Programme Update

Education

UPE – (17 districts) in all 4 Provinces

- Door to door census of 2.65 million HH's in 17 districts and complete education profile for children aged 0-9 years
- 1.28 million OSC children identified
- 1.01 million OSC children enrolled
- Dropout rate decreased from 48% (ave) to 12% (ave)
- Over 40,000 Volunteers trained in UPE
- 9,121 Feeder Schools (community-based) opened

Programme Update contd.

Education

Adult Literacy – (58 districts)

- 5,391 Literacy centers opened
- 3,874 Literacy centers completed
- 83,549 non-literate made literate aged 15-39 years (80% women)

Programme Update (Contd.)

Health

Primary Health Care (Extension)

(where LHW program has not yet reached)

- 1.1 million population being covered every month
- 168,000 Households receiving Health care visits
- Nearly 1.0 million women trained to make / administer ORS at home
- 261,000 children under five have been vaccinated and monitored for growth regularly
- 262,000 women and 275,000 men have been educated on health issues

Programme Update (Contd.)

Volunteerism

Goal:

To raise a National Volunteer Corps of at least 100,000 volunteers to provide support for MDG's

- Over 78,000 volunteers identified, and 40,000 trained in 17 districts at grass roots level
- Over 33,000 participated in door to door enrollment / dropout prevention & support to teachers
- ICV: First ever International Conference on Volunteerism in support of MDGs held in Pakistan in Dec. 2004 in collaboration with UNDP/UNV
- Co-sponsored Resolution with Brazil on Volunteerism and MDGs at UN General Assembly (2003)

Programme Update (Contd.)

Capacity Building / Management Training

- Completed 21 District level Planning and Budgeting workshops
- 431 government officials trained in Planning and Budgeting
- 20 ZMC's made operational in 17 districts
- 399 elected officials of ZMC's trained
- 32 CCB's organized in 13 Districts with 476 officials trained

**Alliance for Community Empowerment (ACE)
Project – NCHD, DTCE & RSPN partners**

Public Private Partnership & Global Resource Mobilization

- \$16.4 million raised between 2002-2005 from various non-governmental sources globally to support MDGs in Pakistan
- 40,000 volunteers mobilized to help achieve MDGs and create social capital at grass roots level

Provincial Coordination

- Agreement with Govt. of Punjab for UPE / Adult Literacy / School Health / Midwifery and restructuring of BHUs
- Agreement with Govt. of NWFP for UPE / Adult Literacy and Primary Health Care
- Agreement with Govt. of Sindh & Balochistan in final stages of signing

Future Plan

PM has approved NCHD's six year Expansion and Budgetary Plan (2005-2011) to cover all 105 districts, AJK, FATA and FANA for:

- **UPE**
- **Adult Literacy**
- **Primary Health Care / Strengthening and restructuring of BHUs**
- **Community Midwifery Programme**
- **School Health Programme**
- **National ORS Campaign to train nearly 7.0 million women over 3 years**
