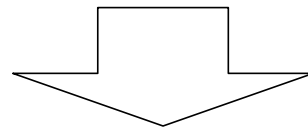
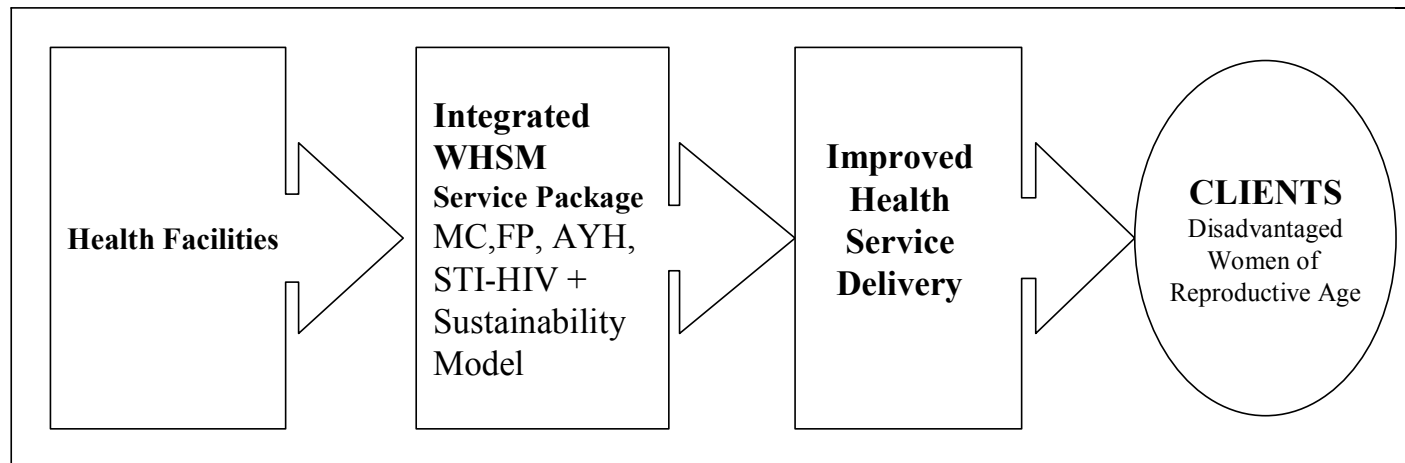

The Framework

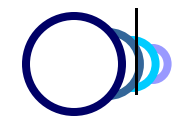


Makes pregnancy and motherhood safer
Enable couples to attain their desired spacing and number of children
Improve reach to adolescents and youth
Controls the spread of STIs and prevent HIV infection in the general population
Sustainable autonomous operation of public health facilities

3. Primary Research Questions

- Will the provision of financial incentives to the Women's Health Team lead to:
 - Increase in facility based deliveries?
 - Increase in skilled birth attendance?
 - Increase in antenatal care visits?

4. Outcome Indicators

- % increase in facility based deliveries
- % increase in skilled birth attendance
- % increase in antenatal care visits

5. Identification Strategy/Method

- Randomized assignment of intervention

6. Sample and data

- Universe: 16 F1 Provinces
- Sampling Method: stratified random sampling of municipalities, stratified at the provincial level
 - In each province, select an equal number of intervention and control municipalities
- Data Source: FHSIS

7. Time Frame/Work Plan

- **February 2009:** sample selection, set-up systems and fiduciary arrangements for transferring incentive budgets
- **March 2009:** Orientation workshop for intervention units; establish baseline using FHSIS
- **April 2009:** start distributing WHT fund
- **September 2009:** monitoring visits to see progress of WHT interventions
- **March 2010:** do the analysis using 2009 FHSIS
