Online Assessor Feedback Entry

- Each assessor has the flexibility of entering the feedback online by accessing her/his login. The login info will be provided on May 07, 2009 by e-mail
- System checks to ensure the entered score validity
- Average score is calculated automatically and distinct rank is ensured by system
- Assessors can sort the proposals on rank to get a perspective on their entered scores. Feedback can be edited till May 21, 2009

Finalist announcement & next steps

- SARDM team will accept all “Tier I” proposals (2 per assessment group X 26 groups = 52 finalists)
- Out of the “Tier II” proposals, SARDM team will select 8-20 to qualify as finalists based on their scores, and other criteria such as regional balance, etc. (1 per assessor group X 26 groups = 26 potential finalists of which 8-20 will be accepted)
- Finalists will be announced on June 08, 2009
- Finalists will be invited to submit a fuller proposal and invited to attend the Marketplace on Aug 05, 2009.
