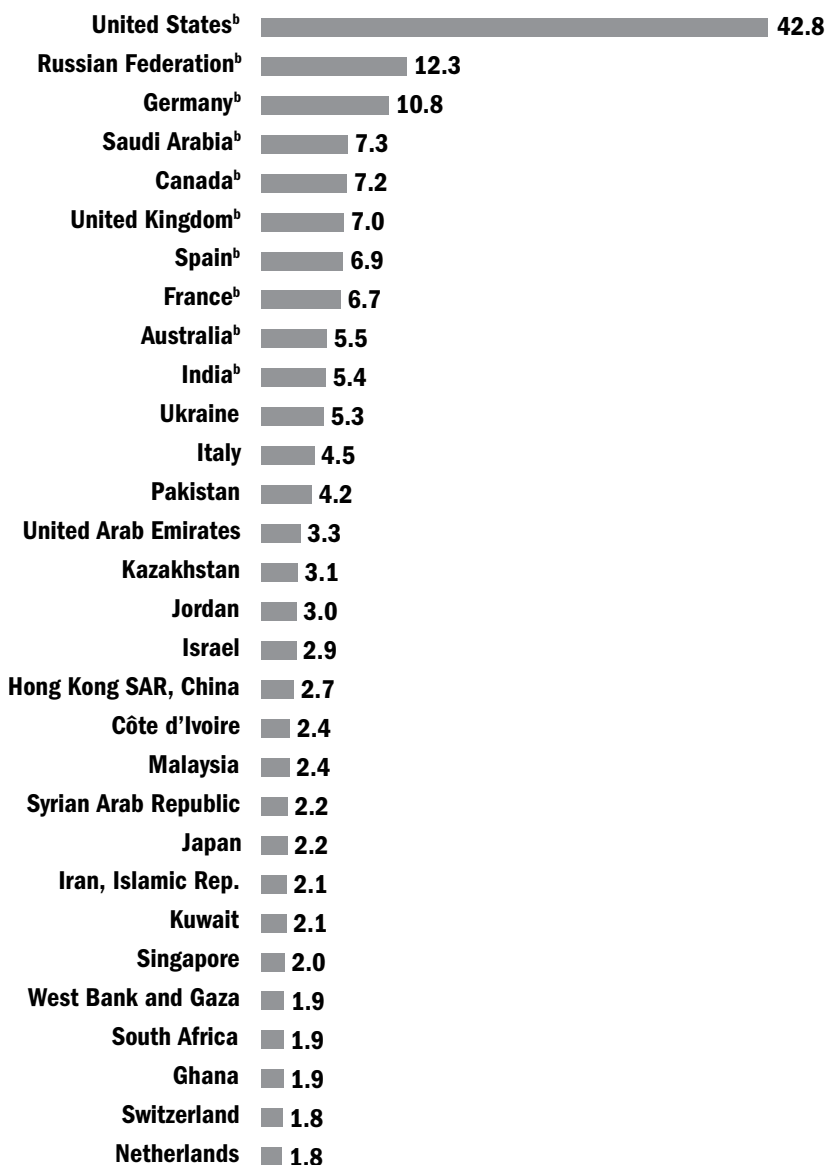

number of immigrants, millions



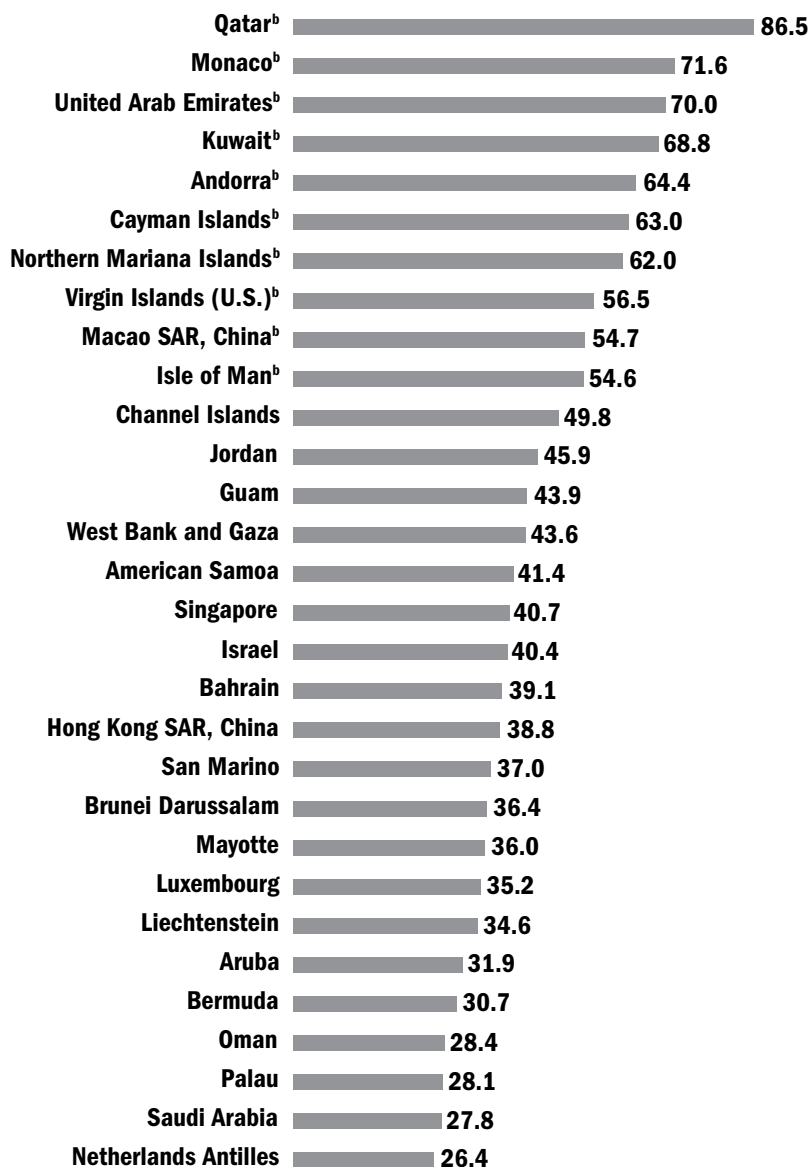

percentage of population



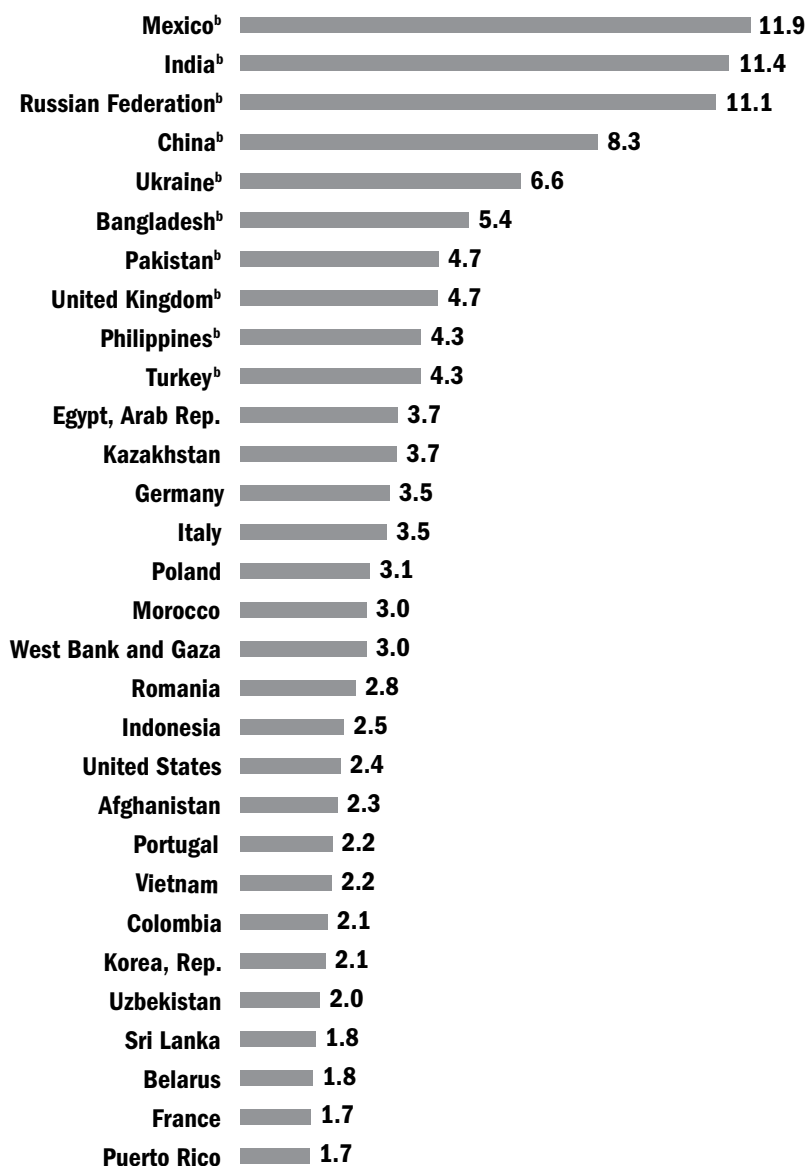

number of emigrants, millions



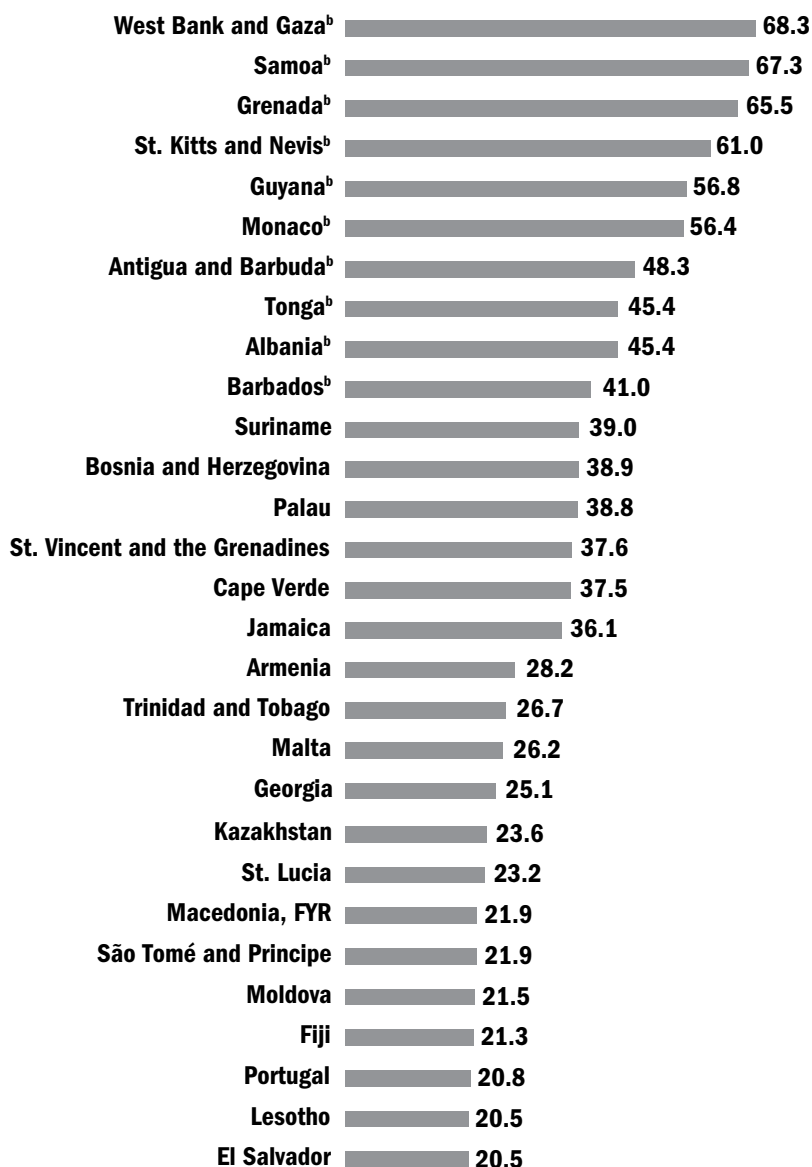

percentage of population



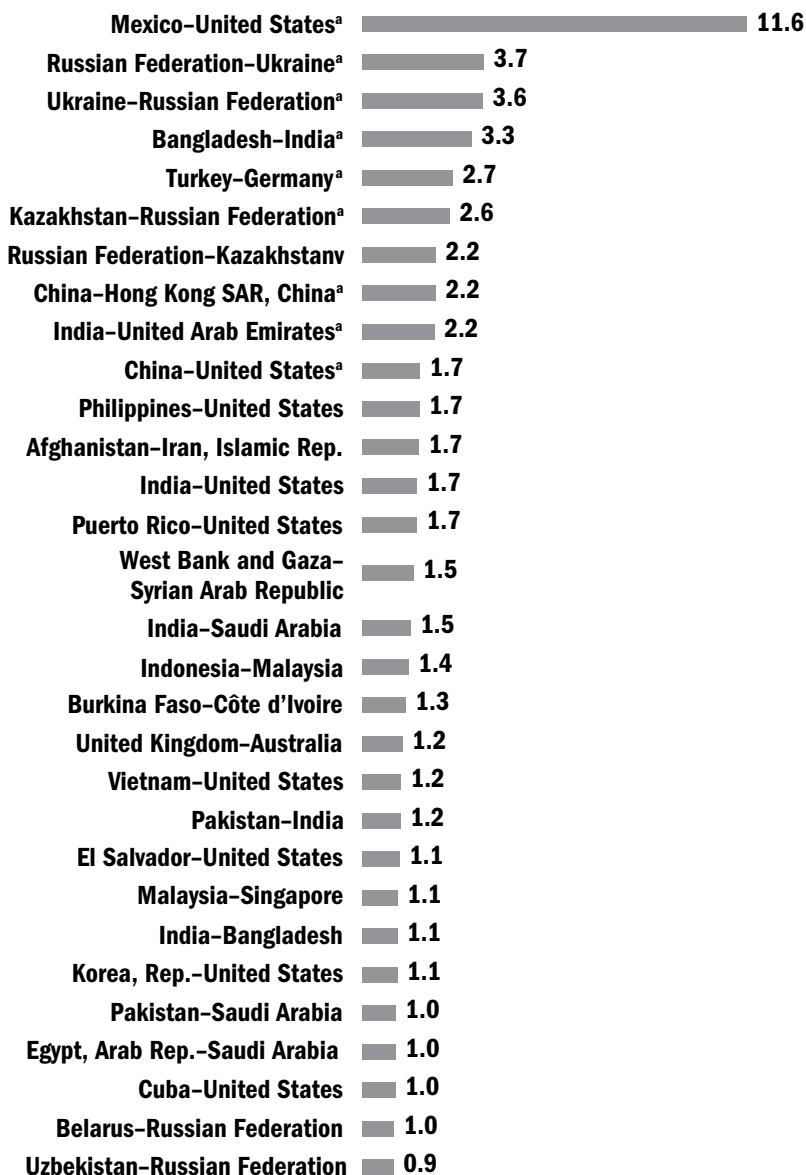

number of migrants, millions

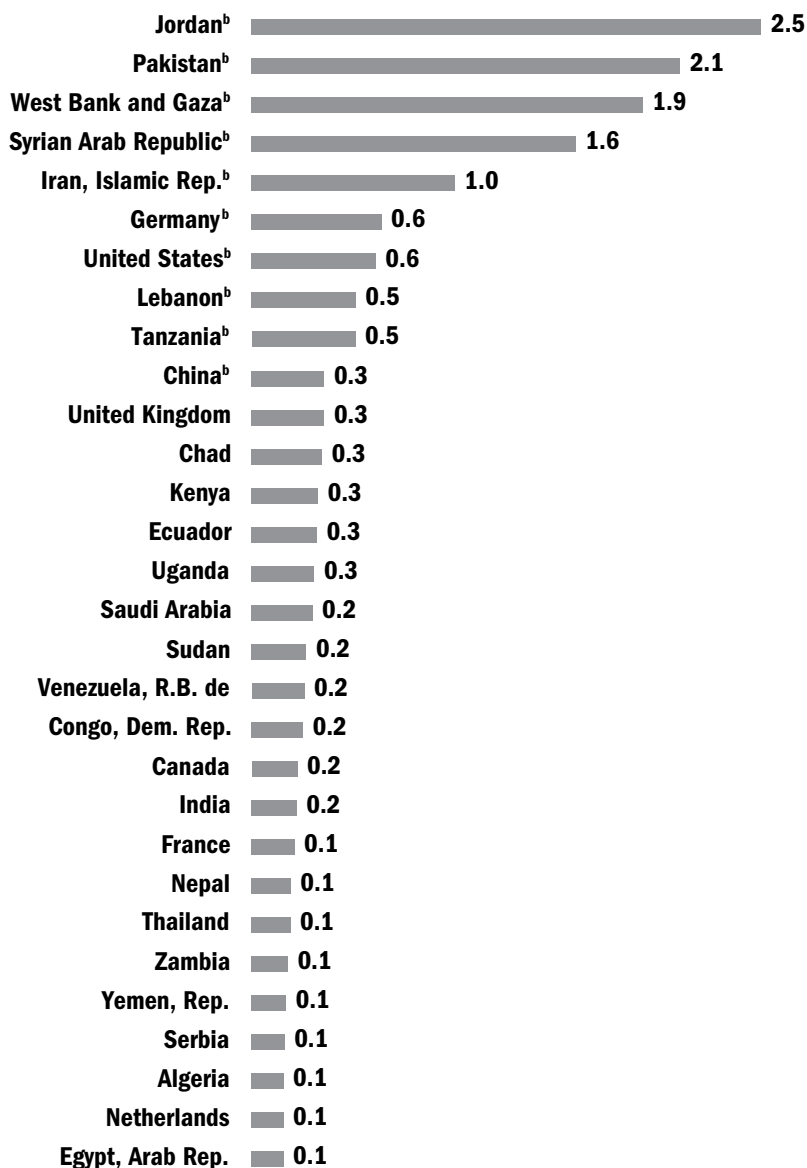

number of migrants, millions



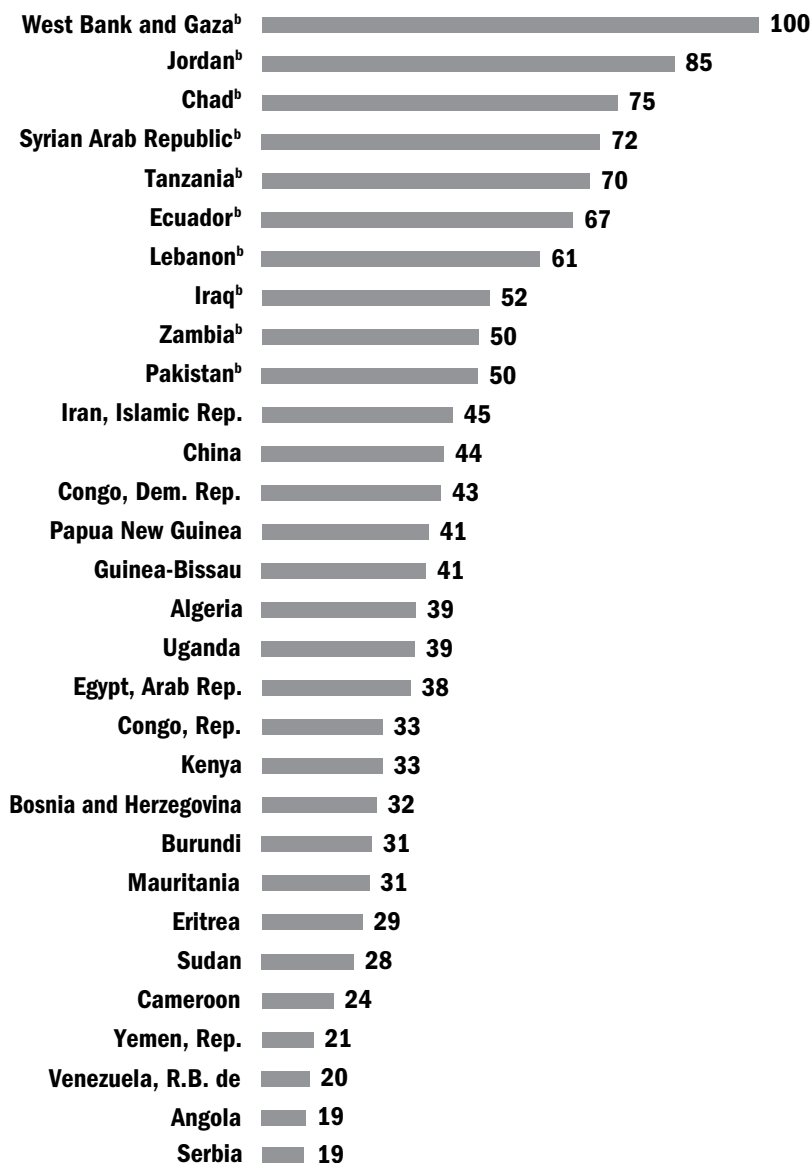

percentage of migrants



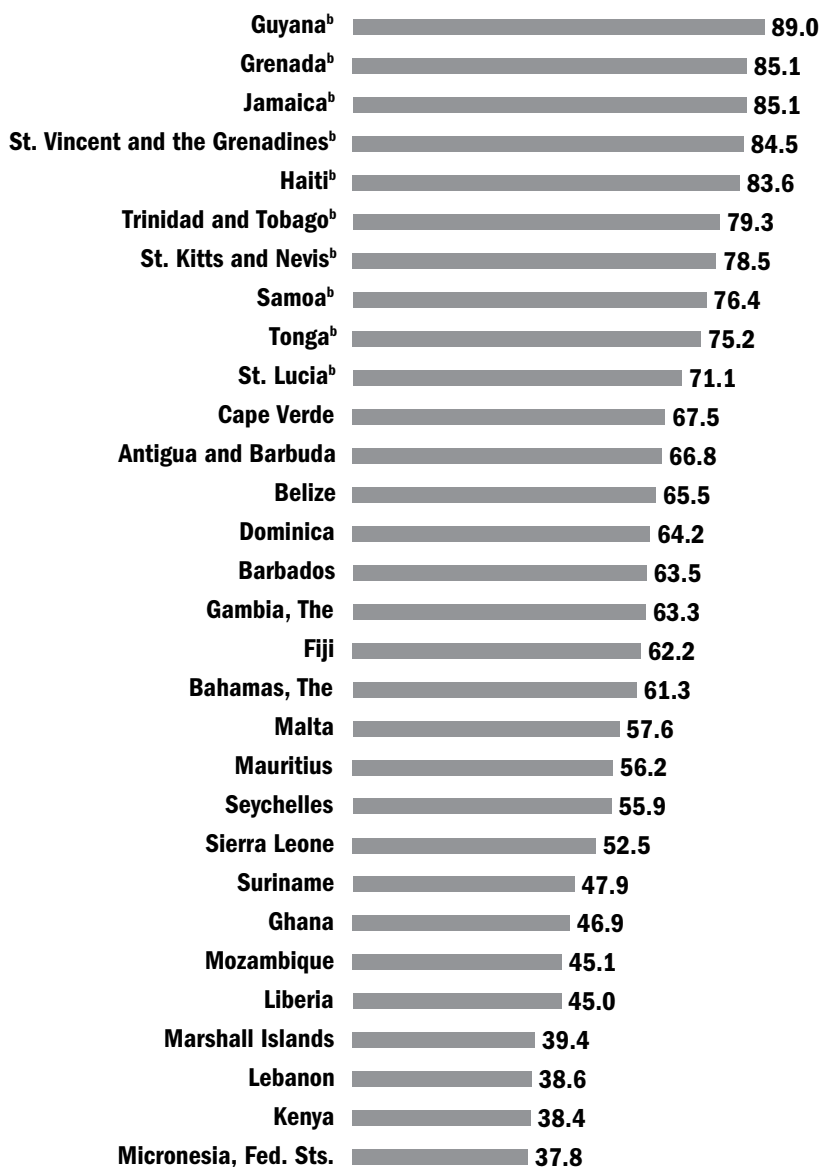

number of migrants, thousands



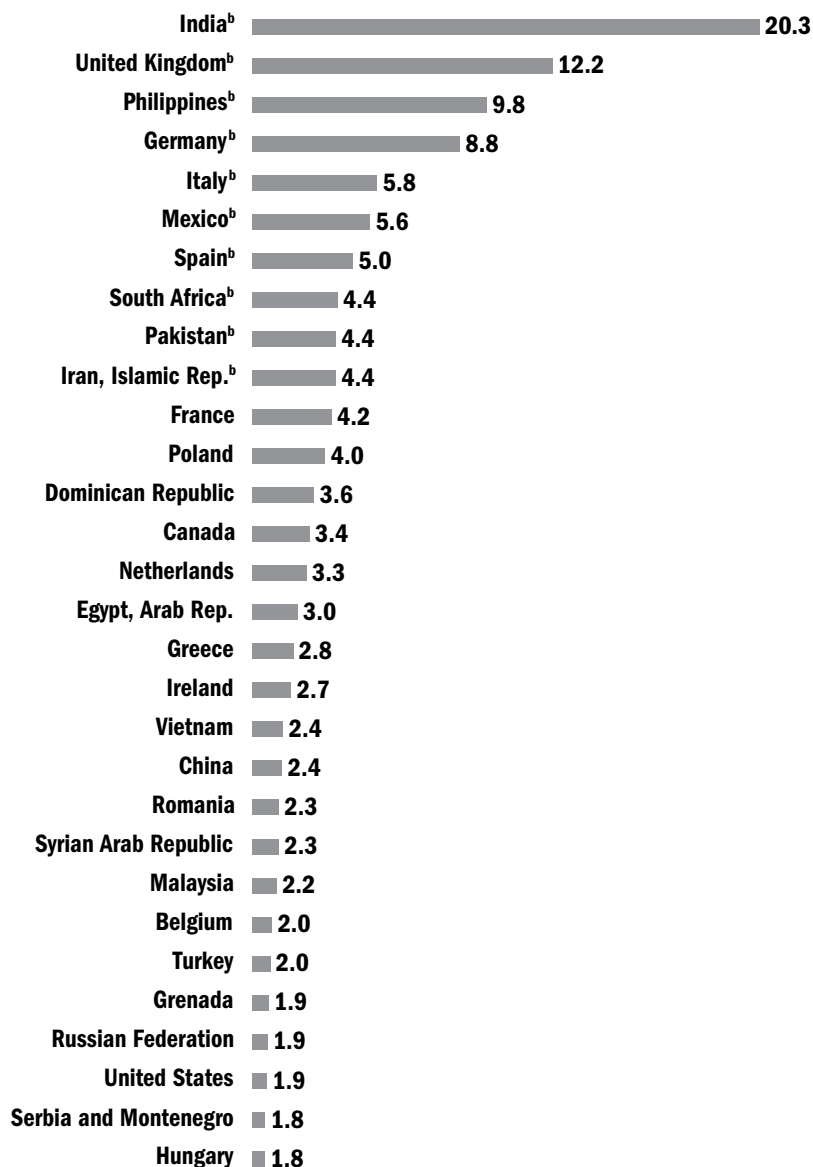

number of migrants, thousands



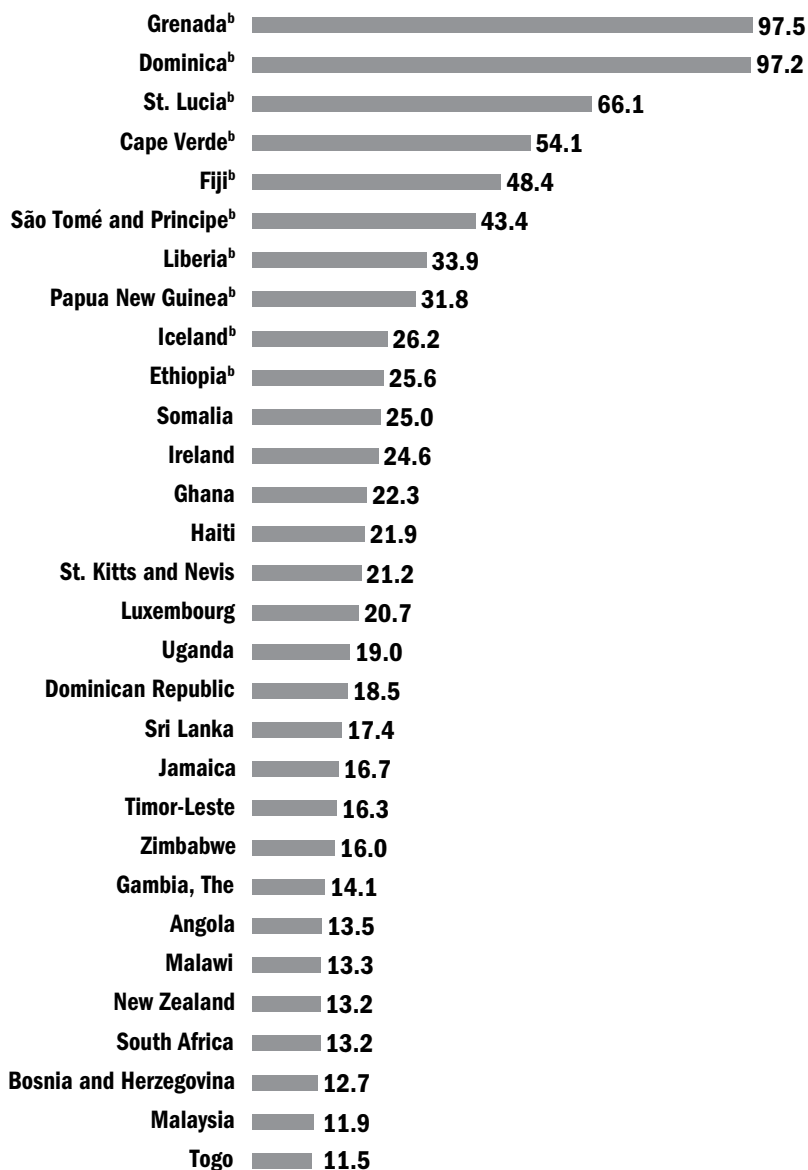

percentage of total physicians trained in the country



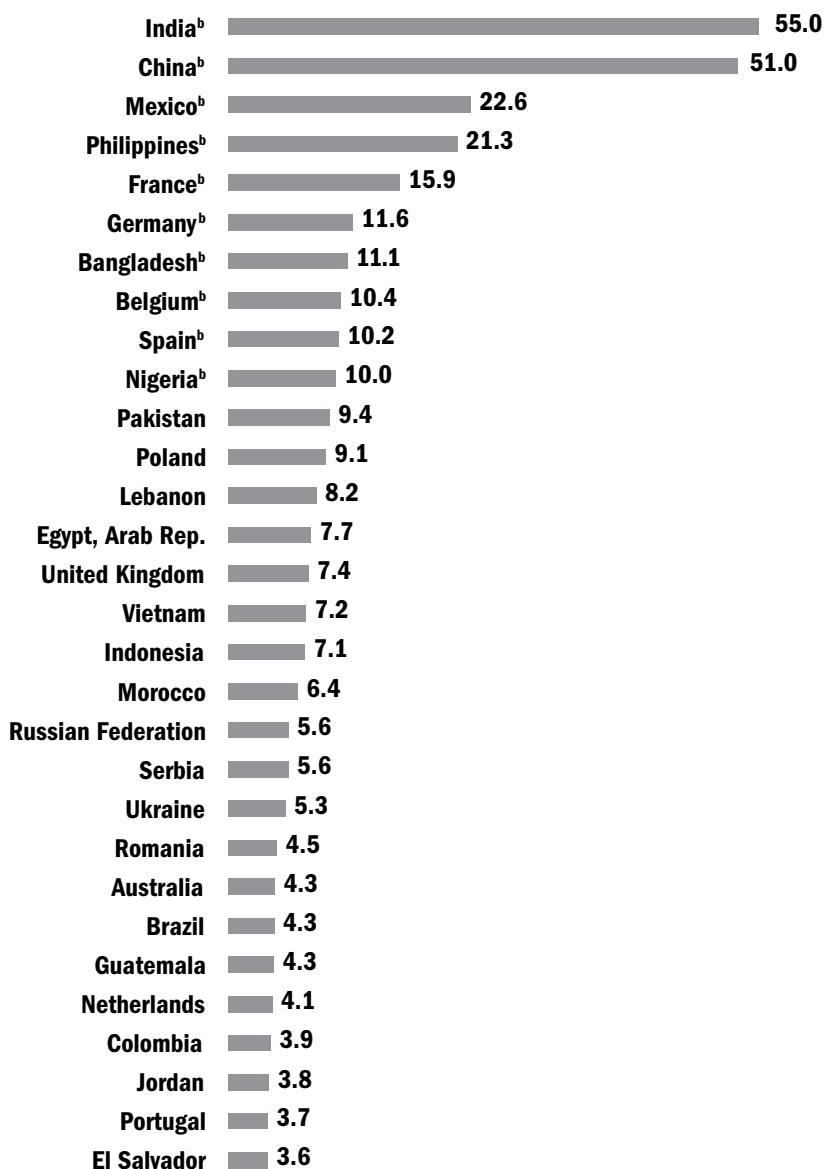

US\$ billions



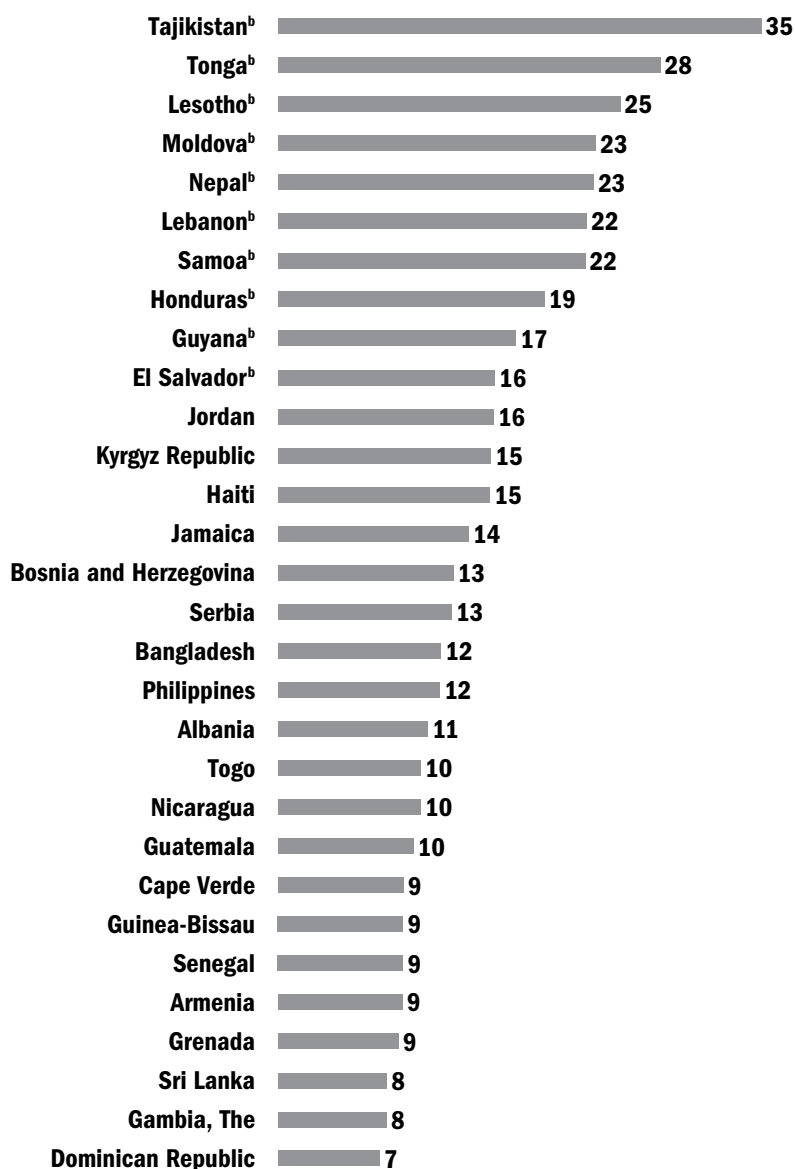

percentage of GDP



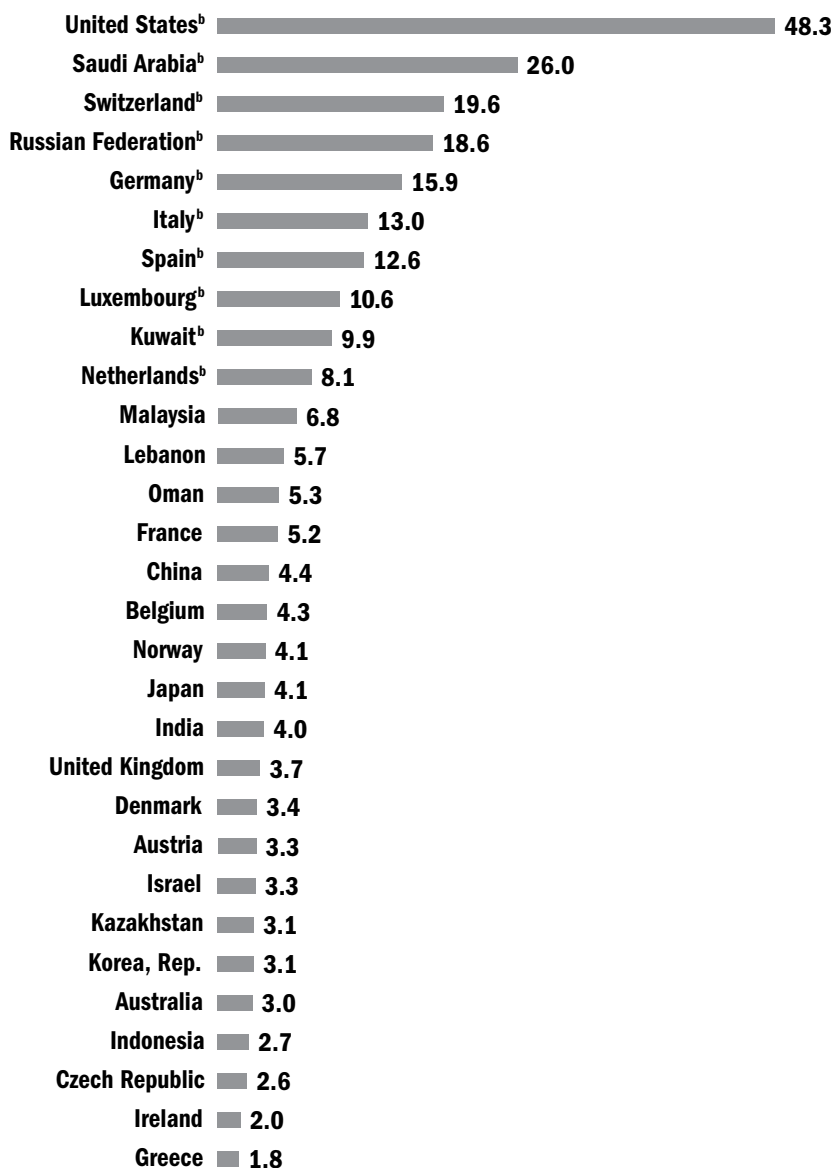

US\$ billions



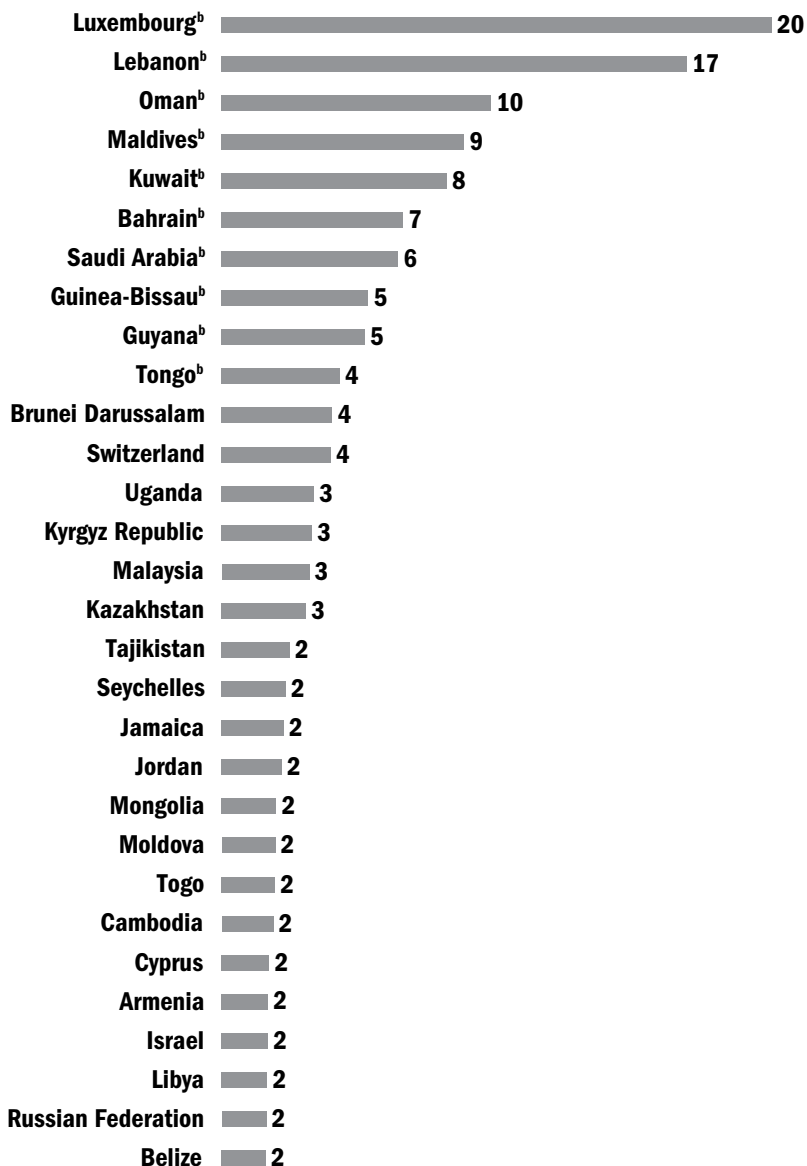
