Knut Rexed



Knut Rexed is a former Director-General of Statskontoret, the Swedish Agency for Public Management. Statskontoret is a staff agency assisting the Swedish Government in issues related to public governance and public management.

He retired from public service at the end of 2005. He is now active in private capacity as a consultant for i.a. the Swedish Ministry of Finance and OECD.

Knut Rexed has been Vice-Chair of OECDs Public Governance Committee (formerly called PUMA), and Chair of its Working Party on Public Employment and Management. He also chaired the Advisory Panel for the OECD Public Sector Modernisation Review.

During the Swedish Presidency of the European Union in 2000, he chaired the meetings of European Director-Generals responsible for Public Administration. From 2000 – 2002 he chaired the Government On-Line International Network (formerly the G8 Government On Line Group).

Previously, Knut Rexed served in the Swedish Foreign Service, as Chief Economic Adviser to the Minister of Finance and as State Secretary in the Ministry of Finance responsible for Government revenues. He has also worked as a structural analyst for the Swedish Confederation for Professional Employees (TCO).

He is born in 1945 and has a MSc in Theoretical Physics and a BA in Economics from the University of Uppsala. He speaks English, French and German.

He is married with one daughter.
