Tingim Yut Kompetisen is a nationwide competition aimed at finding and funding good ideas that address the major challenges affecting PNG's young people in their communities. The competition is an initiative of the World Bank in partnership with Air Niugini, Airlines PNG, Bank South Pacific, the Department of Community Development, Divine Word University, NASFUND, UNDP and UNICEF. To win, project ideas must be creative, innovative, cost-effective and have a direct impact on youth issues. Winning projects will be funded for a period of 12 months.

Why a competition?

- To find good ideas from the community level that address youth challenges
- To stimulate thinking and discussion about PNG's young people
- To build public interest in finding creative solutions



Theme

Yut na Komuniti Wokbung

All entries must address this theme.



Who can apply?

The competition is open to non-government organisations and other locally recognized civil society organisations, universities, schools and private sector groups that are directly in touch with youth aged between 15 and 25 years. Every group entering a submission must nominate a partnering organisation (eg NGO, church, local business) that can act as a contact and help oversee the project's

What is the prize?

Winners with the best ideas, as judged by a panel of distinguished Papua New Guineans and other experts, will have their project idea funded for a period of 12 months.

Winning projects will be closely monitored and evaluated.

Important dates

Close of submissions: **5pm, Friday, 3 February 2006**

Finalists announced: **Friday, 17 February, 2006**

Awards event: **Saturday, 29 April 2006.**





How to apply

Discuss your project idea with your community and send a two to three page proposal that answers all the questions and provides all the information listed on the back of this brochure. Submissions longer than three pages will not be eligible. Entries can be submitted in English or Tok Pisin. You can drop your proposal off at any branch of Bank South Pacific in PNG or you can hand deliver, send by post, email or fax to:

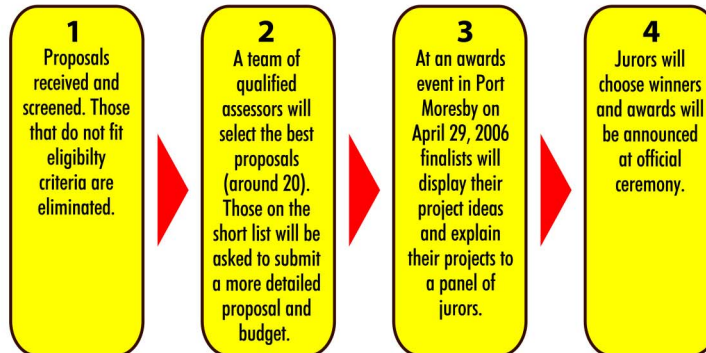


All proposals will be assessed for:
