

## **Mainstreaming Gender in the Transport Project Cycle**

### **Identification**

- Identify all stakeholders.
- Identify gender and other social inclusion issues relevant to the proposed transport project and assess adequacy of information on those issues.
- Analyze travel and transport needs, access and constraints of male and females.
- Assess institutional capacity for managing gender responsive projects (staffing , expertise, exposure to gender training).

### **Preparation and Design**

- Involve all client groups including women, disabled, etc.
- Identify gender and other social issues that might arise.
- Develop gender indicators for monitoring and supervision.

### **Appraisal**

- Assess gender related opportunities, constraints, outcomes, impacts and risks of proposed transport project.

### **Implementation and Supervision**

- Monitor implementation of gender strategies.
- Address constraints to women's and girls' access and participation.
- Track gender indicators.

### **Monitoring and Evaluation**

- Assess impact of transport project on males, females by age, social group, disabilities and other characteristics.
