

## **Dick de Zeeuw**



Dr. de Zeeuw is a specialist in international agriculture. He was a member of the Dutch Senate (1970-75), General Director of Agricultural Research in the Netherlands (1976-1985), President of the Agricultural University at Wageningen (1985-89), Professor on Environmental Policy and World Food Problems at the Catholic University, Nijmegen (1971-89), and Member and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the International Food Policy Research Institute, IFPRI (1980-90). Currently, he is Deputy Chairman of the Netherlands Commission for Environmental Impact Assessment (Commission MER), and Chairman of the Working Groups on Social Justice and the Future of Agriculture in the Netherlands. He has been the Convenor of the NT2 IAG since its inception in 1997, and is also a member of the independent International Advisory Group on the Chad-Cameroon Pipeline Project.
