- Last national Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES) in 1988



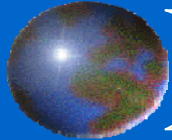

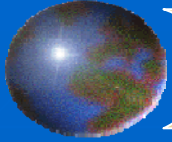
Links to Other Activities

 - Targeting mechanism



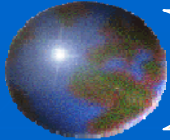
What is Happening on the Ground?

- 12 months of fieldwork started November 1, 2006
- Connecting fieldworkers
- Incredibly, the fieldwork continues everywhere
- So far...6,000 households interviewed and two months of nation-wide data.
- Now starting analysis
