

Project Preparation and Design Check List

Review the project design process and ensure that the following elements are included:

- Are gender issues identified and addressed in the project design?
- Is a gender specialist included on the project preparation team?
- What is the process for consultation with stakeholders?
- How do project objectives and specific components address gender?
- Are there gender disaggregated indicators for the project objectives?
- Are intersectoral linkages examined (eg. improved access to health services, markets, education) ?
- Are differential impacts of project components addressed sufficiently at both project and policy levels?
- Road works: attention to mobility, access, labor and contracting opportunities.
- Retrenchment: gender assessment of differential impacts and design of appropriate safety nets
- Policy changes such as subsidies, fuel levies, etc.
