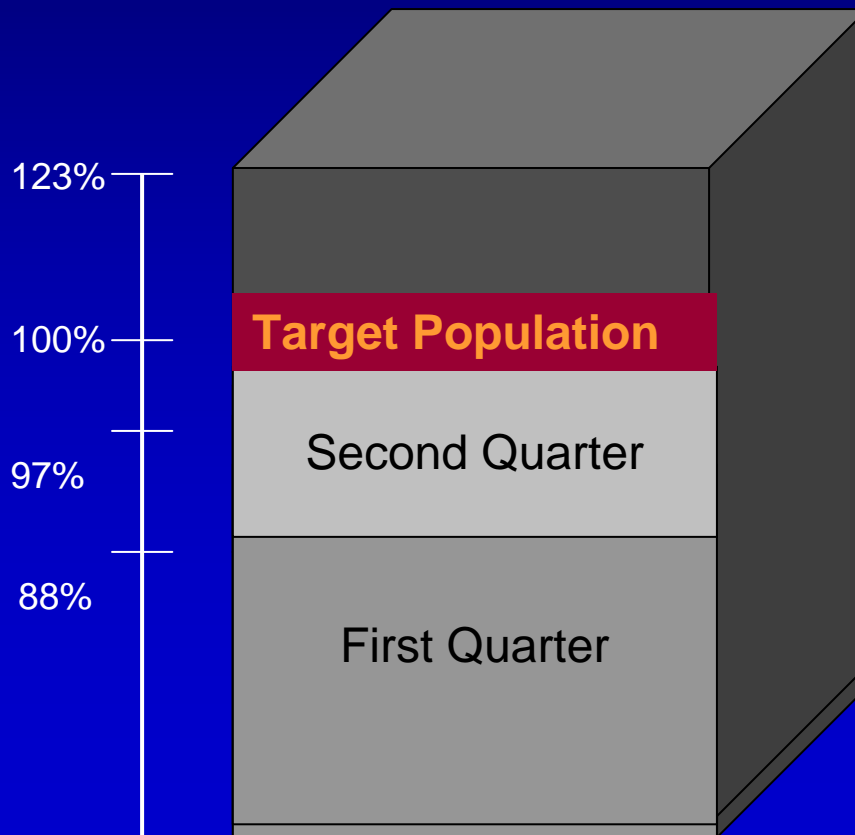


Girls Stipend Disbursement Model

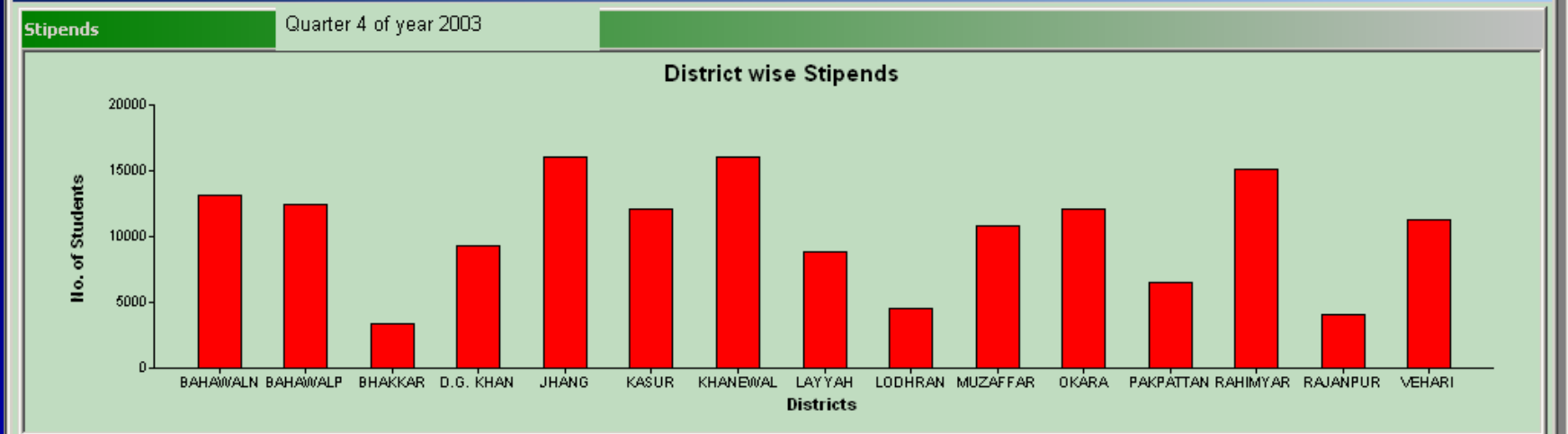


Stipends Progress

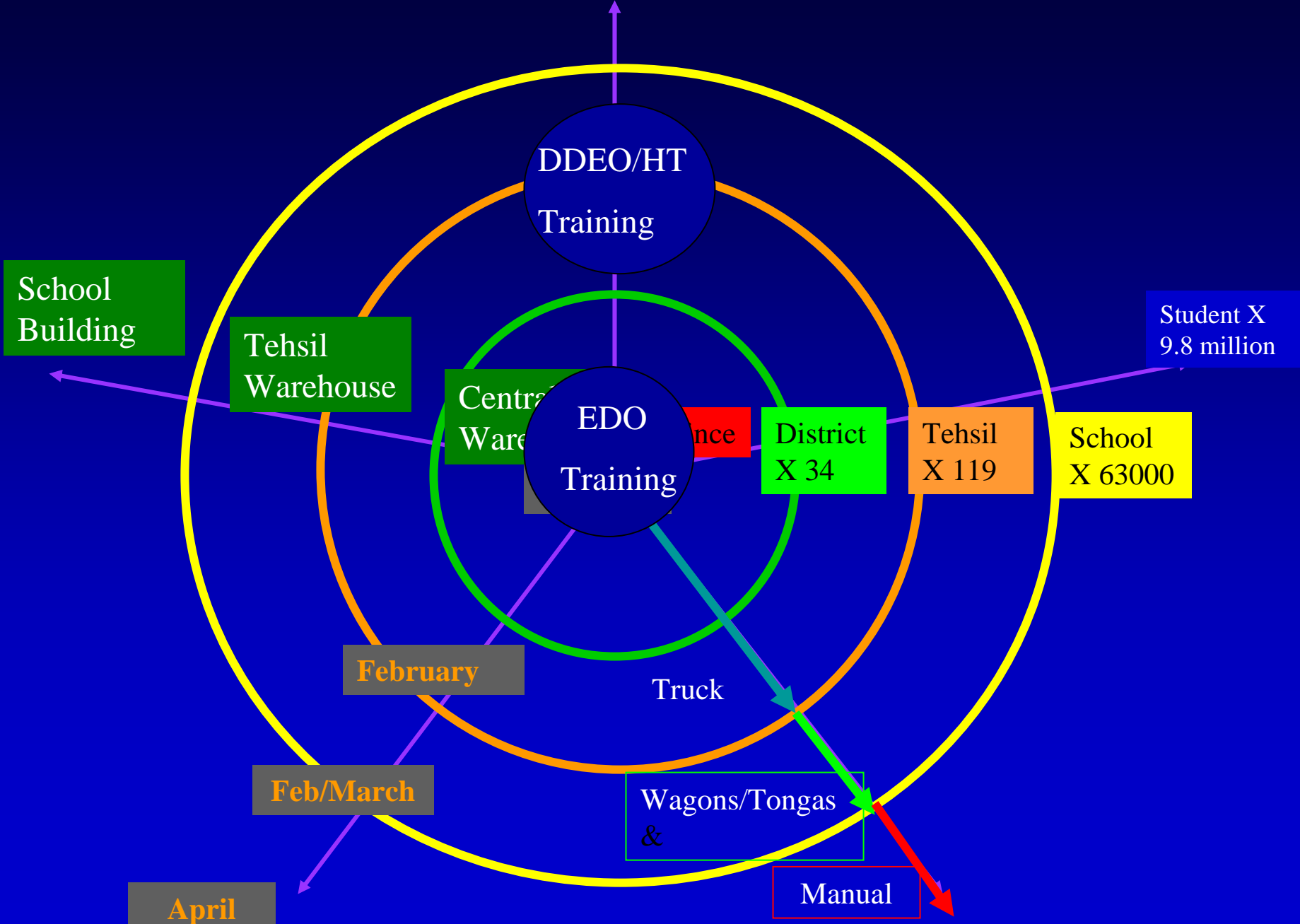

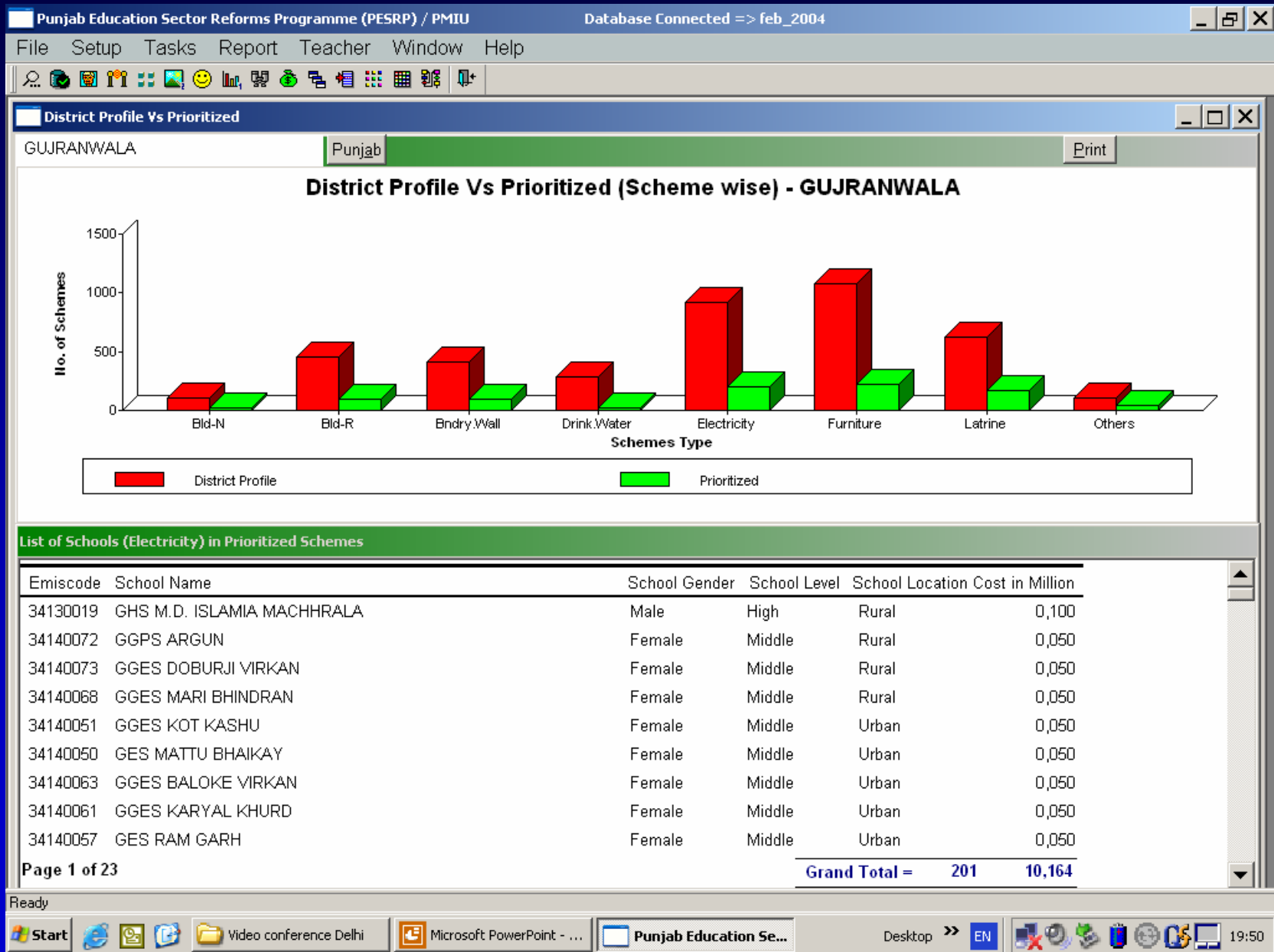

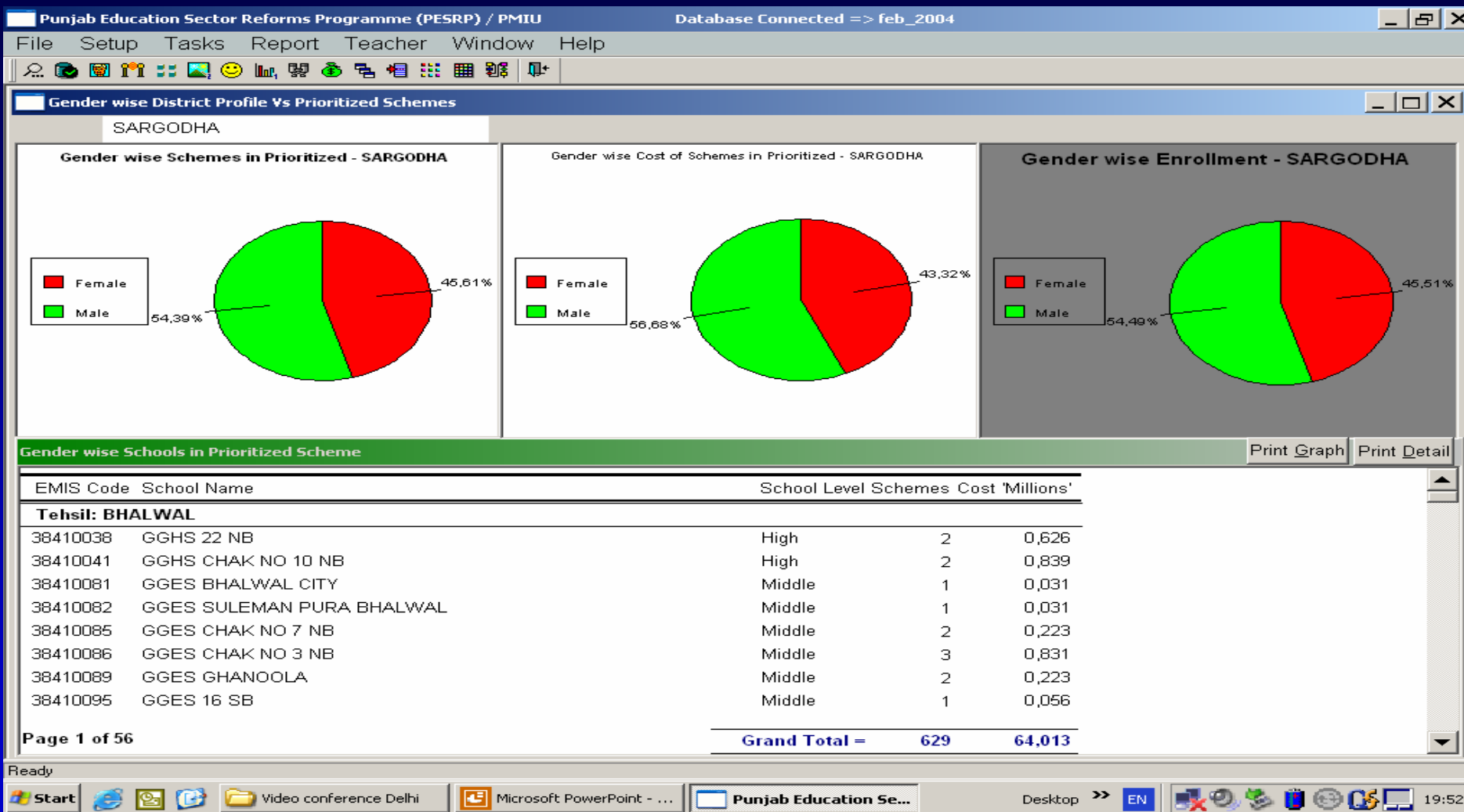

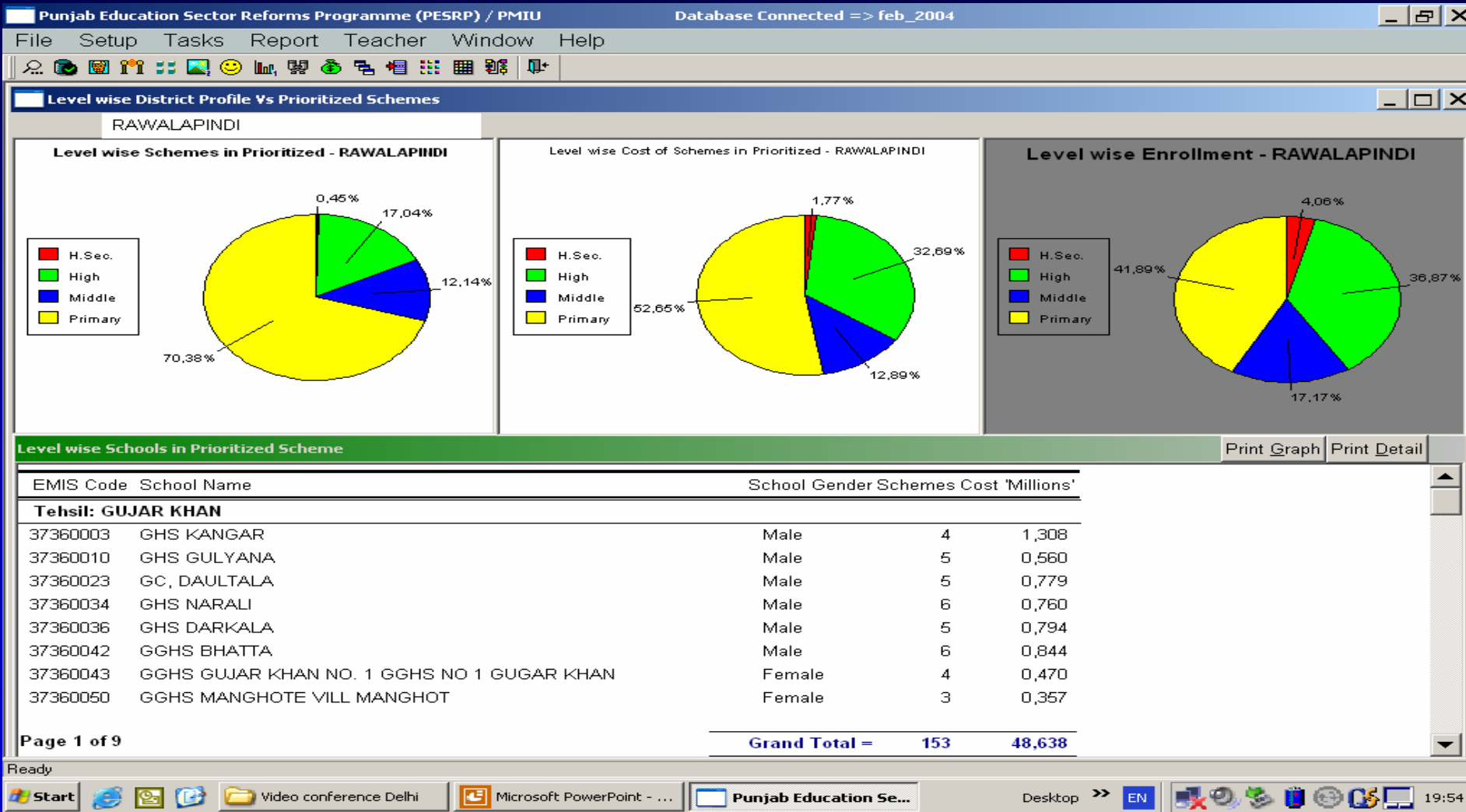
Missing Facilities Monitoring



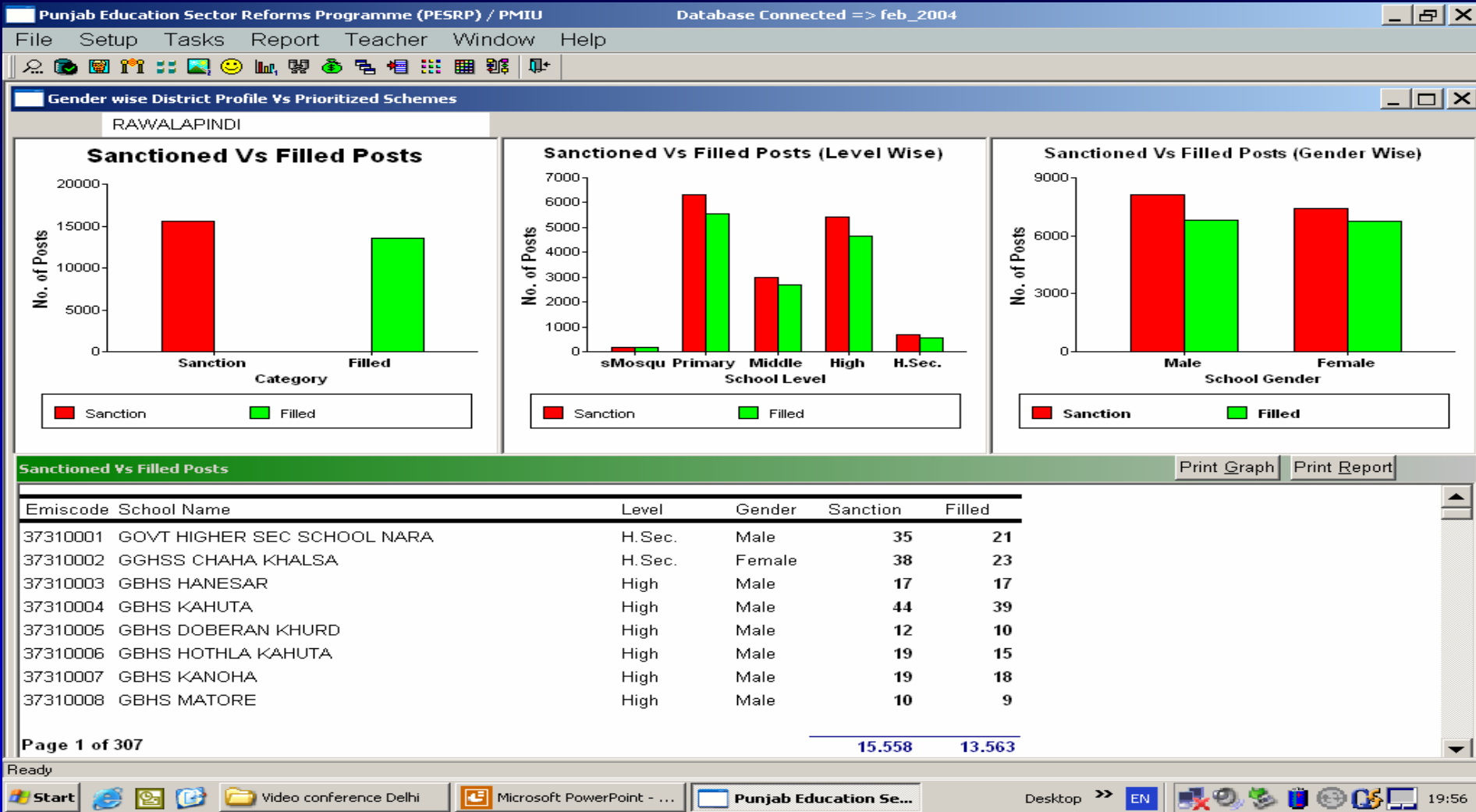
Missing Facilities Monitoring (Gender Dimension)



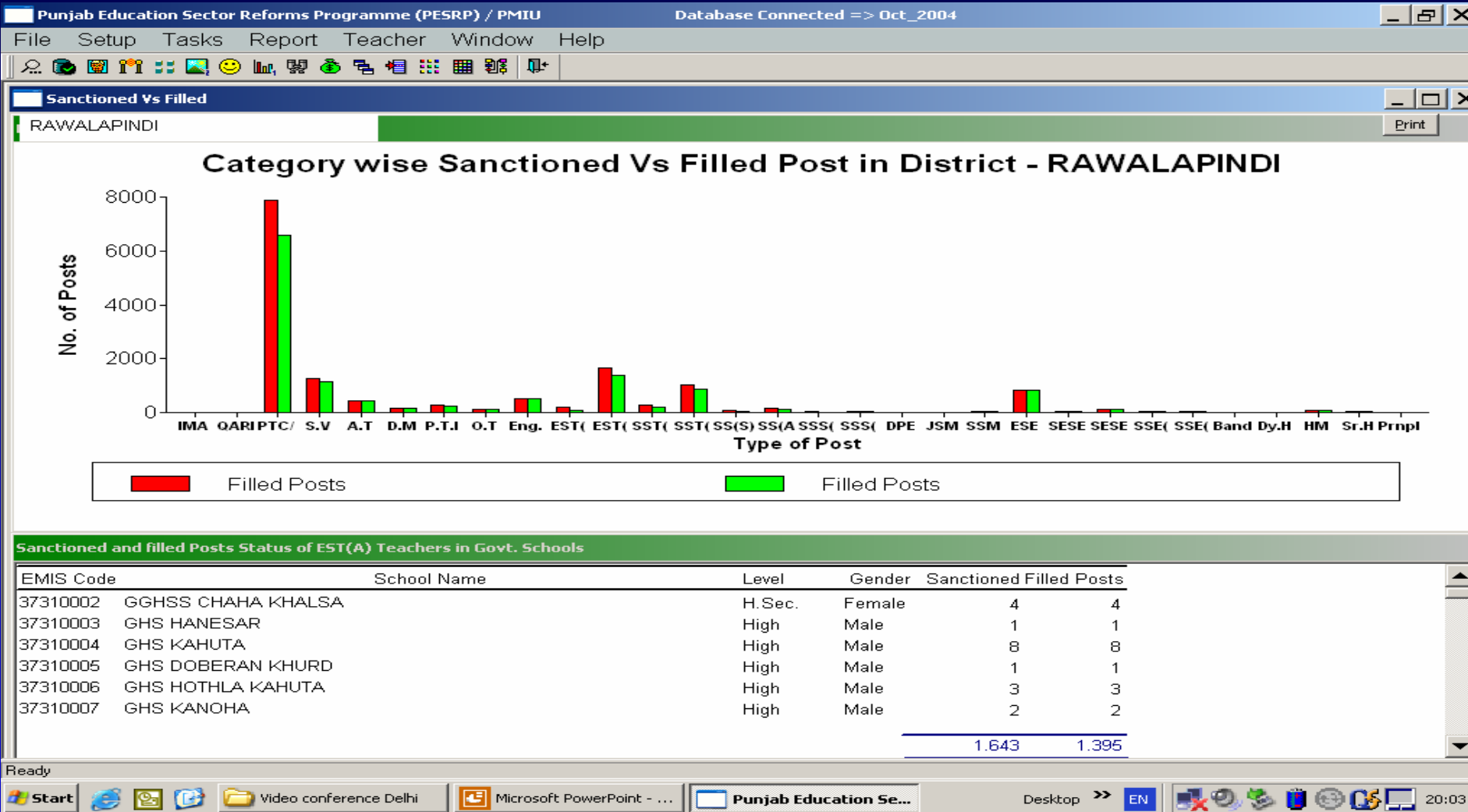
Missing Facilities Monitoring (Education Level Dimension)

Independent Validation of Program

- Annual Third Party Validations (TPVs) carried out for stipend program, textbook distribution, teacher training, and validation of school census data (e.g., 99% student outreach for textbook delivery, 97% for stipends)
- Results confirm the progress data and information captured through ongoing monitoring
- Evaluation of the girls stipend program commencing in September 2005 with technical support from the Bank

Citizen Participation Through Awareness Campaign

- Extensive awareness campaign through print and electronic media
- The campaign encouraged citizen and civil society engagement in the Program
- Campaign created greater accountability in the system
