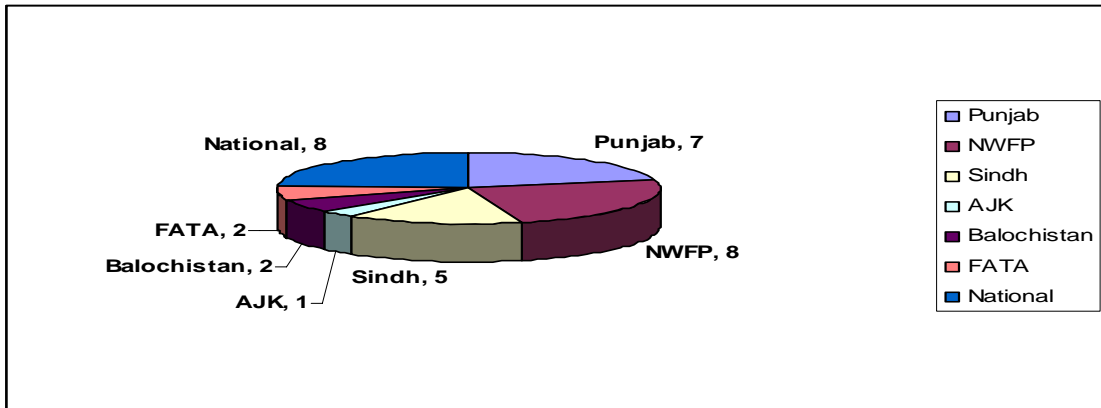


Pakistan Development Marketplace Finalists Data

- After two rounds of assessment by 22 assessors, 33 finalists have been selected to attend the 2006 Pakistan Development Marketplace, scheduled for March 15, 2006 in Islamabad. The Finalists will present their ideas before a jury, and the general public for an opportunity to receive funding from an estimated US\$235,000 award pool. The 33 Finalists, representing all provinces of Pakistan, were selected from a highly competitive pool of 215 applicants.
