

## Jacques Gérin



Mr. Gérin has been a manager and a consultant in the fields of natural resources management, economic development and the environment in both the public and private sectors, in Canada and internationally. He was Vice President of the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA), Deputy Minister of Environment Canada and Associate Deputy Minister of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development. He is a civil engineer with a Master's degree in Regional Planning and was formerly the President of Hatch-Québec. In 1999, he chaired the Panel on Ecological Integrity of Canada's National Parks and has chaired the Joint Public Advisory Committee of the North American Commission for Environmental Cooperation. He is Chairman of the Board of the International Institute for Sustainable Development (IISD) and a Governor of the International Development Research Centre (IDRC). Mr. Gérin was appointed to the NT2 IAG in 2006 and is currently the Executive Secretary of the independent International Advisory Group for the Chad-Cameroon Petroleum Development and Pipeline Project.
