Dr. Mary Racelis is currently Director of the Institute of Philippine Culture, Ateneo de Manila University. She is the president of Community Organizers Multiversity of the Philippines, a non-government organization involved in empowering urban poor communities. Dr. Racelis has worked as a consultant to several international development agencies, including the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), the Asian Development Bank, the World Bank, the Rockefeller Foundation and the Ford Foundation. She was formerly Regional Director for the UNICEF office for the East and South Africa Region. She was a lecturer at the graduate classes at the Department of Sociology of the University of the Philippines and the Ateneo de Manila University. Areas of interests are varied and include, among others, women's roles, participation, NGOs and civil society, and urban poverty. She is the author of several books and more than 200 articles on sociological, anthropological, political and development issues. Dr. Racelis was appointed to the NT2 IAG in 2006.
