- **Obtaining of a status of an expert organisation of financial institutions**
 - WBI, UNDP, МБПП, EBRD, VEB, SberBank of RF, Deutsche Bank
- **Start for a research work and consultancy projects**

 - Building of conditions for projects of regional and municipal scale
 - PPP projects monitoring and creation the best practice collection
- **Formation of demand for educational programs in the sphere of PPP**
 - Regulatory support of themes in the range of priorities for professional development training
 - Collaboration with development institutions and executive bodies
 - Contacts with the Russian Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs and other business associations

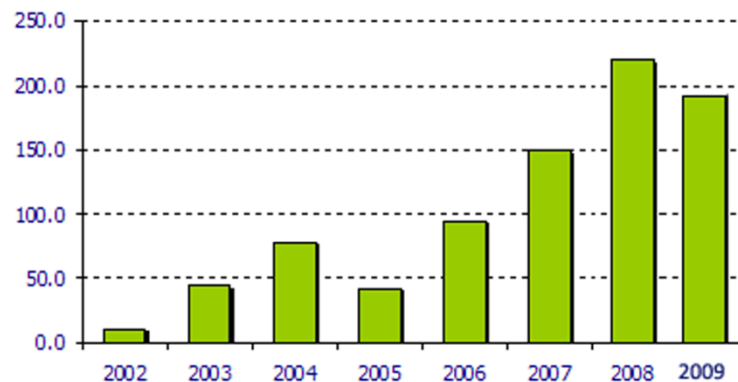

Main highlights (December 2009)

- 70 payroll employees
- 90 invited experts
- more than 100 implemented projects per year
- more than 15 professional scientific events per year
- 190 mln.Rbl. – volume of works implemented in 2009
- 40% works – commissioned by subjects of RF

- Centre of competence and distribution of expertise for modernization of public administration and municipal management

The Institute was established in 2003
as a structure unit of SU-HSE

Existing obstacles to the promotion of PPP in the Russian-speaking community

- The lack of common understanding of PPP-terminology and PPP-phenomena
- The shortage of country-specific educational materials taking into account legal and cultural differences
- High language barriers hampering information dissemination
- Ad hoc patchwork nature of PPP-related legislation in most countries
- Absence or inefficiency of PPP regulating bodies
- Absence of libraries of best practices of projects from Russian-speaking countries
- Capacity gap at the local level (an acute need for local officials capable of initiating, facilitating and monitoring PPP activities)
- Absence of the functioning PPP market of projects
- Unpredictable investment climate at the regional level and inexperience of regional administrations in dealing with foreign investors

The role of the PPP unit of IPAMM

- Provision of training programs to promote better understanding of PPP-phenomena and PPP-terminology
- Development of relevant educational materials adapted to local needs and realities
- Making information on PPP accessible to wider Russian-speaking audience (translation, publishing, organisation of PPP-oriented events)
- Acting as the National Hub to bring together PPP experts and practitioners
- Training of focus groups in Russian-speaking countries
- Consulting and advisory in PPP deals
- Cooperation with national and international organisation in improving PPP legislation
- Data collection on best PPP practices relevant to Russian-speaking experts
