

Migration and Remittances in Senegal

This is a snapshot of migration and remittances based on available data from various sources.

Emigration, 2005

- Stock of emigrants: 463,403
- Stock of emigrants as percentage of population: 4.0%
- Top 10 destination countries: Gambia, France, Italy, Mauritania, Spain, Gabon, United States, Rep. of Congo, Guinea-Bissau, Nigeria.

Skilled Emigration, 2000

- Emigration rate of tertiary educated: 24.1% (Source: Docquier and Marfouk 2004)
- Emigration of physicians:
 - a) 27 or 2.8% of physicians trained in the country (Source: Docquier and Bhargava 2006)
 - b) 678 or 51.4% of physicians trained in the country (Source: Clemens and Pettersson 2006)
- Emigration of Nurses: 695 or 26.9% of nurses trained in the country (Source: Clemens and Pettersson 2006)

Immigration, 2005

- Stock of immigrants: 325,940
- Stock of immigrants as percentage of population: 2.8%
- Female as percentage of immigrants: 40.2%
- Refugees as percentage of immigrants: 6.4%
- Top 10 source countries: Guinea, Mauritania, Guinea-Bissau, Mali, France, Cape Verde, Gambia, Morocco, Syrian Arab Republic, United States.
