Prof. Dr. Salim is on the faculty of economics at the University of Indonesia. He was Minister of State for Population and Environment from 1978 to 1993 and has held numerous other public offices throughout his career. Dr. Salim was President of the United Nations Environment Programme Governing Council from 1985 to 1987. He is currently a Board member of the International Institute on Environment and Development and the Stockholm Environment Institute, International Institute for Environment Technology and Management, is a member of the World Health Organization's Health and Environment Commission and the UN High Level Advisory Board on Sustainable Development, and served as the Eminent Person on the Extractive Industries Review. He also serves as Chairman of the Board of Trustees for a number of leading Indonesian environmental organizations. Dr. Salim received a master's degree and a Ph.D in economics from the University of California at Berkeley in the United States. He has been a member of the NT2 IAG since its inception in 1997.
